Item No. 4(a): **Letter dated 1st November 2012 received from PCT's Veermata Hiraben P. Shah College of Pharmacy, Thane requesting to waive the penalty for late submission of merit list for the AY. 2008-09. (Ref : Agenda of 1st September 2012 Item No. 5)**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti had in its meeting held on 1st Sept. 2012 charged the penalty of Rs. 11, 20,000/- (Rs. 5000 X 56 (No. of Students) X 4 (No. of Years late)), to the Institute. Institute has deposited Rs. 2,80,000/- (Rs. 5000 X 56 (No. of Students)) in the office.

It has been requested to waive the penalty in view of the fact that the institute has been closed.

In partial modification of its decision dated 1/9/2012, Samiti considers the request of the institute and after deliberation it decides to charge the penalty of Rs. 5000/- per student.

Samiti also directs the institute to submit an Undertaking that it will not run the courses in the institute here after.

Item No. 4(b): **Letter dated 26th Sept. 2012 received from Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Technology, Versova, Adndheri, Mumbai responding to the complaint lodged by Saurabh Uddhav Kulkarni. (Ref : Agenda of 1st September 2012 Item No. 3)**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberation, Samiti decides to send the matter to Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Technical Education, Maharashtra State for their report. After receipt of the same, it be placed before Samiti for its consideration.

It is observed that the admissions of Varada S. Nawathe and Brendan Dennies Cuthino done in 2nd round of Lokmanya Tilak Institute of Architecture, Koparkhairane and Viva School of Architecture, Virar respectively were cancelled in 3rd round considering higher choices of the Candidates in other institutes.

Maharashtra Association of Schools of Architecture Mumbai (MASA) who conducted the admission process has submitted their Explanation vide letters under reference.

After deliberation Samiti decides to forward the said explanation to the Applicants. Samiti further directs the applicants to submit their say over the explanation. After receipt of the same it be placed before the Samiti for its consideration.

It is observed that Miss. Kshitija Rajendra Khedekar admitted on 25th July 2012 at Shrimati Kashibai Navale college of Pharmacy, Pune in M.Pharmacy (Q.A.). She cancelled her admission on 6th August 2012 before the cutoff date as well as before the starting of the course. Samiti perused the AUPPC brochure Rule 10 for cancellation and Refund of Fees.

After deliberation, Samiti directs the said institute to act as per the provisions of Rule 10 as mentioned above.
