1. Appendix – 7 of the said notification laying Norms and standards for bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed.) Degree, Rule 2.1 for Duration of the course reads as under_____

"2.1 Duration

The B.P.Ed. Programme shall be of duration of two academic years or of four semesters. However, the students shall be permitted to complete the programme requirements within a maximum of three years from the date of admission to the programme."

2. Appendix – 8 of the said notification laying Norms and standards for Master of Physical Education (M.P.Ed.) Degree, Rule 2.1 for Duration of the course reads as under_____

"2.1 Duration

The M.P.Ed. programme shall be of a duration of two academic years or four semesters. However, the students shall be permitted to complete the programme within a maximum period of three years."

In light of the foregoing after deliberation, Samiti directs the aforesaid Association to submit its say on the contents of the said Notifications of National Council for Teacher Education. After receipt of the same it be placed before Samiti for its consideration.
