**Item No. 4 :** **To Consider and Decide on the Letters / representations received :-**

**Item No. 4(a):** **Letter dated 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2013 received from Vidya Pratishthan's College of Engineering, Baramati Pune, in respect of decision taken by Samiti in its meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> March 2013 (at Item no. 4[b]) regarding admission at Institute level (Mechanical Engineering course for the Academic year 2011-12) along with the observations report submitted by Directorate of Technical Education, M.S. vide its letter dated 26<sup>th</sup> August 2013.**

Samiti perused the aforesaid letter under reference.

Shri Tilekar Jayshankar Dhanesh was admitted to Second Year (Mechanical Engineering course) by direct admission process. He belonged to scheduled Tribe Category. Since he happened to be from Karnataka state could not produce the Caste Validity Certificate. His admission against a reserved seat was therefore liable for cancellation. However the college has requested to treat the admission against the seats meant to be filled in at Institute level seats.

Director Technical Education has vide his letter dated 26/8/2013 requested to regularize the admission treating it as against the seats meant to be filled in at Institute level seats, Request has been made in view of the fact that the First term was already over.

Samiti does not concur with the views of the director, in view of the fact that the earlier decision was taken by Samiti on the basis of information supplied by director only.

Samiti Further Observes that Candidates admitted in Direct Second Year Engineering courses were not required to qualify in any CET for such admissions.

In view of the foregoing, after deliberation Samiti therefore concludes that the admission process for 2<sup>nd</sup> year Engineering Courses does not come within the purview of Samiti not with standing the fact that Samiti does not concur with the recommendations of the director as above.

**Item No. 4(b):** **Letter dated 12<sup>th</sup> September 2013 received from Directorate of Sports and youth, Pune regarding verification of merit list of professional courses for the Academic year 2013-14 by Higher and Technical Education Department, M.S.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference received from Directorate of Sports and Youth, Pune regarding verification of merit list of professional courses for the Academic Year 2013-14 by Higher and Technical Education Department, M.S.

Samiti also perused letters of Deputy Secretary, Department of School Education & Sports, Maharashtra and Gazette Certificate of Govt. of Maharashtra.

After deliberation, Samiti directs as under:

**For Sports Education Courses**

Experts Committee (PNS) shall be headed by Director, Higher Education, M.S. Pune. Director, Higher Education, will appoint two other members who shall be drawn from the officers of Higher Education Department and who shall be not below the ranks of Dy. Director.

- a) Committee will check & verify admissions done through CAP process for private B.P.ED./M.P.Ed Colleges / Institutes, who have joined Govt. CET. Where the admissions are done in violation of triple test criterion, same are to be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- b) Committee will check & verify admissions granted through CAP process in private unaided B.P.Ed./ M.P.Ed Colleges / Institutes and those who opted for CET conducted by Universities, Private Associations. Where admissions are done in violation of triple test criterion, same are to be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- c) Committee will submit overall verification report of admissions for AY 2013-14 to Samiti before 15th December 2013.

**Schedule for Submission of Online Admissions details**

- 1) All Colleges / Institutes shall submit the lists of admissions online only within 15 days to PNS immediately after the admissions are over for the academic year.
- 2) Expert Committees i.e. Director, Technical Education, Director, Higher Education, as the case may be after verification of the proposals shall submit or reports to PNS before 15<sup>th</sup> December every year for approval of Samiti,
- 3) Colleges / Institutes submitting their admission details online after due dates mentioned as above , penalty will be charged as under:-
  - a) Upto 30<sup>th</sup> October every year Rs. 10,000/- per course
  - b) Upto 30<sup>th</sup> November every year Rs. 50,000/- per course
- 4) After 31st March in case of failure / non observance of due dates same to be brought to the notice of PNS for further actions.

**Item No. 4(c): Letter dated 20<sup>th</sup> September 2013 received from Sau. Jaai Yashwantrao Mohite Shikshan Prasarak Mandal's, Satara asking for permission to admit the students on the basis of scores in CET Conducted by Association for B.Ed. course for the Academic Year 2013-14.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti observes that the Institute has admitted students on the basis of Scores in Government CET. Now it wants to admit candidates on the basis of scores in Asso – CET against remaining vacant seats.

Institute should satisfy itself that the List of students from Government CET is exhausted fully before admissions on the basis of scores in Asso.CET. It should produce sufficient evidence showing the list of Govt. CET as having exhausted fully. Admissions on the basis of scores in Asso.CET should satisfy the criteria of Triple Test as laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Case - T.M.A. Pai Foundation v. State of Karnataka, (2002)8 SCC 481.

**Item No. 5:** **To consider, discuss and decide about approval of the admissions to Higher and Technical Courses for the Academic Year 2012-13. (Shri. St. Gajanan Adhyapak (B.Ed.) College, Beed.**

Samiti perused the verification/observation report submitted by Expert committee i.e. Director, Higher Education.

Samiti after deliberation decides to approve eligibility and selection process of following college/Institute in Higher Education for AY 2012-13, Subject to the Expert Committee - i.e. Director, Higher Education or his Officers or the Competent Authorities sorting out and disposing off with the said discrepancies after appropriate compliances from respective institutions for Academic Year 2012-13.

**Item No. 6(i): Letter dated 10<sup>th</sup> September 2013 received from Womens B.Ed. College, Aurangabad requesting to admit Candidates (for Marathi Medium Batch) from Maharashtra Vinaanudanit Adhyapak Mahavidyalaya Sansthachalak Association CET for Academic Year 2013-14.**

Samiti perused letter dated 10<sup>th</sup> September 2013 received from Women's B.Ed. College, Aurangabad requesting to admit Candidates (for Marathi Medium Batch) from Maharashtra Vinaanudanit Adhyapak Mahavidyalaya Sansthachalak Association CET for Academic Year 2013-14.

Samiti observes that the Institute has admitted students on the basis of Scores in Government CET. Now it wants to admit candidates on the basis of scores in Asso – CET against remaining vacant seats.

Institute should satisfy itself that the List of students from Government CET is exhausted fully before admissions on the basis of scores in Asso.CET. It should produce sufficient evidence showing the list of Govt. CET as having exhausted fully. Admissions on the basis of scores in Asso.CET should satisfy the criteria of Triple Test as laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Case - T.M.A. Pai Foundation v. State of Karnataka, (2002) 8 SCC 481.

**Item No. 6(ii): Letter dated 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2013 received from Jeevan Vikas Pratishthan Latur, requesting to extend date of B.Ed. CET for Admissions to B.Ed. Special Course (Deaf & Dumb) for Academic Year 2013-14.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti concludes that at this stage attendance of students for minimum 210 days as per NCTE norms, for completing the academic session for B.Ed. course was practically not possible.

In view of the above Samiti rejects the prayer of the college to admit the students now.

**Item No. 6(iii): Letter Dated 24/9/2013 received from Sadhana Education Society, Thane affiliated by Mumbai University vide Letter no. AFF/ICD/2013-14/1896 dated 23/09/2013 requesting to permit the admissions of B.Ed. for Academic Year 2013-14.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti concludes that at this stage attendance of students for minimum 210 days as per NCTE norms, for completing the academic session for B.Ed. course was practically not possible.

In view of the above Samiti rejects the prayer of the college to admit the students now.

**Item No. 6(iv): Letter Dated 19 August 2013 received from Maharashtra Vinaanudanit Adhyapak Mahavidyalaya Sansthachalak Association, Pune asking for permission to conduct Second CET for B.Ed. Course for Academic Year 2013-14.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Maharashtra Vinaanudanit Adhyapak Mahavidyalaya Sansthachalak Association has asked for a permission to conduct Second CET for B.Ed. Course for Academic Year 2013-14. However the representative of the Association communicated to the office that the said request to conduct second CET was not meant to be placed before the committee for its approval. This was therefore not placed before the Samiti in previous meeting.

Samiti went through the letter dated 26<sup>th</sup> September 2013 Submitted by the Association. Association states that if Government of Maharashtra directs the Universities to Extend the Schedule of the Academic Year, requirement of 210 days for completing Academic Session will be fulfilled. Association has requested to permit the colleges to admit Non – Zero CET students for B.Ed. course in AY. 2013-14 also.

Cut off date for B.Ed. course admission is already over. At this stage minimum attendance of (210 days) for completing the academic session of B.Ed. course was practically impossible.

Samiti therefore rejects the prayer of the Association. Samiti also rejects the request to allow colleges to admit Non-Zero CET Candidates for B.Ed. course for AY. 2013-14.

**Item No. 6(v): Letter dated 21 September 2013 received from Maharashtra Sharirik Shikshanshastra Mahavidyalaya Vyavasthapan Mahasangh, Pune regarding details in respect of CET'S conducted for for B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed. Course for the Academic Year 2013-14. (Ref. Letter no. Asso. CET /2013/4636 dated 21/9/2013)**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti observes as follows -

- 1) Samiti allowed conducting CET on 4<sup>th</sup> August 2013, as per the Schedule submitted by Mahasangh on 27/12/2012.
- 2) Maharashtra Sharirik Shikshanshastra Mahavidyalaya Vyavasthapan Mahasangh, Pune then requested to change CET Schedule vide letter dated 31/7/2013. Date of CET was scheduled on 25<sup>th</sup> August 2013.
- 3) Samiti in its meeting of 6<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2013 resolved as under -

***"Samiti ratifies the decision of approval of revised schedule for B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed. CET for the Academic year 2013-14. Samiti directs the Association not to submit the prayer for reconsideration or a revised schedule again."***

- 4) Maharashtra Sharirik Shikshanshastra Mahavidyalaya Vyavasthapan Mahasangh, Pune changed their Schedule again vide letter dated 21/9/2013.
