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I) Medical Education

Item No. 3 : To approve the admission procedure/schedule of the Colleges/Institutes of Health Science – (BAMS/BHMS/ Unani) PG & UG Courses in the State of Maharashtra to admit students for Academic Year 2016-17 of which the cut off date is extended till 15th December, 2016.

The Authority perused the admission procedure/schedule of the Colleges/Institutes of Health Science – (BAMS/BHMS/ Unani) PG & UG Courses in the State of Maharashtra to admit students for Academic Year 2016-17 of which the cut off date is extended till 15th December, 2016.

After deliberations, the Authority approved the Schedule which are marked as **Annexure A,B,C**. The Authority further directs the concerned Colleges and all concerned to follow the directions strictly.

Item No. 4: To ratify the decision taken by the Commissioner, State CET Cell on letter dated 8th December, 2016 submitted by Directorate of AYUSH, M.S. Mumbai regarding admission of 1. Chanande Suchita Satish – SC, 2. Nimekar Prachi Sanjay - OBC, in Kakasaheb Mhaske College of Homeopathy, Ahmednagar for Academic Year 2016-17.

The Authority perused the letter dated 8th December, 2016 submitted by Directorate of AYUSH, M.S. Mumbai regarding admission of 1. Chanande Suchita Satish – SC, 2. Nimekar Prachi Sanjay – OBC, in Kakasaheb Mhaske College of Homeopathy, Ahmednagar for Academic Year 2016-17 and the decision taken by the Commissioner, State CET CELL to allow the admissions of 1. Chanande Suchita Satish in SC quota, 2. Nimekar Prachi Sanjay in OBC quota.

The Secretary, Admissions Regulating Authority and the Commissioner, State CET CELL, M.S. stated that as per report submitted by the Observer at the time of admission process, the above named candidates were present and these candidates are meritorious and deserve admissions as per the norms. However due to interruption created by some candidates and parents at that time of admission, the above named meritorious candidates could not get admission though they were present that time. The Director, AYUSH has submitted his detailed report to the Commissioner, State CET CELL. After considering all relevant facts, the Commissioner allowed admission of these candidates in respective reserved quota.

After deliberations, the Authority decides to ratify the decision taken by the Commissioner to allow these candidates to admit in respective reserved quota in Kakasaheb Mhaske Homeopathy College, Ahmednagar for the Academic Year 2016-17 in BHMS Course.



Item No. 5: To ratify the decision taken by the Commissioner, State CET Cell on Letter dated 15th December, 2016 received from the Directorate of AYUSH, M.S. Mumbai regarding not to conduct admission process in Sai Charitable Trust's Sai Ayurvedic College, Barshi Solapur for Academic Year 2016-17.

The Authority perused the letter dated 15th December, 2016 submitted by the Director AYUSH, M.S. Mumbai regarding not to conduct admission process in Sai Charitable Trust's Sai Ayurvedic College, Barshi, Solapur for Academic Year 2016-17 and accordingly the decision taken by the Commissioner, State CET CELL to not to conduct admission process in Sai Charitable Trust, Sai Ayurved College, Barshi for Academic Year 2016-17.

The Secretary, Admissions Regulating Authority and the Commissioner, State CET CELL stated that the aforesaid College has received permission of Medical Education & Drugs Department, Government of Maharashtra, vide Government Resolution No. एएमसी/२०१६प्र (१-शिक्षण)/शिकाना/१६/४६, dated 14/12/2016.

Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik has given permission vide letter No. MUHS/PBUG/Ayurved/First/1305/2016, dated 14/12/2016 and informed to CET CELL office on 15/12/2016 at 11.51 AM by email i.e. on the last date of cut-off. The Director, Directorate of AYUSH therefore immediately convened the meeting of High Power Committee on 15/12/2016, to take necessary decision on this issue. Considering the fact that it was not possible to conduct the admission process at the last moment, and all other relevant facts, the High Power Committee recommended not to allow the college to be included in the admission process on 15/12/2016. The Director, AYUSH submitted his report vide letter dated 15/12/2016

As per the recommendation of the Director, AYUSH and the High Power Committee, the Commissioner State CET CELL informed to the above mentioned college to not to admit the students for Academic Year 2016-17. The Commissioner also informed to the college that if the Cut- off- Date of admission for BAMS Course is extended by the Competent Authority of AYUSH Department, Government of India, then it may be planned accordingly to process the admission.

After deliberations, the Authority ratifies the decision taken by the Commissioner, State CET CELL to not to conduct admission process for Sai Charitable Trust's Sai Ayurvedic College, Barshi, Solapur for Academic Year 2016-17 and do the needful.

Office to inform accordingly.

Item No. 6: To consider and decide on letters/representations received from :-

Item No. 6(a): Letter dated 30th November, 2016 received from Rahul Yuvraj Ahire asking for clarification regarding Irregularity of Admission Process in MIMER Medical College, Talegaon Dabhade, Pune for the course of MBBS and BDS in the Academic Year 2016-17.

The Authority perused the letter dated 30th November, 2016 received from Mr. Rahul Yuvraj Ahire asking for clarification regarding Irregularity of Admission Process in MIMER Medical College, Talegaon Dabhade, Pune for the course of MBBS and BDS in the Academic Year 2016-17.

After deliberations, the Authority directed the office to forward the complaint to the concerned College/Institute for its explanation and also to the Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai for verification and observation report and also for remarks. The college and the Director Medical Education to submit report within a week to the Authority office. After receipt of the same it will be placed before the Authority for its consideration. Office to inform accordingly.

Item No. 6(b): Letter dated 22nd November, 2016 received from the Association of Management of Ayurvedic Medical College of Maharashtra, Sangli requesting for permission to admit CET appeared but not eligible and Non CET candidates if the seats remain vacant even after the Institutional level round on 30th November, 2016 for Academic Year 2016-17, for PG Ayurved Course.

The Authority perused the letter dated 22nd November, 2016 received from the Association of Management of Ayurvedic Medical College of Maharashtra, Sangli requesting for permission to admit CET appeared but not eligible and Non CET candidates if the seats remain vacant even after the Institutional level round on 30th November, 2016 for Academic Year 2016-17, for PG Ayurved Course.

The Authority, after deliberations, concludes that the provisions of the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act, 2015 does not permit to admit CET appeared but not eligible and Non CET candidates (if the seats remain vacant even after the Institutional level round on 30th November 2016 for PG Ayurved Course). Office to inform accordingly.

Item No. 6(c): Letter dated 25th November, 2016 received from the Directorate of AYUSH, M.S. Mumbai regarding the malpractices adopted by Piyush Namdev Hivarkar, SML No.

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30793 in the marksheet of MH-CET 2016, for Academic Year 2016-17.

The Authority perused the letter dated 25th November, 2016 received from the Directorate of AYUSH, M.S. Mumbai regarding the malpractices adopted by Piyush Namdev Hivalakar, SML No. 30793 in the marksheet of MH-CET 2016, for Academic Year 2016-17. The Director AYUSH further informed that the said candidate had admitted in writing about the malpractice adopted by him and therefore was not included in the further admission process for the Academic Year 2016-17.

Authority noted the contents of the letter of Directorate of AYUSH and the submission made by him.

Item No. 6(d): Letters received regarding acceptance of dissertation through online system submission of online thesis as per the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik Circular No. 105/2016, of PG admissions in NRI Quota for Academic Year 2014-15.

- ii) **Letter dated 1st December, 2016 received from Maharashtra Institute of Medical Sciences and Research, Pune.**

The Authority perused the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik Circular No. 105/2016, dated 09/12/2016 regarding rescheduling the acceptance of dissertation w.r.t. PG admissions in Academic Year 2014-15. The Authority also perused the aforesaid letters received from the Colleges/Institutes regarding acceptance of dissertation through online system submission of online thesis by PG students admitted in Academic Year 2014-15.

The Authority directs the office of the Admissions Regulating Authority to verify/scrutinize the admissions in NRI quota for Academic Year 2014-15 and inform the college and also students to comply the discrepancies at the earliest. After submission of required documents from college/students, it will be placed before the Authority for consideration. Office to inform accordingly to all concerned.

Item No. 7: To consider and decide on the Verification/Observation report dated 1st December, 2016 received from the Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai by email.

The Admissions Regulating Authority perused the observation report w.r.t. MBBS (02 College), BDS (01 College), B.Sc. Nursing (17 Colleges) B.P.Th. (03 Colleges) submitted by the Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai. No discrepancies were found in admission process of these Under Graduate Courses for the Academic Year 2015-16. Except 3 colleges of B.Sc Nursing, who have not submitted list of applicants and hence correctness of the selection list could not be verified by the Director Medical Education and Research as mention in 'Observation' of its report viz. – 1) college of Nursing and Medical Research Institute, Ratnagiri, 2) Supriyadidi Sule College of Nursing, Ahmednagar and 3) Aditya Basic B.Sc. Nursing College, Beed.

The Admissions Regulating Authority, after deliberations decides to approve the college wise admissions for Academic Year 2015-16, except the 3 above mentioned B.Sc. Nursing Colleges, where the Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai found no discrepancy. The report of Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai is marked herewith as **Annexure-D.**

The Admissions Regulating Authority further decides to approve the admission process of Kumari Garg Jenny SML no. 17009 in ST Quota admitted at Institute level in Padmashree Dr. Vitthalrao Vikhe Patil Memorial Hospital and Medical College, Ahmednagar subject to verification report of Caste Validity Certificate of Garg Jenny from Director Medical Education and Research.

It is noticed that the Directorate in its verification report dated 1/12/2016 pointed out that various B.Sc. Nursing Colleges/Institutes, admitted candidates from both the lists i.e. MH-CET-2015, Asso-CET-2015 and also admitted Non-CET candidates during the admission process.

The Authority perused the Government Resolution No. एमईडी १०१५/प्र.क्र. ७६/१५/शिक्षण - २, dated 29th April 2015, in this regard.

After, deliberations, the Authority decides to approve admissions of B.Sc. Nursing course as per the provisions of Government Resolution dated 29/04/2015 which is effective for Academic Year 2015-16 and on the basis of verification and observation report of Directorate of Medical Education & Research, Mumbai (in which the admissions have been approved). However the Directorate should sort out and dispose off with the discrepancies after appropriate compliances within two weeks from respective College/Institute.

Item No. 8: To apprise the Order of Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Bombay Bench at Aurangabad in writ petition no. 11687/2016 filed by Shiva Trust, Yeshwantrao Chavan Ayurvedic College,

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Aurangabad and action taken by the Commissioner, State CET Cell on it.

The Authority perused the Order of Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Bombay Bench at Aurangabad in writ petition no. 11687/2016 filed by Shiva Trust, Yeshwantrao Chavan Ayurvedic College, Aurangabad and action taken by the Commissioner, State CET Cell on it, vide its letter dated 09/12/2016.

Authority noted the Judgment and the action taken by the Commissioner, State CET CELL on it.

Item No. 9: To decide on Proposals w.r.t. admissions in 15% NRI Quota for the Academic Year 2012-13.

The Authority perused the Note submitted by the office w.r.t. admissions in 15% NRI quota for the Academic Year 2012-13.

In view of the above, after deliberations, the Authority directs the office of the Authority to verify and scrutinize all pending proposals of admitted students in 15% NRI Quota for the Academic Year 2012-13 for UG course and also for Academic Year 2014-15 for PG course at the earliest and submit the report to the Authority on priority basis. Thereafter the NRI cases of UG & PG course may be scrutinized year wise and put up report to the Authority for needful action/directions. The decision of the Authority be conveyed accordingly to the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik for further necessary action. The Authority further directs the office to inform the aforesaid College/Institute as well as candidates of UG course of Academic Year 2012-13 and PG course of Academic Year 2014-15 to comply with the requirements within one week failing which admissions are liable to be disapproved. Office of the Authority to take necessary steps accordingly.

II) Higher and Technical Education :**Item No. 10: To consider, discuss and decide about approval of the admissions to Higher & Technical Education courses for the Academic Year 2015-16, subject to amendment in schedule of submission and disposing the proposals as per the section 9(5) of the Act.**

- a) **To consider, discuss and decide on proposals received for approval of admissions where there are no discrepancies.**
- b) **To consider, discuss and decide on proposals received for approval of admissions where there are discrepancies.**

The Authority perused the list of proposals received after 31st January, 2015, for approval of admissions to Higher & Technical Education courses for the Academic Year 2015-16. The Authority has sought the directions of the Govt. on it. The proposals – received after due date will be processed by the Authority subject to the requisite

amendment in schedule of submission and disposing the proposals as per the section 9(5) of the Act.

Attention is drawn to the provisions of the Government of Maharashtra, Act No. XXVIII of 2015 dated on 12th August 2015, of chapter III, section 9, sub section 5 clause (iii).

In view of the above, after deliberations, the Authority decides to remind/suggest to the Higher and Technical Education Department, Government of Maharashtra to take the necessary steps in this respect and inform the Authority accordingly.

Item No. 11: To discuss letter no. 2A/ADM/2016/1503 dated 15th November, 2016 received from Director of Technical Education, Mumbai regarding considering the admission of Shri. Shaswat Zaa done in Sant Gajanan Maharaj College of Engineering, Shegaon.

The Authority perused the letter under reference received from Director of Technical Education, Mumbai regarding admission of Shri. Shaswat Zaa in Sant Gajanan Maharaj College of Engineering, Shegaon in second year Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering.

It is stated that the First Year Engineering result of Shri. Shaswat Zaa was declared by Amarawati University on 29/08/2016. At this stage the Direct Second Year admission process i.e. updation of vacancies and allotment of candidates was over. Shri. Shaswat Zaa, a regular student of the college from First Year was expected to be admitted in Second Year as a pipeline process. Hence the Director, Technical Education, recommended to regularize his admission.

After deliberations, the Authority, decides to regularize the admission of Shri. Shaswat Zaa in Second Year Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering, in Sant Gajanan Maharaj college of Engineering, Shegaon.

Item No. 12: To discuss letter no. 2A/ADM/2016/1501 dated 15th November, 2016 received from Director of Technical Education, Mumbai regarding considering the admission of Ku. Ankita Ashok Lonkar done in PH4207 Dadasaheb Balpande College of Pharmacy, Nagpur and the admission of 1. Ku. Pankaj Bandu Jahurkar 2. Ku. Abhishek Chandrashekhar Bapat done in Gurunanak College of Pharmacy, Nagpur for Academic Year 2016-17.

The Authority perused the letter under reference of the Director of Technical Education, Mumbai regarding considering the admission of Ku. Ankita Ashok Lonkar done in PH4207 Dadasaheb Balpande College of Pharmacy, Nagpur and the admissions of 1. Ku. Pankaj Bandu Jahurkar, 2. Ku. Abhishek Chandrashekhar Bapat done in Gurunanak College of Pharmacy, Nagpur for Academic Year 2016-17.

It is stated that the revaluation proposals of above named students were considered and their results was declared on 4/10/2016 by Nagpur University. At this stage the Direct Second Year admission process i.e. updation of vacancies and allotment of candidates was over. But Ku. Ankita Ashok Lonkar, Pankaj Bandu Jahurkar, Abhishek Chandrashekhar Bapat are regular students of Dadasaheb Balpande College of Pharmacy, Nagpur and Gurunanak College of Pharmacy, Nagpur respectively. Therefore they are expected to be admitted in second year as a pipeline process. In view of this the Director, Technical Education recommended to regularize their admissions.

After deliberations, the Authority decides to regularize the admission of Ku. Ankita Ashok Lonkar in second year B. Pharmacy of Dadasaheb Balpande College of Pharmacy, Nagpur and Shri. Pankaj Bandu Jaharkar, Abhishek Chandrashekhar Bapat in second year B. Pharmacy of Gurunanak College of Pharmacy, Nagpur.

Item No. 13: To consider and decide on letters/representations received from :-

Item No. 13(a): Letter dated 27th October, 2016 received from Higher and Technical Education department, Mantralaya, Mumbai M.S. regarding Illegal and fraudulent practices in the PG admission 2016-17 at College of Engineering, Pune for Academic Year 2016-17.

The Authority perused the letter dated 27th October, 2016 received from Higher and Technical Education department, Mantralaya, Mumbai M.S. regarding illegal and fraudulent practices in the PG admission 2016-17 at College of Engineering, Pune for Academic Year 2016-17.

It is observed that the sponsorship certificate was a false certificate given to the candidate who is not full time employee of the college of Engineering, Pune for admission in PG Engineering Course. The admission of the above candidate is cancelled as it is brought to the notice of the Chairman of Admission Committee of the college. The college of Engineering Gazetted Teachers/officers, Association, Pune requested to take appropriate legal action against the persons involved in the above illegality.

The Authority, after deliberations, concludes that the aforesaid matter does not come within the purview of the Authority. The Authority directs the office to forward the aforesaid letter to the Director, Technical Education, Mumbai for necessary action. Office to inform accordingly.

Item No. 13(b): Letter dated 19th October, 2016 received from Higher and Technical Education department, Mantralaya, Mumbai M.S. regarding transfer of admission of Ku. Aditya Pravin Vishwasrao from Institute of Hotel Management, Goa to

Institute of Hotel Management, Maharashtra for Academic Year 2016-17.

The Authority perused the letter dated 19th October, 2016 received from Higher and Technical Education department, Mantralaya, Mumbai M.S. regarding transfer of admission of Ku. Aditya Pravin Vishwasrao from Institute of Hotel Management, Goa to Institute of Hotel Management, Maharashtra for Academic Year 2016-17.

The Authority directed that the Director, Technical Education have to submit its appropriate report. After receipt, it may be placed before the Authority.

These Institutes have requested to the Authority to open online link for uploading their admission details. In view of this, the Secretary, Admissions Regulating Authority decided to extend the date for uploading the admission details upto 31st Dec. 2016.


