Samiti perused observations report of Expert Committee appointed by the Samiti. After going through it Director, Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai having found certain discrepancies in admission process of 100 colleges/Institutes, after deliberation, Samiti decides to approve eligibility and selection process of following 100 colleges/Institutes in Technical Education for Academic Year 2011-12, Subject to the Expert Committee – Director, Technical Education, Mumbai or his Officers or the Competent Authorities sorting out and disposing off with the said discrepancies after appropriate compliances from respective institutions for Academic Year 2011-12, enclosed as "**ANNEXURE – B**" within three weeks.

HIGHER EDUCATION COURSES:

In view of the above, after deliberation, on the basis of fulfillment of the conditions of triple test, as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the Expert Committee i.e. Director Higher Education, Pune having discrepancy, Samiti decides to approve the eligibility and selection process of the following 07 Colleges/Institutes in Higher Education for Academic Year 2011-12, subject to the Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Higher Education, Pune or his officers or the Competent Authority sorting out and disposing of the said discrepancies after appropriate compliances from the respective institutes, enclosed as "**ANNEXURE – C**" within three weeks

Similar information is to be submitted by MASA, Collegewise to comply in respect of discrepancies pointed out.

Samiti directs the Expert Committee, i.e. Directorate of Technical Education, M.S., Mumbai to verify the list of admitted students and submit the same before the Samiti for its consideration within 15 days positively. (List attached - **Annexure – D**)

Item No. 4 : To consider and decide on the Letters / representations received

Item No. 4(a) : Letter dated 27th April 2012 received from Directorate of Sports and Youth, Pune in respect of remarks/comments on draft brochure of B.P.Ed./M.P.Ed.-CET-2012.

Samiti perused the letters under references.

After deliberation, Samiti decides to grant its permission to Maharashtra Sharirik Shikshanshastra Mahavidyalaya Vyavasthapan Mahasangh, Jalgaon to conduct CET-2012 for admissions to B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed. course for the Academic Year 2012-13

Considering the suggestions of Expert Committee on the draft brochure Samiti directs as under-

- CET/CAP should be conducted in fair and transparent manner and as per the directives, orders, norms, rules and regulations laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi, 2) Hon'ble High Courts, 3) Respective Councils, 4) Respective University, 5) Govt. of Maharashtra, 6) Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti, Maharashtra State and 7) Directorate of Sports and Youth, Pune, Maharashtra State.
- CET should be conducted at the centers located in non faculty Colleges and staff of examination i.e. Supervisor, Invigilator, Center In-charge and other staff should be drawn from non faculty.
- List of notified centers with details of seating arrangement made in each such centers and list of eligible candidates appearing for examination to be

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provided to Samiti. No. of seats available college wise to be provided to Samiti. This is to be submitted to Samiti before the date of examination.

- d) Schedule of CET should be as per directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi, if any.
- e) Result of CET should be displayed on website of the Association and the notice boards of participating Colleges/Institutes. Result of CET-2012 to be submitted to the Samiti office, within two days from the date of declaration of result.
- f) Association should ensure that allotment of students to colleges is made strictly as per merit and as per the options of choices exercised. Association should also ensure that colleges must have submitted Fee Approval proposals to Competent Authority, Maharashtra State for finalization of fees structure the Academic Year 2012-13. It is also to be ensured that allotment of students is done only the colleges those are affiliated to Council and University for the academic year 2012-13. Association should ensure that colleges submit the list of admissions within two days form the cut off date to Samiti's office.
- g) Association conducting CET/ CAP should communicate to Samiti's office vacancy details immediately after the last round is over but within 7 days.
- h) The Competent Authority of the Association and / or Representatives of Director, Sports and Youth, Maharashtra State, Mumbai will be Grievance Redressal Authority who will take care of all complaints of students/parents during CET examinations and admission process. Association should further ensure appointment of appellate authority to hear and decide and dispose of grievances against the decisions of said competent authority.
- i) All admissions to be done on the basis of CET conducted by the Mahasangh with the requisite mark.
- j) Mahasangh/Colleges are directed to display details of their infrastructure available on their website.
- k) It should be ensured that the Colleges incorporated in the lists are having all permissions, affiliations of the respective Authorities and/or Universities. Students to be allotted to these colleges only.
- l) Where seats are likely to be increased, Association to publish the details before hand in Local as well as State Level News papers, notice boards and websites of association and respective Colleges also and invite/call the fresh preferences / choices from the candidates for such seats.
- m) Association should submit detailed information in respect of appointments of moderators/examiners their names qualifications, etc to Samiti immediately.
- n) Samiti further directs the Association to submit the following information to office of Samiti without fail:-

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- i) No. of students appeared
 - ii) No. of students qualified in the Exam.
 - iii) No. of participating Colleges with subjects and their sanction intake capacity.
 - iv) Course/Subject/category wise seat matrix of each rounds before and after rounds.
 - v) List of selected candidates of each round.
 - vi) Details of complaints received during the process and details of action taken by Competent Authority and the Appellate Authority.
- 1) **Refund of Fees** : The Colleges/Institutes are directed to follow the following rule in the matter of refund of fees and incorporate the same clause as follows:
- i) "If a candidate cancels his admission before the cut-off-date, then College/Institute has to deduct only Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges and balance amount of fees paid by a student be refunded within two days, otherwise the same will amount to profiteering and charging of capitation fees. The samiti further directs that the College/Institute should also return the original documents / certificates collected from the students within two days.
 - ii) If a candidate expires within three months from the date of admission full refund shall be made after deducting Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges.
 - iii) After cut-off-date except in (ii) above no refund shall be made.

Samiti, subject to the incorporation of the aforesaid changes and/or conditions, grants its approval to the draft brochure of CET-2012 of Maharashtra Sharirik Shikshanshastra Mahavidyalaya Vyavasthapan Mahasangh, Jalgaon for admissions to B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed. courses for Academic Year 2012-13.

Item No. 4(b) : Letter dated 30th May 2012 received from Maharashtra Association of Schools of Architecture (MASA), Mumbai along with draft brochure regarding admission process of B. Architecture course for the Academic Year 2012-13.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After going through, Samiti decided to approved the draft brochure submitted by Association for MASA--2012 for admission to B.Architecture course for the Academic Year 2012-13, subject to modification suggested by the Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Technical Education, M.S., Mumbai and publication of the corrected brochure accordingly.

After deliberation, Samiti allows Maharashtra Association of School of Architecture (MASA) to conduct CAP for B.Architecture course for Academic Year 2012-13.

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In view of the above and considering the suggestion of Expert Committee on the draft brochure Samiti directs as under :-

- a) CAP should be conducted in fair and transparent manner and as per the directives, orders, norms, rules and regulations laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi, 2) Hon'ble High Courts, 3) Respective Councils, 4) Respective University, 5) Govt. of Maharashtra, 6) Pravesh Niyamtran Samiti, Maharashtra State and 7) Directorate of Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai.
- b) Schedule of CAP should be as per directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi, if any.
- c) Schedule of CAP should be displayed on website of the Association and the notice boards of participating Colleges/Institutes.
- d) Association should ensure that allotment of students to colleges is made strictly as per merit and as per the options of choices exercised. Association should also ensure that colleges must have submitted Fee Approval proposals to Shikshan Shulka Samiti, Maharashtra State for finalization of fees structure the Academic Year 2012-13. It is also to be ensured that allotment of students is done only the colleges those are affiliated to Council and University for the academic year 2012-13. Association should ensure that colleges submit the list of admissions within two days form the cut off date to Samiti's office.
- e) Association conducting CAP should communicate to Samiti's office vacancy details immediately after the last round is over but within 7 days.
- f) The Competent Authority of the Association and / or Representatives of Director, Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai will be Grievance Redressal Authority who will take care of all complaints of students/parents during admission process. Association should further ensure appointment of appellate authority to hear and decide and dispose of grievances against the decisions of said competent authority.
- g) MASA/Colleges are directed to display details of their infrastructure available on their website.
- h) It should be ensured that the Colleges incorporated in the lists are having all permissions, affiliations of the respective Authorities and/or Universities. Students to be allotted to these colleges only.
- i) Where seats are likely to be increased, Association to publish the details before hand in Local as well as State Level News papers, notice boards and websites of association and respective Colleges also and invite/call the fresh preferences / choices from the candidates for such seats.
- j) Samiti further directs the Association to submit the following information to office of Samiti without fail:-
 - i) No. of students participated in CAP
 - ii) No. of students qualified in the CAP.
 - iii) No. of participating Colleges with subjects and their sanction intake capacity.

- iv) Course/Subject/category wise seat matrix of each rounds before and after rounds.
 - w) List of selected candidates of each round.
 - vii) Details of complaints received during the process and details of action taken by Competent Authority and the Appellate Authority.
- 2) **Refund of Fees** : The Colleges/Institutes are directed to follow the following rule in the matter of refund of fees and incorporate the same clause as follows:
- ii) "If a candidate cancels his admission before the cut-off-date, then College/Institute has to deduct only Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges and balance amount of fees paid by a student be refunded within two days, otherwise the same will amount to profiteering and charging of capitation fees. The samiti further directs that the College/Institute should also return the original documents / certificates collected from the students within two days.
 - ii) If a candidate expires within three months from the date of admission full refund shall be made after deducting Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges.
 - iii) After cut-off-date except in (ii) above no refund shall be made.

Samiti, subject to the incorporation of the aforesaid changes and/or conditions, grants its approval to the draft brochure of CAP-2012 of Maharashtra Association of Schools of Architecture, Mumbai for admissions to B. Architecture courses for Academic Year 2012-13.

Item No. 4(c) : Letter dated 13th April 2012 received from Pankaj Mahajan asking consideration of his case for eligibility of M.M.S. course along with clarification submitted by G.N.V.S. Institute of Management, Mumbai vide its letter 3rd May 2012.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberation, Samiti concludes that the issue of eligibility criteria for M.M.S. course does not come within the purview of the Samiti. Samiti directs the aforesaid applicant to approach the appropriate authority.

Item No. 4(d) : Letter dated 27th February 2012 received from Pad. Vasantdada Patil Institute of Technology, Pune regarding admission of Mr. Nagesh Yogesh Pathak admitted for B.E. course for the Academic Year 2006-07 (Non submission of Nationality Certificate).

Samiti perused the letter under reference.



After deliberation, Samiti decides to approve the admission of Mr. Nagesh Yogesh Pathak admitted for B.E. course for the Academic Year 2006-07, subject to the condition that the appropriate authorities satisfy themselves about the correctness compliance so made

Item No. 4(e) : Letter dated 1st June 2012 received from Al-Ameen Educational & Medical Foundation's College of Engineering and Management Studies, Pune requesting to waive the penalty for late submission of merit list for the Academic Year 2010-11. While approving the merit list vide the Samiti resolution dated 19th July 2011.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

It is observed that the aforesaid College/Institute has not given any reason of late submission of their admission details for the Academic Year 2010-11. In view of this the penalty cannot be waived as decided in the meeting of 19th July 2011.

After deliberation, Samiti directs the aforesaid College/Institute to submit the proper explanation with penalties for the Academic Year 2010-11. After receipt of the same it be placed before Samiti for its consideration.

Item No. 4(f) : Letter dated 19th May 2012 received from Directorate of Technical Education, M.S. asking to approve admissions in Academic Year 2011-12 of MBA course at Marathwada Institute of Management and Research, Aurangabad for the Academic Year 2011-12.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

The deficiencies whether removed or not to be communicated by Director of Technical Education, Mumbai. College concerned need to explain in respect of following.

- 1) Whether she is the student ?
- 2) What is the date of admission ?
- 3) When the admission was cancelled ?
- 4) When the said student was readmitted ?
- 5) As of now, whether she is a student? Director, Technical Education, Mumbai to inform Samiti as to whether "cancellation of admission", discrepancy is done away with it or not specifically.

After receipt of the proper explanation it be place before the Samiti for approval of admission.

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Item No. 4(g) : Letter dated 18th May 2012 received from Directorate of Technical Education, M.S. in respect of the decision taken by the Samiti in its meeting held on 26th September 2012 (at Item No. 5[c]) regarding verification of merit list of I.E.S. College of Architecture, Mumbai for the Academic Year 2010-11.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

MASA to inform the following:-

- 1) What procedure did in follow during Academic Year 2008-09, 2009-10, 2010-11 and 2011-12
- 2) What where their admission norms ?
- 3) What was the justification for not obtaining the permission for conduct of CET/CAP from Samiti. MASA to ensure submission of list of admission to Samiti for Academic Year 2008-09, 2009-10, 2010-11 and 2011-12 early.

Item No. 5 : To hear the following institute as decided in the previous meeting held on 18th April 2012.

Item No. 5(a) : SVPKM's D.J. Sanghavi College of Engineering, Mumbai requesting to approve admissions done in TFWS Supernumerary quota without fine charged by Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai.

Samiti heard Dr Hari Vasundran and Mr. Nilesh M. Mohite, representative of the College/Institute.

During the hearing, it was observed that the penalty was imposed by Director of Technical Education, M.S. It is therefore for the authority concerned to take a call of the institute for waiver of the penalty.

After the appropriate decision of the authority concerned matter to be placed before Samiti again for its consideration for approval of admissions.

Item No. 5(b) : Maharashtra Association of Schools of Architecture (MASA) regarding CET and CAP – 2012 for admission to B.Architecture course for the Academic Year 2011-12.

and

Item No. 5(c) : Pillai's College of Architecture, New Panvel regarding admission process of B.Architecture course for the Academic Year 2010-12 conducted by MASA.

Samiti heard to Prof. Akhtar Chauhan, Dr. M.V. Tulang, Shri Abhay V. Purohit, Aneerudha Dhuru representatives of MASA.

Samiti also heard to Mr. Pragnesh Shah, representative of Pillai College of Architecture, New Panvel.

It is observed that the aforesaid Association has not taken prior approval of Samiti for its CET and CAP for admission to B.Architecture course for the Academic Year 2010-11 and 2011-12.

In view of the above, after deliberation, Samiti directs Association to submit all relevant information/documents in respect of admissions for Academic Years 2008-09, 2009-10 and 2010-11. After receipt of the same it would be sent to the Expert Committee i.e. Office of Director, Technical Education, Maharashtra State for their scrutiny and comments/ remarks. After receipt of said comments/ remarks from the Office of the Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai the same to be placed before Samiti for its consideration.

Item No. 6 : **To consider and decides on the letters received from Shivaji University, Kolhapur regarding proportionate allotment of students on basis of actual appointments of regular teachers appointed in affiliated/Autonomous Engineering/ Management/ Pharmacy/MCA Colleges (List enclose as Annexure –E)**

Samiti perused the letters under references,

After deliberation, Samiti directs the aforesaid Colleges/Institutes to submit their say/explanation in respect of deficiency pointed out by the University to Samiti within two weeks. Samiti further directs the directorates to offer their remarks and immediate action at their level since they are monitoring the process. Universities to inform us what action they have taken at their level in this regards.

Item No. 7 : **To consider and decide on the letter dated 31st May 2012 received from G.V. Acharya Institute of Engineering and Technology, Mumbai requesting to approve the merit list of Academic Years 2009-10 along with verification report submitted by Directorate of Technical Education, M.S. vide its letter dated 16/04/2012.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberation, on the basis of letter dated 16/04/2012 submitted by Expert Committee, i.e. Directorate of Technical Education, M.S. Samiti decides to approve the admission process of the aforesaid College/Institute for the Academic Year 2009-10, subject to the compliance of the discrepancy pointed out by the Expert Committee vide its above referred letter.

Item No. 8: **Any other matter with the permission to the Chair.**

Item No. 8(a): **Letter dated 18th June 2012 received from Ali – Allana College of Pharmacy, Nandurbar alongwith the brochure of AMPCA CETs- 2012 asking permission to conduct AMPCA CET – 2012 for Academic Year 2012-13.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After going through, Samiti decided that the copy of draft brochure for conduct of AMPCA-CET--2012 for admission to M. Pharmacy course submitted by aforesaid College/Institute would be sent to the Expert Committee i.e. Office of Director, Technical Education, Maharashtra State for their scrutiny and comments/remarks. After receipt of said comments/ remarks from the Office of the Directorate of Technical Education, the Association would be conveyed the necessary changes/modifications to be carried out in the said draft brochure and thereafter the final approval to the brochure would be given by the Samiti to the Association.

Item No. 8(b): Letter dated 25th April 2012 received from Association of Management of MBA/MMS Institutes (AMMI), regarding revised schedule of CET for MBA/MMS courses for the Academic Year 2012-13

Samiti perused the letter under reference and noted the same.

Item No. 8(c): Letter dated 18th May 2012 received from Management Association MCA Institutes (MAMI), submitting the list of the the Examiners and Moderators for MAMI-MCA-CET-2012

Samiti perused the letter under reference and noted the same.

Item No. 8(d): Letter dated 21st May 2012 received from Director, Higher Education, Pune regarding 20% Management Quota seats for B.Ed. Colleges addressed to Principal Secretary, Higher & Technical Department, Mantralaya copy endorsed to us.

Item No. 8(e): Letter dated 20th April 2012 received from Late. Shivramji Hiwase B.Ed. College, Warud requesting the approval for 20% Management Quota admission for Academic Year 2011-12.

Item No. 8(f): Letter dated 2nd June 2012 received from Mahatma Fule Shikshan Shastra Mahavidyalaya, Jalgaon requesting the approval for 20% Management Quota admission for Academic Year 2011-12.

Samiti perused the letters under reference.

In furtherance of its meetings held on 17th January 2012, 5th March 2012 and 18th April 2012 and Government resolution No. 1) बी.एड. २०११/प्र.क्र. ४९/मशि-२, दिनांक ४ मे २०११ and 2) क्र. एन.जी.सी. २००४/(४१/०४) /मशि-३, दिनांक १६ फेब्रुवारी २००४. Samiti observes as under :-

GR referred above allows institutes to have Management Quota. On the other hand National Council for Technical Education, (NCTE) Bhopal vide its regulation No. 51-3/2009/Pt/NCTE(N&S), dated 25/08/2010 in view of provisions of rule No. 4(5)(i) does not allow any Management Quota seats. Samiti observes that the direction in GR cited above does not match with these regulations framed by NCTE.

Samiti in its meeting held on 5th March 2012 (at Item No. 4) has directed the Director of Higher Education, Pune to approach the concerned authorities for the

clarifications in respect of Government resolution dated 4th May 2011 and guidelines of National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi (NCTE) dated 25th August 2010 regarding 20% management quota seats, but clarification from the concerned authorities is yet not received.

In view of the above, after deliberation, Samiti directs the office to obtain details of management quota admissions from Colleges for Academic Year 2011-12 and initiate the process of approval considering exceptional circumstances and considering the interests of students admitted in Academic Year 2011-12.

Samiti feels that the directions in GR about management quota needs to be with drawn in view of NCTE regulations and in view of contradictions between these regulations and GR.

Alternatively National Council of Teacher Education, Bhopal (NCTE) may like to offer remarks / interpretations of the relevant provisions in light of contents of aforesaid GR and NCTE regulations.
