- 1) In respect of Asso. CET for M. Pharm it is seen that 931 students were qualified. However only 345 and 89 students were allotted to colleges in round I and II. Association should explain the circumstances as to why it did not allot sufficient students in spite of the fact that 931 students were qualified.
- 2) In respect of Asso. CET for B.Ed. & M.Ed. it is seen that 22036 & 2294 students were qualified in the examination. However 11874 & 905 students were allotted to colleges in round I and II. Association should explain the circumstances as to why it did not allot sufficient students in spite of the fact that more students were qualified.
- 3) MASA should submit the List of applications having applied for admissions in furtherance of qualifying examination conducted by NATA showing their merit wise seniority.

Item No. 4(a): To discuss, consider and ratify decision taken on circulatory submission on 6th August 2013 regarding Third CET for admissions to MBA course for the Academic Year 2013-14.

Samiti perused the letter received from Association of Management of MBA/MMS Institutes (AMMI) requesting to allow to conduct Third CET for admissions to MBA course for Academic Year 2013-14. It was circulated amongst the members as a circulatory submission dated 6th August 2013.

After deliberation Samiti ratifies the decision of granting permission to conduct a 3rd CET for MBA Course for Academic Year 2013-14. Samiti makes it clear that this being the last chance for the academic year 2013-14; this should not be treated as a precedent in the years to come.

Item No. 4(b): To discuss, consider and ratify the decision taken on circulatory submission on 6th August 2013 regarding change of schedule in B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed. CET and admission process for the Academic Year 2013-14.

Samiti perused the letter received from Maharashtra Sharirik Shikshanshastra Mahavidyalaya Vyavasthapan Mahasangh, Pune conveying change of schedule in B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed. CET for the Academic year 2013-14. It was circulated amongst the members of Samiti as a circulatory Submission dated 6th August 2013.

After deliberation Samiti ratifies the decision of approval of revised schedule for B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed. CET for the Academic year 2013-14. Samiti directs the Association not to submit the prayer for a reconsideration or a revised schedule again.

Item No. 4(c): To discuss, consider and ratify the decision taken on circulatory submission on 6th August 2013 regarding appointment of Observer for CET and Oral examination for admissions to B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses for Academic Year 2013-14.

Samiti perused the letter received from Directorate of Higher Education, Pune regarding appointments of Observers for CET and Oral examinations for admissions to B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses for Academic Year 2013-14. This was circulated amongst the members of Samiti as a circulatory Submission dated 6th August 2013.

After deliberation Samiti ratifies the decision of appointing Observers for CET and Oral Examinations for admissions to B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses for Academic Year 2013-14. Director Higher Education should submit his consolidated report about his remarks and observations over the process.

Item No. 4(d): To discuss, consider and ratify the decision taken on circulatory submission on 6th August 2013 regarding non acceptance of application form for B.Architecture admission course for the Academic Year 2013-14 of Kum. Aishwariya Satish Bidri.

Samiti perused the letter received from Kum. Aishwariya Satish Bidri regarding non acceptance of application form for B.Architecture admission course for the Academic Year 2013-14. This was circulated amongst the members of Samiti as a circulatory Submission dated 6th August 2013.

After deliberation Samiti ratifies the decision of confirming the action of college authorities not accepting the application of the candidate in view of the fact that such reservation rules were not provided for after 2nd round.

Item No. 5: **To consider and decide on the Letters / representations received :-**

Item No. 5(a): **Letter dated 18th July 2013 received from Directorate of Higher Education, Maharashtra State requesting to reconsider the earlier decision taken by Samiti in its meeting held on 24th June 2013 (at Item No. 6[c]) regarding admissions of B.Ed. course on the basis of Non Zero CET and/or Non CET for the Academic Year 2012-13.**

Samiti perused the letter received from Directorate of Higher Education, Maharashtra State requesting to reconsider the earlier decision taken by Samiti in its meeting held on 24th June 2013 (at Item No. 6[c]) regarding admissions of B.Ed. course on the basis of Non Zero CET and/or Non CET for the Academic Year 2012-13.

After deliberation Samiti decides as under:

1. Director, Higher Education to ensure that all CET Meritorious Candidates were allotted in CAP processes for the Academic Year 2012-13.
2. After Exhausting of List of CET Meritorious students only CET appeared (Non –Zero) students were allowed to be admitted in B.Ed. Course for the Academic Year 2012-13.
3. This is not to be treated as a precedent in the years to come.

Item No. 5(b): **Letter dated 13th July 2013 received from Association of Minority Pharmacy Colleges, Akkalkuwa asking for M.Pharm – AMPCA-CET-2013 and CAP-2013 for the Year 2013-14.**

Samiti perused the letter received from Association of Minority Pharmacy Colleges, Akkalkuwa asking for M.Pharm – AMPCA-CET-2013 and CAP-2013 for the Year 2013-14.

1. The Order delivered on 16th of January 2012 by National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions in CASE No. 2334 of 2012 has been challenge by PNS before the Hon'ble high court vide Petition No. 6469/2013.
2. Samiti has in its meeting held on 24th June 2013 (at Item no. 5[f]) decided as under -

"Samiti decides that there being no provision for separate CET for Minority Quota Admissions, Request of the aforesaid College/ Institute to conduct CET for Minority Quota admission for the Academic Year 2013-14 stands rejected."

In consideration of the above and in view of the fact that the order cited in para. 1 above was for AY 2012-13, after deliberation, Samiti comes to the conclusion that the decision taken by Samiti in its meeting held on 24th June 2013 (at Item no 5[f]) for AY. 2013-14 warrants no change.

Item No. 5(c): Letter dated nil received from Maharashtra Sharirik Shikshanshastra Mahavidyalaya Vyavasthapan Mahasangh, Pune asking to enlist new College – P.E.S. College of Physical Education, Aurangabad for admissions to M.P.Ed. course for the Academic Year 2013-14.

Samiti perused the letter received from Maharashtra Sharirik Shikshanshastra Mahavidyalaya Vyavasthapan Mahasangh, Pune asking to enlist the new College – P.E.S. College of Physical Education, Aurangabad for admissions to M.P.Ed. Course for the Academic Year 2013-14.

After deliberation Samiti decides that the said college not having asked for enlisting; question of allowing the association to enlist it does not arise.

Item No. 5(d) : Letter dated 7th August 2013 received Maharashtra Vinaanudan Adhyapak Mahavidyalaya Sansthachalak Association, Pune regarding submission of compliance report in respect of deficiency pointed out by Samiti for the Admission of B.Ed. Courses for the Academic Year 2012-13.

Samiti perused the letter received from Maharashtra Vinaanudan Adhyapak Mahavidyalaya Sansthachalak Association, Pune regarding submission of compliance report in respect of deficiencies pointed out by Samiti for the Admission of B.Ed. Courses for the Academic Year 2012-13.

Samiti feels that the Compliance report in respect of deficiencies needs to be verified by Expert Committee i.e. Directorate Higher Education, Pune.

After deliberation Samiti directs the Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Higher Education, Maharashtra State to verify and submit the verification report to Samiti office early. Thereafter it be placed before Samiti for its consideration.

Item No. 5(e): Letter dated 30th July 2013 received from Management Association of MCA Institutes, Ahmednagar submitting the affidavit as per the conditions laid down by Samiti (at agenda item No. 6[c]) while permitting Second CET of MAMI-MCA-CET for admissions to MCA course for the Academic Year 2013-14.

Samiti perused the Affidavit submitted by Management Association of MCA Institutes, Ahmednagar. It is in compliance of the conditions laid down by Samiti (at agenda item No. 6[c]) while permitting Second CET of MAMI-MCA-CET for admissions to MCA course for the Academic Year 2013-14.

After deliberation Samiti directs the Association to Submit the College wise Merit List of Qualified students those appeared for first CET.

Item No. 5(f) : Letter dated 23rd July 2013 received from Aditya Institute of Management Studies and Research, Mumbai requesting to consider the applications sympathetically in respect of penalties for late online submission of admission details in respect of decision taken by the Samiti in its meeting held on 24th June 2013 (at Item No. 7[a]) regarding delay in submission of admission details for the Academic Year 2012-13.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

It is observed that the aforesaid College/Institute has not given any cogent and just reason for late submission of its admission details for the Academic Year 2012-13.

After deliberation, Samiti therefore decides not to accede to the request made by colleges/Institutes to waive the penalty for late submission of online submission of merit List and acceptance of merit List for Academic Year 2012 – 13.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberation, Samiti concludes that the issue of conversion of admission from NT-D to open category does not come within the purview of the Samiti.

Samiti perused the letter received from Ali Allana College of Pharmacy, Nandurbar, Nandurbar requesting to approve the admissions of 02 students admitted in M.Pharmacy course on the basis of AMPCA-CET for the Academic Year 2012-13 and the decision of National Commission for Minority Educational Institutes, New Delhi, case No. 2334/2012.

1. The Order delivered on 16th of January 2012 by National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions in CASE No. 2334 of 2012 has been challenged by PNS before the Hon'ble high court vide Petition No. 6469/2013,
2. Request of the aforesaid College/ Institute to conduct CET for Minority Quota admissions for the Academic Year 2012-13 was rejected in Samiti Meeting held on 16th July 2012 at Item No. 4(f)
3. Samiti observes that these 02 students were admitted through AMPCA-CET and the said CET was not approved by PNS for the Academic Year 2012-13.

In view of the above now there remains no question to approve these admissions.

a) Upto 15th October every year Rs. 10,000/- per course

b) Upto 30th November every year Rs. 50,000/- per course"

In view of the above after deliberation, Samiti decides not to accede to the request made by college/Institute to waive the penalty for late submission of online submission of merit List for Academic Year 2013 – 14. in spite of the fact that the reasons quoted by the institute appear to be bonafide.
