Samiti noted that 392, institutes have not submitted their admission details for approval of Samiti. Samiti decides to issue notice to these colleges asking for their explanations. These institutes should submit their say within 15 days. Samiti directs the Office to inform the University for non-enrollment of the students, who were admitted in these institutes. Details to be placed before the Samiti.

Item No. 3 : **To consider, discuss and decide about approval of the admissions to Higher and Technical Courses for the Academic Year 2012-13.**

Item No. 3(a) : **To consider, discuss and decide on proposals received for approval of admissions where there are no discrepancies considering the criteria on triple test as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.**

TECHNICAL EDUCATION

Samiti perused the observations of Expert Committee appointed by the Samiti i.e. Office of the Director, Technical Education, Mumbai (Academic year 2012-13). After going through it and office of Director, Technical Education, Mumbai, having found no discrepancies in admission process of following 41 Colleges/Institutes, Samiti, on the basis of fulfillment of the conditions of triple test, as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and having found no discrepancy, decides to approve the eligibility and selection process of these institutes for Academic Year 2012-13.

1. Samiti perused observation of Expert Committee i.e. Director, Higher Education, Pune, found certain discrepancies in admission process of 55 colleges/Institutes. Considering this after deliberation, Samiti decides to approve eligibility and selection process of following 55 colleges/Institutes in Higher Education for AY 2012-13, Subject to the Expert Committee - i.e. Director, Higher Education or his Officers or the Competent Authorities sorting out and disposing off with the said discrepancies after appropriate compliances from respective institutions for Academic Year 2012-13.

Samiti further directs these institutes to submit the documents of university affiliation, NCTE permission and other permissions as required from the respective competent authorities. They should also confirm that their fees are approved by appropriate Authority.

Samiti noted the contents.

Item No. 5(a): **Letter dated 6th May 2013 received from Directorate of Sports and Youth, M.S. Pune regarding remarks/suggestion in draft brochure of B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed. CET.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Director, Directorate of Sports and Youth Services, Pune has submitted their remarks/suggestions on brochure of CET 2013 of B.P.ED/M.P.ED course.

In continuation to Samiti's decision dated 15/2/2013, at item No. 4(b), Samiti decides to approve the draft brochure submitted by Mahasangh, subject to modification suggested by Expert Committee i.e. Director of Sports & Youth Services, Pune.

Item No. 5(b): **Letter dated 14th February 2013 received from Directorate of Technical Education, Pune regarding remarks/suggestion in draft brochure of AMMI-CET for admissions to MBA course for the Academic Year 2013-14.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Director of Technical Education, M.S. Mumbai has submitted their remarks/suggestions on draft brochure & AMMI-CET for admission of MBA course for the Academic Year 2013-14.

In continuation to Samiti's decision dated 15/2/2013, at item No. 4(a), Samiti decides to approve the draft brochure submitted by AMMI-CET. Office should inform accordingly.

Item No. 5(c): **Letter dated 29th April 2013 received from Association of Unaided Private Pharmacy Colleges, Wardha in respect of the decision taken by the Samiti in its meeting held on 15th March 2013- clarification regarding refund of fees.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti in its meeting held on 15th March 2013 at Item No. 5 in direction No. n (i) has directed as under in connection with refund of fees:-

- i) "If a candidate cancels his admission before the cut-off-date, then College/Institute has to deduct only Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges and balance amount of fees paid by a student be refunded within two days, otherwise the same will amount to profiteering and charging of capitation

fees. The samiti further directs that the College/Institute should also return the original documents / certificates collected from the students within two days.

- ii) If a candidate expires within three months from the date of admission full refund shall be made after deducting Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges.
- iii) After cut-off-date except in (ii) above no refund shall be made.

After deliberation Samiti decides that the decision taken by Samiti in the earlier meeting held on 15th March 2013 at item No. 5 warrants no change. Samiti further directs the Association to act as per the decisions taken earlier in this regard.

Item No. 5(d): Letter dated 11th June 2013 received from Association of Management of MBA/MMS institutes, Pune asking for permission to conduct Second CET on 28th July 2013 for admissions to MBA/MMS course.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Association has conducted first CET on 16th June 2013, for admission to MBA/MMS program with prior permission from Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti. The details are as under:-

After deliberation, Samiti decides to grant permission for conduct of second CET on 28th July 2013 as per the schedule submitted by Association. However it is made clear that this permission has been granted for the current academic year and it shall not be used as the precedent in the years to come.

Item No. 5(e): Letter dated 29th April 2013 received from Maharashtra Association of Schools of Architecture (MASA), Pune regarding admission process for M. Architecture course for the Academic Year 2013-14.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti decides to approve the draft brochure submitted by Association for MASA--2013 for admission to M. Architecture course for the Academic Year 2013-14, subject to modifications suggested by Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Technical Education, M.S., Mumbai and publication of the corrected brochure accordingly.

Samiti allows Maharashtra Association of School of Architecture (MASA) to conduct CAP for M. Architecture course for Academic Year 2013-14.

- a. CAP should be conducted in fair and transparent manner and as per the directives, orders, norms, rules and regulations laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi, 2) Hon'ble High Courts, 3) Respective Councils, 4) Respective University, 5) Govt. of Maharashtra, 6) Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti, Maharashtra State and 7) Directorate of Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai.
- b. Schedule of CAP should be as per directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi, if any.
- c. Schedule of CAP should be displayed on website of the Association and the notice boards of participating Colleges/Institutes.
- d. Association should ensure that allotment of students to colleges is made strictly as per merit and as per the options of choices exercised. Association should also ensure that colleges must have submitted Fee Approval proposals to Shikshan Shulka Samiti, Maharashtra State for finalization of fees structure the Academic Year 2013-14. It is also to be ensured that allotment of students is done only the colleges those are affiliated to Council and University for the academic year 2013-14. Association should ensure that colleges submit the list of admissions within two days from the cut off date to Samiti's office.
- e. Association conducting CAP should communicate to Samiti's office vacancy details immediately after the last round is over but within 7 days.
- f. The Competent Authority of the Association and / or Representatives of Director, Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai will be Grievance Redressal Authority who will take care of all complaints of students/parents during admission process. Association should further ensure appointment of appellate authority to hear and decide and dispose of grievances against the decisions of said competent authority.
- g. MASA/Colleges are directed to display details of their infrastructure available on their website.
- h. It should be ensured that the Colleges incorporated in the lists are having all permissions, affiliations of the respective Authorities and/or Universities. Students to be allotted to these colleges only.
- i. Where seats are likely to be increased, Association to publish the details before hand in Local as well as State Level News papers, notice boards and websites of association and respective Colleges also and invite/call the fresh preferences / choices from the candidates for such seats.
- j. Samiti further directs the Association to submit the following information to office of Samiti without fail:-
 - i) No. of students participated in CAP
 - ii) No. of students qualified in the CAP.
 - iii) No. of participating Colleges with subjects and their sanction intake capacity.

- iv) Course/Subject/category wise seat matrix of each rounds before and after rounds.
- v) List of selected candidates of each round.
- vi) Details of complaints received during the process and details of action taken by Competent Authority and the Appellate Authority.

Item No. 5(f): Letter dated 30th May 2013 received from Association of Minority Pharmacy Colleges, Akkalkuwa asking for continuation the permission of M.Pharm AMPCA CET- 2013 & CAP-2013 for the Academic Year 2013-14 for admissions to M.Pharmacy course in Minority Colleges/ Institute.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberation, Samiti decides that there being no provision for separate CET for Minority Quota Admissions, Request of the aforesaid College/ Institute to conduct CET for Minority Quota admission for the Academic Year 2013-14 stands rejected.

Item No. 5(g): Letter dated 11th June 2013 received from Maharashtra Vinaanudan Adhyapak Mahavidyalaya Sansthachalak Association, Pune asking guidelines in respect of discrepancies in admissions list of B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses for the Academic Year 2012-13.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

While approving the admissions where there were discrepancies, pointed out by Expert Committee i.e. Director, Higher Education, Pune Samiti had decided as under in its earlier meeting:-

"Samiti is, prima facie, satisfied as to the correctness of list of the students admitted provisionally by your college. Samiti, on the basis of fulfillment of the condition of triple test, as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme court and having found certain discrepancies, decided to approve the eligibility and selection process of the college/institute in Higher Education for AY 2012-13, subject to the office of the Director, Higher Education or its officers or the competent authorities to sort out and dispose off with the discrepancies in regard to selection list for eligibility of admission process for AY 2012-13."

After deliberation, Samiti decides that the discrepancies to be sorted out and disposed off by the Expert Committee appointed by Samiti.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberation, Samiti observes the request made by Director, Higher Education, Pune not being specific deserves to be set aside.

Item No. 6(c) : Letter dated 13th June 2013 received from Directorate of Higher Education, Pune asking for verification of merit list in respect of NON ZERO score or Non CET candidates alongwith Hon'ble High Court Order in Writ Petition No. 9243 of 2012.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberation, Samiti decides that the decision taken by Samiti in its meeting held on 15th February 2013, 15th March 2013 and 18th April 2013 (at item No. 3(b)) warrants no change. All decisions of the committee those were taken herein before stand as they are without any alterations, modification, etc.

Item No. 6(d) : Letter dated 10th May 2013 received from Dr. S. Radhakrishnan College of Business Management, Nagpur asking for the amount of penalty to Rs. 20,000/- reduction in for delay in submission of admission details for the Academic Year 2010-11.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

It is observed that the aforesaid college/ Institute has not submitted their proposals for approval of admission in time. In view of this Samiti decided in its meeting held on 1st September 2012 to charge penalty of 50% of the fees collected by them for the process of approval of admission for Academic Year 2011- 12 and 2010-11.

After deliberation, Samiti directs the aforesaid college/ Institute to pay the penalties for the Academic Year 2011-12 and 2010-11. Samiti to be kept informed of whether penalty has been paid or not.

Item No. 6(e) : **Letter dated 9th June 2013 received from Chaudhari Atarsingh Yadav Memorial Education Trust, Pune asking for reductions in the amount of penalty for approval of merit list for Academic Year 2006-07 and 2007-08.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

It is observed that the aforesaid college/ Institute has not submitted their proposals for approval of admission in time. In view of this Samiti decided in its meeting held on 1st September 2012 to charge penalty of Rs. 5,000/- per year for the process of approval of admission for academic year 2006-07, 2007-08 and 2008-09 for late submission of proposal for approving admissions.

After deliberation, Samiti directs the aforesaid college/ Institute to pay the penalties for the Academic Year 2006-07, 2007-08 and 2008-09. Samiti to be kept informed of whether penalties have been paid or not.

Item No. 6(f) : **Letter dated 9th May 2013 received from Poojya Sane Guruji Vidya Prasarak Mandal, College of Education, Nandurbar requesting to approve non CET admissions for Academic Year 2012-13.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference. As decided at Item No. 6(c) above.

Item No. 6(g) : **Letter dated 14th June 2013 received from N.L. Dalmia Institute of Management Studies and Research, Mumbai informing the details of MMS admission process under Minority Category for the Academic Year 2013-14.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference. Samiti noted it.

Item No. 7 : **To consider and decide on the following matter with the permission of the Chair.**

Item No. 7(a): **Letter dated 18th June 2013 received from Aditya Institute of management Studies and Research, Mumbai regarding delay in submission of admission details for the Academic Year 2012-13.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

It is observed that the aforesaid college/Institute has not given any cogent and just reason for non- submission of admission details online and for late submission of their admission details for the Academic year 2012-13.
