Considering this after deliberation, Samiti decides to approve eligibility and selection process of following **100** colleges/Institutes in Higher Education for AY 2013-14, Subject to the Expert Committee - i.e. Director, Higher Education or his Officers or the Competent Authorities sorting out and disposing off with the said discrepancies after appropriate compliances from respective institutions for Academic Year 2013-14, within four weeks.

**Item No. 3(c):** **To consider, discuss and decide on proposals submitted after 30<sup>th</sup> March and yet not submitted for approval.**

Samiti observed that the Colleges/Institutes submitted their proposals after 30<sup>th</sup> March 2014. (List Attached as Annexure - D )

1. After deliberation Samiti decides that Those who have not submitted their admission details online upto 30<sup>th</sup> March 2014 and did not submit their proposal for approval of admissions the penalty will be charged **Rs. 1,00,000/- per course.**
2. Samiti also decides that the colleges who yet not submitted their proposals should submit before 30<sup>th</sup> July 2014 with Rs. 1,00,000/- Penalty.
3. Samiti further decides that, after 30<sup>th</sup> July 2014 the proposals for approval of admissions, same to be notice of Pravesh Niyantran Samiti for further action such as disaffiliation/non approval of admissions etc.

**Item No. 5(b): Letters dated 27<sup>th</sup> May 2014 and 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2014 received from Association of Unaided Private Pharmacy Colleges, Wardha asking for permission to conduct Asso-CET 2014 for admission to M.Pharmacy Course to fill up vacant seats for Academic Year 2014-15 with draft brochure.**

Samiti perused the aforesaid letter dated 25<sup>th</sup> April 2014 received from aforesaid Associations in respect of Conducting CET against vacant seats after the "Common Admission Process" are over by the Competent Authority, Directorate of Technical Education, Maharashtra State.

Samiti heard to Dr. E. B. Khedkar, Representative of the Association of Management of MBA/MMS Institutions, Pune, Dr. S.B. Kolate, Representative of the Management Association of MCA Institutes, Ahmednagar and Dr. P. G. Yeole and Dr. R. S. Bhambar Representative of the Association of Unaided Private Pharmacy Colleges, Wardha.

Attention is drawn to the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court's in (2003) 6 Supreme Court cases 697 Islamic Academy of Education v/s. State of Karnataka Para. No. 16 as re-produced hereunder:

*"We thus hold that the management could select students, of their quota, either on the basis of the common entrance test conducted by the State or on the basis of a common entrance test to be conducted by an association of all colleges of a particular type in that State e.g. medical, engineering or technical etc. The common entrance test, held by the association must be for admission to all colleges of that type in the state. The option of choosing, between either of these tests, must be exercised before issuing of prospectus and after intimation to the concerned authority and the committee set up hereinafter. If any professional college choose not to admit from the common entrance test conducted by the association then that college must necessarily admit from the common entrance test conducted by the State. After holding the common entrance test and declaration of results the merit list will immediately be placed on the notice board of the colleges which have chosen to admit as per this test. A copy of the merit list will also be forthwith sent to the concerned authority and the committee. Selection of students must then be strictly on the basis of merit as per that merit list." ( emphasis supplied)*

In view of the above quoted direction of the Hon'ble Supreme court Samiti can not accede to the request made by the aforesaid institute. It was submitted before the Samiti by the representative of the Associations that after the above referred Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court significant changes have taken place in the system and therefore in the changed situation there request should be considered otherwise a large number of seats would remain vacant and a large number of students would not be able to get admissions. In the opinion of the Samiti

the direction issued by Hon'ble Supreme Court is binding on the Samiti and it will continue to be binding on the Samiti till its modified by Hon'ble Supreme Court itself. When this was pointed out to the representative of the Associations, they stated that they will initiate appropriate proceedings before Hon'ble Supreme Court seeking suitable modifications in the above quoted directions immediately but they should be permitted to hold the CET as requested by them. In this view of the things following decision is taken by the Samiti. The Samiti grants permission to the Associations to conduct the CET 2014 as requested by Associations for admission against vacant seats after the "Common Admission Process" is over by the competent authority, Director of Technical Education M.S. subject to following conditions.

- 1) Association should submit affidavits incorporating following points Affidavit to go submitted within three days from 25/6/2014.
  - i) Association shall conduct the CET but result of CET to be declared and "Common Admission Process" to be done only after the appropriate order from the Hon'ble Supreme Court is secured.
  - ii) Associations to clearly inform all students/parents before the test that they can get admission only if and When Hon'ble Supreme Court gives the appropriate permission for the admission procedure. A clear statement to this effect should be made before admission of student for the tests.
  - iii) Association shall also mention in their affidavit that they clearly understand that if the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India denies the permission to admit the students then the said CET shall stand cancelled.
- 2) The Associations can declare their intention to hold the tests only after filling in an affidavit and not before.
- 3) It is made clear that, only in case the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India grants the permission, Associations or the Colleges concerned can admit the students to the course for the Academic Year 2014-15.
- 4) It is also made clear that the Associations shall take clear undertaking from the students stating that they are fully aware that they can get admissions only if Hon'ble Supreme Court makes the suitable order.

Samiti perused the letter dated 9<sup>th</sup> April 2014 received from Pragati Women's College of Education, Torxem, Tal – Pernem, Goa requesting to enlist with Association B.Ed. CET 2014-15 for admission to B.Ed. Course for the Academic Year 2014-15.

Samiti observed the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court's in (2003) 6 Supreme Court cases 697 Islamic Academy of Education v/s. State of Karnataka Para. No. 16 as re-produced hereunder:

*"We thus hold that the management could select students, of their quota, either on the basis of the common entrance test conducted by the State or on the basis of a common entrance test to be conducted by an association of all colleges of a particular type in that State e.g. medical, engineering or technical etc. The common entrance test, held by the association must be for admission to all colleges of that type in the state. The option of choosing, between either of these tests, must be exercised before issuing of prospectus and after intimation to the concerned authority and the committee set up hereinafter. If any professional college choose not to admit from the common entrance test conducted by the association then that college must necessarily admit from the common entrance test conducted by the State. After holding the common entrance test and declaration of results the merit list will immediately be placed on the notice board of the colleges which have chosen to admit as per this test. In view of the above, quoted direction of the Hon'ble Supreme court Samiti can not to accede to the request made by the aforesaid institute.

Samiti perused the letter dated 26<sup>th</sup> May 2014 received from Sapkal Knowledge Hub, Mumbai requesting to allow to admit Zero CET and Non CET candidates at Institute Level admissions for M.Pharmacy course for Academic Year 2014-15.

After deliberation Samiti decides that can not to accede to the request made by the aforesaid institute, to allow Non CET candidates.

**Item No. 5(f): Letter Dated 5<sup>th</sup> May 2014 received from Late Shri Balibhadra Singh Shikshan Sansthan, Mumbai informing about admission process to fill up 100% seats at institute level from Academic Year 2014-15 for B.Ed. course.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberation, Samiti direct the college to follow the directions, orders, norms, rules and regulations laid down by the 1. Hon,ble Supreme court of India, New Delhi 2. Hon,ble High Court, 3. Respective Councils, 4. Respective Universities, 5. Govt. of Maharashtra for Minority Institutions.

**Item No. 5(g): Letter dated 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2014 received from Association of Hotel Management Colleges of Maharashtra, Nagpur asking for permission to conduct ASSO-CET for HMCT Courses to fill vacant seats after MH-CET/CAP for Academic Year 2014-15.**

Samiti perused the letter dated 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2014 received from Association of Hotel Management Colleges of Maharashtra, Nagpur asking for permission to conduct ASSO-CET for HMCT Courses to fill vacant seats after MH-CET/CAP for Academic Year 2014-15.

Samiti observed that the Draft brochure for CET 2014 to be conducted by HMCT Association has not submitted for approval.

Samiti will take appropriate decision after the submission of the draft brochure and detailed Schedule of CET – 2014 to be conducted by HMCT Association.

**Item No. 6: To consider and decide on the Letters / representations received from Colleges/Institutes:-**

**Item No. 6(a): Letter dated 30<sup>th</sup> April 2014 received from Leelavati Awhad Institute of Technology M S & R, Badalapur requesting to consider the application sympathetically in respect of penalties for late submission of admission details in respect of decision taken by the Samiti in its meeting held on 11th April 2014 (at Item No. 9[v]) regarding delay in submission of admission details for the Academic Year 2010-11 to 2013-14.**

Samiti perused the letter dated 30<sup>th</sup> April 2014 received from Leelavati Awhad Institute of Technology M S & R, Badalapur requesting to consider the application sympathetically in respect of penalties for late submission of admission details in respect of decision taken by the Samiti in its meeting held on 11th April 2014.

In partial modification of its decision of penalty dated 11/4/2014 Samiti considers the request of the college/institute. Samiti observed that the College/Institute already submitted the penalty for late submission of proposals for approval of admission for Academic Year 2012-13, 2013-14 as per the Samiti's earlier decision. College submitted penalty Rs. 25,000/- for Academic Year 2012-13 (as per the decision of Samiti taken in its meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> April 2013.) and Rs. 50,000/- for Academic Year 2013-14 (as per the decision of Samiti taken in its meeting held on 11 April 2014.)

After deliberation, Samiti decides\_

1. To charge the penalty of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rs. One Lakh) per course for late submission of proposal for approval of admission. For Academic Year 2010-11 and 2011-12 each.
2. 
