- 2) Association at Sr. No. 5 should submit the information in column in 6,7 & 9 within one week.
- 3) Association at Sr. No. 6 should submit the information in column in 4 to 7 & 9 within one week.

**Item No. 3:** **To consider, discuss and decide about the process of verification of merit List and admission of all Higher and Technical Courses for A.Y. 2012-13 ( i.e. MBA MCA / M. Engineering/M.Pharmacy/M.Architecture/ B. Architecture /B. Engineering /B.Pharmacy /B. H.M.C.T./ B.Architecture /B.Ed. /M.Ed./ B.P.Ed./ M.P.Ed. etc.)**

After deliberations, Samiti resolves as under:

**A) For Technical Education Courses**

Expert committee (PNS) shall be headed by the Director, Technical Education, M.S.. The Director, Technical Education will appoint two other members who shall be drawn from the officers of Technical Education Department and who shall be not below the ranks of Dy. Director.

- a) Committee will verify the merit lists of the admitted students, where the admissions have been granted through CAP process for First Year & Direct Second Year in Engg/ B.Pharm, first year in MBA/ MCA/ M.Pharmacy/ M.Architecture/ B.Architecture/ B.HMCT, Where the admissions are done in violation of merit criterion, same be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- b) Committee will verify the merit lists of the admitted students, where the admissions done through institute level, minority quota and other admissions in First Year & Direct Second Year in Engg/ B.Pharm, first year in MBA/ MCA/ M.Pharmacy/ M.Architecture/ B.Architecture/ B.HMCT, Where the admissions are done in violation of merit criterion, same be brought to the notice of Samiti .
- c) Committee will verify the merit lists of the admitted students , where the admission through institute level in M.E. courses, Where the admissions are done in violation of merit criterion, same be brought to the notice of Samiti .
- d) Committee will verify the merit list of the admitted students, where the admissions done through institute level, minority and other admissions done in CAP as well as without CAP Where the admissions are done in violation of merit criterion, same be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- e) Committee will submit overall verification report of admissions done in AY 2012-13 to Samiti before **15th December 2012.**

In case of **Diploma admissions** i.e. Polytechnic, D.Pharmacy, D.HMCT etc. done on 10<sup>th</sup> level/12<sup>th</sup> level bases without any CET and these Institutes does not come under any University, the verification of these admissions will be done at Joint Director level.

**B) For Higher Education Courses**

Expert Committee (PNS) shall be headed by The Director, Higher Education, M.S. Pune. The Director, Higher Education will appoint two other members who shall be drawn from the officers of Higher Education Department and who shall be not below the ranks of Dy. Director.

- a) Committee will check & verify the admissions granted through CAP process for the private B.ED. Colleges / Institute, who have joined the Govt. CET conducted by the Director, Higher Education, Where the admissions are done in violation of merit criterion, same be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- b) Committee will check & verify the admissions done in private B.Ed. Colleges/ Institutes, who have joined the Asso-CET and the CAP conducted by Association, Where the admissions are done in violation of merit criterion, same be brought to the notice of Samiti .
- c) Committee will check & verify the admissions granted through CAP process for the private M.ED. Colleges / Institutes, who have joined the Govt. CET conducted by the Director, Higher Education, Where the admissions are done in violation of merit criterion, same be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- d) Committee will check & verify the admissions granted through CAP process for the private M.ED. Colleges / Institutes, who have joined the Asso. CET conducted by Association, Where the admissions are done in violation of merit criterion, same be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- e) Committee will submit overall verification report of admissions done in AY 2012-13 to Samiti before **15<sup>th</sup> December 2012.**

### **C) For Sports Education Courses**

Experts Committee (PNS) shall be headed by the Director, Sports & Youth services, M.S., Pune. The Director, Sports & Youth services will appoint two other members who shall be drawn from the officers of Sports & Youth services Department and who shall be not below the ranks of Dy. Director.

- a) Committee will check & verify the admissions granted through CAP process for the private B.P. ED./M.P.Ed Colleges / Institute, who have joined the Govt. CET conducted by the Director, Sports & Youth services, Where the admissions are done in violation of merit criterion, same be brought to the notice of Samit.
- b) Committee will check & verify admissions granted through CAP process in private unaided B.P.Ed./ M.P.Ed Colleges / Institutes and those who opted for CET conducted by Universities, Private Association. Where admissions are done in violation of triple test, same be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- c) Committee will submit overall verification report of admissions done in AY 2012-13 to Samiti before **15th December 2012.**

### **D) Schedule for Submission of Proposal for Approval of Admissions**

- 1) All Colleges / Institutes shall submit the lists of admissions online or in person within 15 days to PNS immediately after the admissions are over for the academic year.
- 2) Expert Committee after verification of the proposals shall submit its reports to PNS before 15st December every year.

- 3) All Colleges / Institutes shall submit their proposals for approval of admissions on or before 31st January every year. Copy to be endorsed to respective Directorates.
- 4) Where Colleges / Institutes submit their proposals for approval of admissions after the due dates mentioned in 3 above, penalty will be charged as under:-
  - a) Upto 28th February every year Rs. 10,000/- per course
  - b) Upto 31st March every year Rs. 50,000/- per course
- 5) After 31st March in case of failure / non observance of due dates same to be brought to the notice of PNS for further actions such as disaffiliation/ Non-approval of admissions etc...

**Item No. 4(a) :      Letter dated 19<sup>th</sup> June 2012 received from VMV Commerce, JMT Arts & JJP Science College Institute of Computer Studies and Research Nagpur, asking for Permission to directly admit 10% more seats in MCA Part – II in addition to actual sanctioned intake capacity, as per RTM Nagpur University Notification Direction No. 12 of 2007.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberation Samiti decide not to accede to the request made by aforesaid College to admit directly 10% more seats in MCA Part II in addition to the sanctioned intake capacity.

**Item No. 4(b) :      Letter dated 26<sup>th</sup> June 2012 received from Bharati Vidyapeeth College of Architecture Navi Mumbai, requesting to regularize admission of Omkar A. Haryan done in Course B.Arch. for A.Y. 2010-11 in OBC Quota.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

It is observed that the said candidate is admitted in B.Architecture course for the Academic Year 2010-11 under OBC category and he is not in a position to submit the Caste Validity Certificate.

After deliberation, Samiti decides that the said issue does not come within the purview of this Samiti. The candidate can approach the appropriate authority for the appropriate remedy.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberation, Samiti decides to send the said matter to Directorate of Technical Education, Maharashtra State to verify the admissions whether done on merit basis or not.

**Item No. 4(d) :** Letter dated 16<sup>th</sup> June 2012 received from Association of Unaided Private Pharmacy Colleges Wardha, regarding appointment of observer for M.Pharm. ASSO-CET-2012 along with Hon'ble chairman's note.

Samiti perused the letters under reference.

As per the orders of the Hon'ble Chairman on the office note dated 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2012. Dr. K.M. Kulkarni, Member of the Samiti was to work as an observer for M.Pharm. Asso-CET-2012. Observations/comments of Dr. Kulkarni are yet to be received. After receipt of the same, it be placed before the Samiti for its consideration.

**Item No. 4(e) :** Letter dated 27<sup>th</sup> June 2012 received from Directorate of Technical Education Mumbai in respect of remarks/comments on draft brochure of Maharashtra Association of Schools of Architecture (MASA) for admission process of B. Architecture for academic year 2012-13.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberation Samiti directs MASA to modify the draft broucher according to remarks/comments dated 27<sup>th</sup> June 2012 submitted by Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai.

**Item No. 4(f) :** Letter dated 27<sup>th</sup> June 2012 received from Directorate of Technical Education Mumbai in respect of remarks/comments on draft brochure. of M. Pharm. AMPCMA CET & CAP – 2012.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberation, Samiti directs the Association of Minority Pharmacy Colleges of Maharashtra to follow the directions/instruction given by the directorate vide its aforesaid letter under reference, the extract of which are as under:-

After deliberation, Samiti decides to note the contents of the aforesaid letter submitted by Maharashtra Sharirik Shikshan Shastra Mahavidyalaya Vyavasthapan Mahasangh.

**Item No. 4(i) :** Letter Dated 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2012 from Vidyavardhini College of Engineering & Technology Thane regarding the Institute Level Quota to be fixed at 33 1/3 % seats for ordinary Candidates and 5% Quota for NRI Candidates from Sanctioned Intake.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberations, Samiti directs the aforesaid College/Institute to approach the Directorate of Technical Education, Maharashtra State .

**Item No. 4(j) :** Letter/Verification Report Dated 25<sup>th</sup> Jan 2012 Submitted by Directorate of Technical Education Mumbai regarding admissions done non-minority candidates in minority quota without permission of minority Development department of Maharashtra state in Shah & Anchor Kutchhi Engineering College for A.Y. 2011-12.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

It is observed that the Mahavir Education Trust's Shah and Anchor Kachhi Engineering College, Chembur, Mumbai has admitted non-minority candidate in

minority Quota without permission of Minority Development Department, Maharashtra State for the Academic Year 2011-12.

Samiti therefore directs the aforesaid Institute to get the appropriate permission from the Minority Development Department, Maharashtra State for these admissions. Thereafter same Samiti will take the appropriate decision.

**Item No. 5 :** **To consider, discuss and decide about approval of admissions to first year/direct second year of Technical Education Courses for the Academic Year 2011-12.**

### **TECHNICAL EDUCATION**

Samiti perused observations report of Expert Committee appointed by the Samiti. After going through it Director, Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai having found certain discrepancies in admission process of 06 colleges/Institutes, after deliberation, Samiti decides to approve eligibility and selection process of following 06 colleges/Institutes in Technical Education for Academic Year 2011-12, Subject to the Expert Committee – Director, Technical Education, Mumbai or his Officers or the Competent Authorities sorting out and disposing off with the said discrepancies after appropriate compliances from respective institutions for Academic Year 2011-12, enclosed as "**ANNEXURE – A**" within three weeks.

The course wise summary of the above is as under:

**Item No.6:** **To consider and decide on the following matter with the permission of the Chair.**

**Item No. 6(a) : Letter dated 24<sup>th</sup> June 2012 received from Maharashtra Sharirik Shikshanshatstra Mahavidyalaya Vyavsthapan Mahasangh, Pune in respect of the decision taken by the Samiti in its meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> April 2012 (at Item No. 4).**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Points raised by Samiti in its meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> April 2012 (Item no. 4), an explanation given by the Mahasangh and the decision of Samiti are as under:-

*Point No. 1. It is to be ensured that the admissions are done in only those colleges/institutions who are approved by the National Council For Teachers Education, Bhopal and Sanctioned by the State Government and affiliated to Universities.*

*Explanation :-* We the Association have properly take care of the above subject all the colleges annexed to us are properly verified and documentation received by our experts. We have taken the authority letters of all the colleges and checked it in the proper sequel and also take care to see the legal part of it as per approval affiliation and sanctioned by the State Government in respect of all the colleges under the Association. We have since last every year submitted the letters of approval and also the updaters of the NCTE , Bhopal on the internet and also mentioning the web link.ncte.org. which clearly describes the position and approval of the all colleges under the Association CET. And also inspected nad clear observation by our Association team members who are especially appointed for the work of Association CET.

It is observed that Colleges listed **Annexure -B** have not submitted permissions from NCTE, Bhopal, Colleges have not submitted the university affiliations of remaining 40 B.P.Ed. and 07 M.P.Ed. Colleges as listed in **Annexure -C**.

Samiti directs Colleges to produce the appropriate permissions of NCTE. Samiti also directs to submit university affiliations.

*Point No.2 Total admissions done as provided b rule 10.11 of the brochure 2011-12 approved by the Samiti in B. P.Ed. and M.P. Ed. outside Maharashtra State candidate more than 2%. This needs to be properly explained by Association and Associate colleges/institutes.*

*Explanation :-*Being the Associate, we are replying on behalf of all the colleges who have in any way admitted more students than the quota system. The fact which unchallenged is that the Association have published the advertisement in all the local newspapers and other states also. there are some students who have applied for the admissions and the seats were vacant with the colleges. The colleges have not in any sense violated the rights of the local students. The admissions were given on first come first serve basis only and its was better to admit the students rather to keep the seats vacant as the students admitted are the citizen of the State and not for foreigners. Thus keeping this view in the mind the students were admitted and unintentional.

Samiti directs Mahasangh to submit the advertisement copy which is published in all local news papers and also other States for admission to B.P.Ed. / M.P.Ed. in respect of out side of Maharatsra candidates. Mahasangh also needs to submit all other relevant documents and norms/procedure it followed for admissions.

*Point No.3 As per rule 10.6 of the brochures 2011-12 approved by Samiti in B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed. course over and above one admission is allowed for J & K candidate for per sanctioned batch. Following colleges had admitted more than one candidate in over and above quota. This needs to be properly explained.*

- a) Sadguru Education Society's College of Physical Education, Jalgaon -
- b) Late Madhuribai Deshmukh Sharirik Shikshan Mahavidyalaya, Hingana Road, Nagpur
- c) Ranibai Agnihotri Sharirik Shikshan Mahavidyalaya, Ramnagar, Wardha.
- d) Rani Laxmibai College of Physical Education, Sawargaon, Narkhed, Nagpur
- e) Hanuman Vyayam Shala Krida Mandal's Physical Education College, Yavatmal

*Explanation* :The points raised by the Samiti is true and correct but taking into consideration that as per the Government Resolution and Resolution and letter of Secretary of the State No. D.O.No.F10-1/2009, Desk (u) dated 31.03.2009, New Delhi. Some colleges of the Association have cancelled the admissions of the excess students but taking into the directions of the Central Government and the letters issued by them the admission are carried on and in continuance as the quota and other fundamentals principles as regard to J&K students are liberal and certain benefits being granted by the State they can not be over ruled as it is directly related to their fundamental principals of law as guaranteed by the Constitution of India. Also taking into consideration that it is almost time passed it would amount to a grave injustice to those candidates, securing the future of such candidates a last chance may be granted to continue with their admission and already some colleges have cancelled.

After delibretion, Samiti decides that admissions referred above can not be regularized.

Samiti expresses its displeasure over the way these admissions are done and warns Mahasangh to ensure that the Colleges incorporated in its lists are having all permissions,affiliations of the respective authorities and/or universities and also ensure allotment of students to those colleges only.

**Item No. 6(b) : Letter dated 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2012 bearing No. प्रवेश २०१२/प्र.क्र. ७७/मशि-२, signed by Joint Secretary, Higher and Technical Education Department, Government of Maharashtra in respect of the Management Quota in B.Ed. courses Colleges for the Academic Year 2011-12.**

Samiti perused and seen the letter under reference.

In furtherance of its meetings held on 17<sup>th</sup> January 2012, 5<sup>th</sup> March 2012 and 18<sup>th</sup> April 2012 and Government resolution No. 1) बी.एड. २०११/प्र.क्र. ४९/मशि-२, दिनांक ४ मे २०११ and 2) क्र. एन.जी.सी. २००४/(४१/०४) /मशि-३, दिनांक १६ फेब्रुवारी २००४. Samiti observes as under :-

- 1) Hon'ble Justice Dr. B.V. Ghanekar, (Retd.) has given his legal opinion in the said matter on 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2010
- 2) Hon'ble High Court has passed the orders in Writ Petition No. 5254 of 2009 on 7/5/2010 and in Writ Petition No. 5355 of 2010 on 12<sup>th</sup> July 2010.

- 3) The National Council for Teacher Education, Bhopal (NCTE) notified its regulations on 25<sup>th</sup> August 2010.
- 4) Government of Maharashtra issued its resolution bearing no. बी.एड. २०११/प्र.क्र. ४९/मशि-२, on 4<sup>th</sup> May 2011.

GR referred above allows institutes to have Management Quota. On the other hand National Council for Technical Education, (NCTE) Bhopal vide its regulation No. 51-3/2009/Pt/NCTE(N&S), dated 25/08/2010 in view of provisions of rule No. 4(5)(i) does not allow any Management Quota seats. Samiti observes that the direction in GR cited above does not match with these regulations framed by NCTE.

Samiti in its meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> March 2012 (at Item No. 4) has directed the Director of Higher Education, Pune to approach the concerned authorities for the clarifications in respect of Government resolution dated 4<sup>th</sup> May 2011 and guidelines of National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi (NCTE) dated 25<sup>th</sup> August 2010 regarding 20% management quota seats.

Letter under reference signed by joint secretary, does not appear to have taken cognizance of NCTE regulations. It also fails to consider the contradictions in GR and NCTE regulations. Further Legal opinion of Dr. B.V. Ghanekar is of 2/8/2010. Whereas NCTE regulations came in to force w.e.f 25/8/2010. Considering this; we come to the conclusion that in view of NCTE regulations management quota w.e.f 25/8/2010 cannot be allowed.

Therefore after deliberation, Samiti decides that the decision taken by Samiti in the earlier meetings held on 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2011, 17<sup>th</sup> January 2012, 5<sup>th</sup> March 2012 and 18<sup>th</sup> April 2012 warrants no change. All decisions of the Committee those were taken herein before in respect of 20% Management Quota in B.Ed. course for the Academic Year 2011-12 stand as they are without any alterations, modifications, etc.

The next meeting of the Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti (Higher & Technical Education) would be decide in due course of the time..
