Item No. 3 : **To discuss, decide and plan for the verification of merit List and admissions to Higher and Technical Courses for Academic Year 2013-14 (i.e. MBA MCA / M. Engineering / M. Pharmacy / M. Architecture / B. Architecture / B. Engineering / B. Pharmacy / B. H.M.C.T. / B. .Architecture / B.Ed. / M.Ed. / B.P.Ed. / M.P. Ed. etc.)**

After deliberations, Samiti resolves as under:

A) For Technical Education Courses

Expert committee (PNS) shall be headed by the Director, Technical Education, M.S.. The Director, Technical Education will appoint two other members who shall be drawn from the officers of Technical Education Department and who shall be not below the ranks of Dy. Director.

- a) Committee will verify the merit lists of the admitted students, where the admissions have been done through CAP process for First Year in Engg/ B.Pharm, first year in MBA/ MCA/ M.Pharmacy/ M.Architecture/ B.Architecture/ B.HMCT. Where the admissions are done in violation of triple test criterion, same be brought to the notice of Samiti.

- b) Committee will verify the merit lists of the admitted students, where the admissions are done at institute level, minority quota and other admissions in First Year in Engg/ B.Pharm, first year in MBA/ MCA/ M.Pharmacy/ M.Architecture/ B.Architecture/ B.HMCT, Where the admissions are done in violation of triple test criterion, same be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- c) Committee will verify the merit lists of the admitted students, where the admission are done at institute level in M.E. courses. Where the admissions are done in violation of triple test criterion, same be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- d) Committee will verify the merit list of the admitted students, where the admissions are done at institute level, minority and other admissions done. Where the admissions are done in violation of triple test criterion, same be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- e) Committee will submit overall verification report of admissions for AY 2013-14 to Samiti before **15th December 2013**.
- f) Verification containing details of admissions of following courses need not be sent to Samiti for its consideration:-
 - i) Diploma courses polytechnic, D.Pharmacy. D. HMCT etc where the admissions are done after 10th /12th standard levels without the students having required to qualify only CET.
 - ii) Admission to any courses not recognized/approved by any University.

B) For Higher Education Courses

Expert Committee (PNS) shall be headed by The Director, Higher Education, M.S. Pune. The Director, Higher Education will appoint two other members who shall be drawn from the officers of Higher Education Department and who shall be not below the ranks of Dy. Director.

- a) Committee will check & verify the admissions done through CAP process for the private B.ED. Colleges / Institute who have joined the Govt. CET conducted by the Director, Higher Education, Where the admissions are done in violation of triple test criterion, same be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- b) Committee will check & verify the admissions done in private B.Ed. Colleges/ Institutes, who have joined the Asso-CET and the CAP conducted by Association, Where the admissions are done in violation of triple test criterion, same be brought to the notice of Samiti .
- c) Committee will check & verify the admissions granted through CAP process for the private M.ED. Colleges / Institutes, who have joined the Govt. CET conducted by the Director, Higher Education, Where the admissions are done in violation of triple test criterion, same be brought to the notice of Samiti.

- d) Committee will check & verify the admissions granted through CAP process for the private M.ED. Colleges / Institutes, who have joined the Asso. CET conducted by Association, Where the admissions are done in violation of triple test criterion, same be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- e) Committee will submit overall verification report of admissions for AY 2013-14 to Samiti before **15th December 2013**.

C) For Sports Education Courses

Experts Committee (PNS) shall be headed by the Director, Sports & Youth services, M.S., Pune. The Director, Sports & Youth services will appoint two other members who shall be drawn from the officers of Sports & Youth services Department and who shall be not below the ranks of Dy. Director.

- a) Committee will check & verify the admissions done through CAP process for the private B.P. ED./M.P.Ed Colleges / Institute, who have joined the Govt. CET conducted by the Director, Sports & Youth services, Where the admissions are done in violation of triple test criterion, same be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- b) Committee will check & verify admissions granted through CAP process in private unaided B.P.Ed./ M.P.Ed Colleges / Institutes and those who opted for CET conducted by Universities, Private Association. Where admissions are done in violation of triple test criterion, same be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- c) Committee will submit overall verification report of admissions for AY 2013-14 to Samiti before **15th December 2013**.

D) Schedule for Submission of Online Admissions details

- 1) All Colleges / Institutes shall submit the lists of admissions online only within 15 days to PNS immediately after the admissions are over for the academic year.
- 2) Expert Committee i.e. Director, Technical Education, Director, Higher Education, and Director, Sports & Youth services, after verification of the proposals shall submit its reports to PNS before 15th December every year for approval of Samiti,
- 3) Colleges / Institutes submitting their admission details online after the due date mentioned as above , penalty will be charged as under:-
 - a) Upto 15th October every year Rs. 10,000/- per course
 - b) Upto 30th November every year Rs. 50,000/- per course
- 4) After 31st March in case of failure / non observance of due dates same to be brought to the notice of PNS for further actions.

Item No. 4 : **To consider and decide on the Letters / representations received :-**

Item No. 4 (a): **Letter dated 14th June 2013 received Directorate of Higher Education, Pune regarding admission process of B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses for the Academic Year 2013-14, addressed to Maharashtra Vinanaudit Adhyapak Mahavidyalaya Sansthachalak Association passing certain guidelines/instructions to the said association, copy endorsed to us along with letter dated 13/07/2013 received from Maharashtra Vinaanudan Adhyapak Mahavidyalaya Sansthachalak Association.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti heard Dr. Nikalaje, Co-ordinator, Govt. CAP process and Dr. S.S. Patil, Principal Govt. B.Ed. College, Mumbai.

After deliberation Samiti directs the Association to submit its opinion as to whether it will be appropriate, feasible and advisable to conduct the video recording of an oral examination /interviews of students before selection for admissions.

Samiti further resolves to appoint a Panel of Committee to observe Asso-CET. Samiti further directs to the Director, Higher Education, M.S. Pune submit the list of Officers of Higher Education Department for appointment of panel of committee to observe Asso-CET.

Samiti further directs Panel of Committee to submit their observers report in sealed packet on the next day positively.

Item No. 4 (b): **Letter dated 16th May 2013 received from Kadariya College of Education, Buldhana regarding approval to 03 admissions those were shown as having discrepancies for the Academic Year 2012-13.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti in its meeting held on 15th March 2013, has already taken the decision on the aforesaid matter, the extract of which are as under:

"Samiti once again clarifies that the Non-CET candidates and non eligible candidate with requisite marks admitted in B.Ed course cannot be approved."

After deliberation, Samiti comes to the conclusion that the decision taken by Samiti in its meeting held on 15th March 2013 warrants no change. All decisions of the committee those were taken herein before in respect of Non-CET admissions in B.Ed course stand as they are without any alterations, modifications, etc. The aforesaid college/

institute can seek the remedy against the decision of Samiti if it all the applicant feels aggrieved before the appropriate authority empowered by law.

Item No. 5 : **To consider, discuss and decide about approval of the admissions to Higher and Technical Courses for the Academic Year 2012-13.**

Samiti perused the observations of the Expert Committee appointed by the Samiti- After going through it and Director, Technical Education, Mumbai, having found certain discrepancies in admission process of 488 colleges/Institutes, Samiti after deliberation decides to approve eligibility and selection process of following 488 colleges/Institutes in Technical Education for AY 2012-13, Subject to the Expert Committee - i.e. Director, Technical Education or his Officers or the Competent Authorities sorting out and disposing off with the said discrepancies after appropriate compliances from respective institutions for Academic Year 2012-13.

Samiti directs the institutes to submit the explanations over the complaints lodged by candidates within 15 days. There after to be put up before Samiti.

Item No. 6(b):- Letter dated 11th July 2013 received from Solapur University asking for separate CET for MBA course for the Academic Year 2013- 14.

Samiti perused letter under reference.

Samiti pointed Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgment in (2003) 6 Supreme Court cases 697 Islamic Academy of Education v. State of Karnataka Para No. 16 as re- produced hereunder:

" The word 'common Entrance Test' clearly indicate that each institute cannot hold a separate test. We thus hold that the management could select students, of their quota, either on the basis of the common entrance test conducted by the State or on the basis of a common entrance test to be conducted by an association of all colleges of a particular type in that State e.g. medical, engineering or technical etc. The common entrance test, held by the association, must be for admission to all colleges of that type in the State. The option of choosing, between either of these tests, must be exercised before issuing of prospectus and after intimation to the concerned authority and the Committee set up hereinafter. If any professional college chooses not to admit from the common entrance test conducted by the association then that college must necessarily admit from the common entrance test conducted by the State".

In view of the above after deliberation Samiti decides not to accede to the request made by Solapur University to conduct a separate CET for AY 2013-14.

Item No. 6(c):- Letter dated 11th July 2013 received from Management Association of MCA Institutes (MAMI) requesting for permission to conduct second CET on 31st July 2013 for admission to MCA program for the Academic Year 2013-14.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti observes that the Association has conducted the CET on 29th June 2013 for admissions to MCA, the details of outcome of the said CET are as follows:

After deliberation, Samiti decides to grant permission to conduct the additional CET on 3rd August as per the schedule submitted by Association subject to following conditions:-

- 1) This permission shall be subject to satisfaction of terms/conditions/ suggestion for modifications, alteration, corrections and Remarks/ comments of Expert Committee i.e. Director, Technical Education on Draft brochure of the additional CET (second CET) submitted by Association if any.
- 2) Association to submit the conclusive evidence that all qualified students in earlier CET were considered for admissions and the association should also ensure that none of the qualified students remains to be considered for the admission before the commencement of additional (Second) CET. This needs to be affirmed and submitted to Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti in the form of an affidavit duly executed before the executive Magistrate.
- 3) Association failing to satisfy all the above conditions approval being given now for an additional (Second) CET will be deemed to have been revoked immediately at once without any notice to the Association.
