**Item No. 3(a) :** **Where there are no discrepancies considering the criteria on triple test as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.**

**TECHNICAL EDUCATION**

Samiti perused the observations of Expert Committee appointed by Samiti. After going through it and on the basis of compliance made by individual Colleges/Institutes, office of the Director, Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai having found no discrepancies in admission process of following 64

Colleges/Institutes, Samiti, on the basis of fulfillment of the conditions of triple test, as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and having found no discrepancy, decides to approve the eligibility and selection process of the following 64 Colleges/Institutes in Technical Education for Academic Year 2011-12, enclosed as **"ANNEXURE – A"**.

### **HIGHER EDUCATION**

Samiti perused Government resolution No. 1) बी.एड. २०११/प्र.क्र. ४९/मशि-२, दिनांक ४ मे २०११ and 2) क्र. एन.जी.सी. २००४/(४१/०४) /मशि-३, दिनांक १६ फेब्रुवारी २००४. It allows institutes to have Management Quota. On the other hand National Council for Teacher Education, (NCTE) Bhopal vide its regulation No. 51-3/2009/Pt/NCTE(N&S), dated 25/08/2010 rule No. 4(5)(i) does not allow any Management Quota seats. Samiti observes that the direction in GR cited above do not match with these regulations framed by NCTE.

In view of the above, after deliberation, on the basis of fulfillment of the conditions of triple test, as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the Expert Committee i.e. Director Higher Education, Pune having found no discrepancy, Samiti decides to approve the eligibility and selection process of the following 148 Colleges/Institutes in Higher Education for Academic Year 2011-12, except management quota seats, enclosed as **"ANNEXURE – B"**

### **TECHNICAL EDUCATION**

Samiti perused observations report of Expert Committee appointed by the Samiti. After going through it Director, Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai having found certain discrepancies in admission process of 368 colleges/Institutes, after deliberation, Samiti decides to approve eligibility and selection process of following 364 colleges/Institutes in Technical Education for

Academic Year 2010-11, Subject to the Expert Committee – Director, Technical Education, Mumbai or his Officers or the Competent Authorities sorting out and disposing off with the said discrepancies after appropriate compliances from respective institutions for Academic Year 2011-12 enclose as **"ANNEXURE – C"**.

The course wise summary of the above is as under:

Samiti perused Government resolution No. 1) बी.एड. २०११/प्र.क्र. ४९/मशि-२, दिनांक ४ मे २०११ and 2) क्र. एन.जी.सी. २००४/(४१/०४)/मशि-३, दिनांक १६ फेब्रुवारी २००४. It allow institutes to have Management Quota. On the other hand National Council for Teacher Education, (NCTE) Bhopal vide its regulation No. 51-3/2009/Pt/NCTE(N&S), dated 25/08/2010 rule No. 4(5)(i) does not allow any Management Quota seats. Samiti observes that the direction in GR cited above do not match with these regulations framed by NCTE.

In view of the above, after deliberation, on the basis of fulfillment of the conditions of triple test, as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the Expert Committee i.e. Director Higher Education, Pune having discrepancy, Samiti decides to approve the eligibility and selection process of the following 78 Colleges/Institutes in Higher Education for Academic Year 2011-12, subject to the Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Higher Education, Pune or his officers or the Competent Authority sorting out and disposing of the said discrepancies after appropriate compliances from the respective institutes, except management quota seats, enclosed as **"ANNEXURE – D"**

After deliberation, Samiti decides to hear the Association in the next meeting along with their explanation.

**Item No. 3(c) : On proposals under scrutiny of the office.**

Samiti directs the office to scrutinize the proposals and thereafter submit them before Samiti for its consideration early. (List attached – **Annexure – F**)

**Item No. 3(d) : In respect of those who failed to submit their admission details within the stipulated time period given by the Samiti.**

After deliberation, Samiti decides to direct the authorities in the Government of Maharashtra, Appropriate Competent Authority and respective Universities for disaffiliation and/or disapproval of the admissions of those who failed to submit the proposals for approval of admission before the said date, to Samiti.

**Item No. 4 : To consider and decide on letter dated 27<sup>th</sup> February 2012 received from Dy. Director Sports and Youth Services, Pune indicating approval to the admissions of B.P.Ed./M.P.Ed. courses for Academic Year 2011-12.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti noted the contents with the following observations.

- 1) It is to be ensured that the admissions are done in only those Colleges/Institutes who are approved by National Council for Teacher Education, Bhopal, sanctioned by Government of Maharashtra and affiliated to universities.
- 2) Total admissions done as provided by rule 10.11 of the brochure 2011-12 approved by the Samiti in B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed. course outside of Maharashtra State candidates more than 2%. This needs to be properly explained by Association and Associate Colleges/Institutes.
- 3) As per rule 10.6 of the brochure 2011-12 approved by Samiti in B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed. course over and above one admission is allowed for J & K candidate for per sanctioned batch. Following colleges had admitted more than one candidate in over and above quota. This needs to be properly explained.
  - a) Sadguru Education Society's College of Physical Education, Jalgaon -
  - b) Late Madhuribai Deshmukh Sharirik Shikshan Mahavidyalaya, Hingana Road, Nagpur
  - c) Ranibai Agnihotri Sharirik Shikshan Mahavidyalaya, Ramnagar, Wardha.



- d) Rani Laxmibai College of Physical Education, Sawargaon, Narkhed, Nagpur
- e) Hanuman Vyayam Shala Krida Mandal's Physical Education College, Yavatmal

**Item No. 5: To consider and decide on the letters/representations received:-**

**Item No. 5(a) : Letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> January 2012 received from Management of Association of MCA Institutes (MAMI), along with the brochure of CET's – 2012 for MCA Courses, along with remark/suggestions submitted by Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai on the draft brochure of MAMI-MCA CET - 2012 vide its letter dated 13<sup>th</sup> March 2012.**

Samiti perused the letters under references.

After deliberation, Samiti decides to grant its permission to Management of Association of MCA Institutes (MAMI), Ahmednagar to conduct CET-2012 for admissions to MCA course for the Academic Year 2012-13

Considering the suggestions of Expert Committee on the draft brochure Samiti directs as under-

- a) CET/CAP should be conducted in fair and transparent manner and as per the directives, orders, norms, rules and regulations laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi, 2) Hon'ble High Courts, 3) Respective Councils, 4) Respective University, 5) Govt. of Maharashtra, 6) Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti, Maharashtra State and 7) Directorate of Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai.
- b) CET should be conducted at the centers located in non faculty Colleges and staff of examination i.e. Supervisor, Invigilator, Center In-charge and other staff should be drawn from non faculty.
- c) List of notified centers with details of seating arrangement made in each such centers and list of eligible candidates appearing for examination to be provided to Samiti. No. of seats available college wise to be provided to Samiti. This is to be submitted to Samiti before the date of examination.
- d) Schedule of CET should be as per directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi, if any.
- e) Result of CET should be displayed on website of the Association and the notice boards of participating Colleges/Institutes. Result of CET-2012 to be submitted to the Samiti office, within two days from the date of declaration of result.
- f) Association should ensure that allotment of students to colleges is made strictly as per merit and as per the options of choices exercised. Association





should also ensure that colleges must have submitted Fee Approval proposals to Shikshan Shulka Samiti, Maharashtra State for finalization of fees structure the Academic Year 2012-13. It is also to be ensured that allotment of students is done only the colleges those are affiliated to Council and University for the academic year 2012-13. Association should ensure that colleges submit the list of admissions within two days form the cut off date to Samiti's office.

- g) Association conducting CET/ CAP should communicate to Samiti's office vacancy details immediately after the last round is over but within 7 days.
- h) The Competent Authority of the Association and / or Representatives of Director, Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai will be Grievance Redressal Authority who will take care of all complaints of students/parents during CET examinations and admission process. Association should further ensure appointment of appellate authority to hear and decide and dispose of grievances against the decisions of said competent authority.
- i) All admissions to be done on the basis of CET conducted by the Association with the requisite mark.
- j) Association/Colleges are directed to display details of their infrastructure available on their website.
- k) It should be ensured that the Colleges incorporated in the lists are having all permissions, affiliations of the respective Authorities and/or Universities. Students to be allotted to these colleges only.
- l) Where seats are likely to be increased, Association to publish the details before hand in Local as well as State Level News papers, notice boards and websites of association and respective Colleges also and invite/call the fresh preferences / choices from the candidates for such seats.
- m) Association should submit detailed information in respect of appointments of moderators/examiners their names qualifications, etc to Samiti immediately.
- n) Samiti further directs the Association to submit the following information to office of Samiti without fail:-
  - i) No. of students appeared
  - ii) No. of students qualified in the Exam.
  - iii) No. of participating Colleges with subjects and their sanction intake capacity.
  - iv) Course/Subject/category wise seat matrix of each rounds before and after rounds.
  - v) List of selected candidates of each round.
  - vi) Details of complaints received during the process and details of action taken by Competent Authority and the Appellate Authority.



1) **Refund of Fees** : The Colleges/Institutes are directed to follow the following rule in the matter of refund of fees and incorporate the same clause as follows:

- i) "If a candidate cancels his admission before the cut-off-date, then College/Institute has to deduct only Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges and balance amount of fees paid by a student be refunded within two days, otherwise the same will amount to profiteering and charging of capitation fees. The samiti further directs that the College/Institute should also return the original documents / certificates collected from the students within two days.
- ii) If a candidate expires within three months from the date of admission full refund shall be made after deducting Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges.
- iii) After cut-off-date except in (ii) above no refund shall be made.

Samiti, subject to the incorporation of the aforesaid changes and/or conditions, grants its approval to the draft brochure of CET-2012 of Management of Association of MCA Institutes (MAMI), Ahmednagar for admissions to MCA course for Academic Year 2012-13.

**Item No. 5(b) : Letter dated 21<sup>st</sup> March 2012 received from SVPKM's D.J.Sanghvi College of Engineering requesting to approve admissions done in TFWS Supernumerary Quota without fine charged by Directorate of Technical Education letter dated 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2012.**


Samiti heard Mr. Pragnesh N. Shah, representative of the College/Institute.
