- 1) In respect of Asso. CET for B.Ed. & M.Ed. it is seen that 29028 & 1969 students were qualified in the examination. However 10097 & 1039 students were allotted to colleges in round I and II. Association should explain the circumstances as to why it did not allot sufficient students in round I in spite of the fact that more students were qualified. Samiti also directs association to submit the information related to no. of candidates applied for first and second round.
- 2) In respect of MASA it is seen that 6587 and 159 students were qualified and 2283 and 646 seats were available. However 2237 and 151 students were allotted to colleges in first round. Association should explain the circumstances as to why it did not allot. Sufficient students in spite of the fact that more students were qualified. Samiti also directs the association to submit the information related to no. of candidates applied for first and second round.

Samiti noted the contents. Samiti decides to seek explanation from **382** colleges as to why they failed to upload the admission details online.

Item No. 4(a): To discuss, consider and ratify the decision taken on circulatory submission on 20th August 2014 regarding Maharashtra Sharirik Shikshan Shastra Mahavidyalaya Vyavasthapan Mahasangha, Jalgaon requesting to consider and grant approval to Draft brochure and asking to permit to Conduct CET for B.P.Ed./M.P.Ed. Course for the Academic Year 2014-15.

Samiti perused the letter received from Maharashtra Sharirik Shikshan Shastra Mahavidyalaya Vyavasthapan Mahasangha, Jalgaon requesting to consider and grant approval to Draft brochure and asking to permit to Conduct CET for B.P.Ed./M.P.Ed. Course for the Academic Year 2014-15. It was circulated amongst the members of Samiti as a circulatory Submission dated 20th August 2014.

Samiti ratified the decision of allowing Maharashtra Sharirik Shikshanshastra Mahavidyalaya Vavsasthapan Mahasangh to conduct CET/CAP for B.P.Ed./M.P.Ed. Course for Academic Year 2014-15.

Considering the suggestions of Expert Committee on the draft brochure Samiti directs as under-

- a) CET/CAP should be conducted in fair and transparent manner and admission process to be on the basis of Merit.
- b) CET examinations should be conducted at the centers located in non related Colleges and staff of examination i.e. Supervisor, Invigilator, Center In-charge and other staff should be drawn from non related faculty.
- c) List of notified centers with details of seating arrangement made in each such centers and list of eligible candidates appearing for examination to be provided to Samiti. No. of seats available college wise to be provided to Samiti.
- d) All admissions to be done as per the norms/rules/regulations/conditions laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, Respective Councils, Government of Maharashtra and University.
- e) Result of CET should be displayed on website and the notice boards of participating Colleges/Institutes and of Association. Result of CET-2014 to be submitted to Samiti office, within two days from the date of declaration of result.
- f) Aforesaid association should ensure to that all allotment of students to colleges is made strictly as per merit and as per the options of choices exercised. Association should also ensure that colleges abide by the provisions of National council for Teacher Education (Guidelines for Regulation of Tution fees & other fees chargeable by unaided Teacher Education Institutions) Amendment regulation 2010 duly published in Official Gazette-The Gazette of India,Extra ordinary, Part III, section-4 on 25th August 2010. It should also to be ensured that allotment of students is done only to the colleges who are affiliated to universities for the academic year concerned. It should be ensured that colleges submit the list of admissions within two days form the cut off date to Samiti's office.

- g) Institute/Organization conducting CET/ CAP should communicate to Samiti's office vacancy details immediately after the last round is over but within 7 days.
- h) Competent Authority will be the grievance redressal authority who will take care of all complaints of students/parents during CET examinations and admission process. Association should further ensure appointment of appellate authority to hear and decide and dispose of grievances against the decisions of said competent authority.
- i) Samiti further directs the Association/Colleges to submit the following information to the Samiti office from time to time.
- i) No. of students appeared
 - ii) No. of students qualified in the Exam.
 - iii) No. of participating Colleges with their sanctioned intake capacity.
 - iv) Course/Subject/category wise seat matrix of each round, before and after round.
 - v) List of selected candidates of each round.
 - vi) Details of complaints received during the process and nature of action to taken on the complaints.

Samiti further directs, to incorporate the following changes in final Rules and Information Brochure of CET-2014, as follows:-

- j) The Rule of eligibility, Tie breaker, etc. is at par with CET-2014 conducted by Directorate of Higher Education, Pune or Concern University.
- k) Where seats are likely to be increased, Association to publish the details before hand in Local as well State Level News papers, notice boards and websites of association and respective Colleges also and invite/call the fresh preferences / choices from the candidates for such seats.
- l) Association should submit detailed information in respect of appointments of moderators/examiners their names qualifications, etc to Samiti immediately.
- 1) **Refund of Fees** : The Colleges/Institutes are directed to follow the following rule in the matter of refund of fees and incorporate the same clause as follows:
- i) "If a candidate cancels his admission before the cut-off-date, then College/Institute has deduct only Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges and balance amount of fees paid by a student be refunded within two days, otherwise the same will amount to profiteering and charging of capitation fees. Samiti further directs that the College/Institute should also return the original documents / certificates collected from the students within two days.
 - ii) If a candidate expires within three months from the date of admission full refund shall be made after deducting Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges.
 - iii) After cut-off-date except in (ii) above no refund shall be made.

After deliberation Samiti ratifies the decision of granting approval to Draft brochure and permission to conduct CET for B.P.Ed./M.P.Ed. Course for the Academic Year 2014-15.

Samiti perused the observations of Expert Committee appointed by Samiti i.e. Office of the Director, Technical Education, Mumbai (Academic year 2013-14). After going through it and office of Director, Technical Education, Mumbai, having found no discrepancies in admission process of following College/Institute, Samiti, on the basis of fulfillment of the conditions of triple test, as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and having found no discrepancy, ratifies the decision of approving the eligibility and selection process of these institutes for Academic Year 2013-14.

Samiti perused the letter dated 13th August 2014 received from Jaykumar Rawal Institute of Technology, Dhule. Samiti after deliberation accede the request made by college.

After deliberation, Samiti concludes that the decision taken by Samiti in its meeting held on 20th June 2014 (at Item No. 3(c)) remains applicable to all defaulter Colleges/Institutes those failed to submit their admission details to Samiti. The extract of the decision which reads is as under:-

"Samiti observed that the Colleges/Institutes submitted their proposals after 30th March 2014. (List Attached as Annexure - D)

1. After deliberation Samiti decides that Those who have not submitted their admission details online upto 30th March 2014 and did not submit their proposal for approval of admissions the penalty will be charged **Rs. 1,00,000/- per course.**
2. Samiti also decides that the colleges who yet not submitted their proposals should submit before 30th July 2014 with Rs. 1,00,000/- Penalty.
3. Samiti further decides that, after 30th July 2014 the proposals for approval of admissions, same to be notice of Pravesh Niyamtran Samiti for further action such as disaffiliation/non approval of admissions etc."

After deliberation Samiti ratifies the decision of granting approval of the admissions to Higher and Technical Courses for the Academic Year 2013-14.

Item No. 5 : **To consider and decide on the Letters / representations received:-**

Item No. 5(a): **Letter dated 8th August 2014 received from Jawaharlal Darda Institute of Engineering and Technology, Yavatmal regarding regularization of admission of Kum. Poonam Vasant Jhade admitted in First Year Chemical Engineering course in Open Quota for Academic Year 2013-14 along with Hon'ble High Court, Nagpur Bench order in Writ Petition no. 3665/2014.**

Samiti perused the letter received from Jawaharlal Darda Institute of Engineering and Technology, Yavatmal regarding regularization of admission of Kum. Poonam Vasant Jhade admitted in First Year Chemical Engineering course in Open Quota for Academic Year 2013-14 along with Hon'ble High Court, Nagpur Bench order in Writ Petition no. 3665/2014.

After deliberation, Samiti decides to approve the admission of Kum. Poonam Vasant Jhade admitted in First Year Chemical Engineering course for Academic Year 2013-14 in Jawaharlal Darda Institute of Engineering and Technology, Yavatmal in OPEN category as has been admitted in GOPENH Quota through centralized admission process.

Item No. 5(b): **Letter dated 11th August 2014 received from Jawaharlal Darda Institute of Engineering and Technology, Yavatmal regarding regularization of admission of Ku. Nikhil Chandrakant Chaudhari admitted in First Year Electronics and Tele-communication course in Open Quota for Academic Year 2013-14 along with Hon'ble High Court, Nagpur Bench order in Writ Petition no. 1744/2014.**

Samiti perused the letter dated 11th August 2014 received from Jawaharlal Darda Institute of Engineering and Technology, Yavatmal regarding regularization of admission of Ku. Nikhil Chandrakant Chaudhari admitted in First Year Electronics and Tele-communication course in Open Quota for Academic Year 2013-14 along with Hon'ble High Court, Nagpur Bench order in Writ Petition no. 1744/2014.

After deliberation, Samiti decides to approve the admission of Ku. Nikhil Chandrakant Chaudhari admitted in First Year Electronics and Tele-communication course in Open Quota

for Academic Year 2013-14 in Jawaharlal Darda Institute of Engineering and Technology, Yavatmal as has been admitted in GOPENO Quota through centralized admission process.

Item No. 5(c): Letter dated 22nd August 2014 received from Kum. Monika Chandrakant Jhirange regarding regularization of admission in MMM's Institute of Technology, Pune for Third Year MCA Course admitted in OBC Quota.

Samiti perused the letter dated 22nd August 2014 received from Kum. Monika Chandrakant Jhirange regarding to regularization of admission in MMM's Institute of Technology, Pune for Third Year MCA Course admitted in OBC Quota.

Kum. Monika Chandrakant Jhirange admitted in Quota reserved for OBC Category for the Academic Year 2013-14 in MCA Direct Second Year Course. She was supposed to submit her Original Caste Validity Certificate to regularize her admission. But she did not submit it. She requested to regularize her admission in Open Quota.

After deliberation, Samiti concludes that the "change of category" does not come within the perview of Samiti. Hence rejected.

Item No. 5(d): Letter dated 20th August 2014 received from Matoshree Sayarbai Champalalji Chopada B.Ed. College, Khamgaon, Buldhana requesting to allow to fill vacant seats from Association CET for Academic Year 2014-15.

and

Item No. 5(e): Letters dated 1st July 2014 and 20th August 2014 received from PES's Modern College of Special Education Pune requesting to allow to fill vacant seats from Association CET for Academic Year 2014-15.

and

Item No. 5(f) : Letters dated 1st July 2014 and 20th August 2014 received from PES's Modern College of Special Education (For Ladies) Pune requesting to allow to fill vacant seats from Association CET for Academic Year 2014-15.

Samiti perused letters under reference received from B.Ed. Colleges, requesting to allow to fill in vacant seats from amongst the students qualifying Association CET after the "Common Admission Process" was over by the Competent Authority, Directorate of Higher Education, Maharashtra State for Academic Year 2014-15.

Samiti observes the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court's in (2003) 6 Supreme Court cases 697 Islamic Academy of Education v/s. State of Karnataka Para. No. 16 as reproduced hereunder:

"We thus hold that the management could select students, of their quota, either on the basis of the common entrance test conducted by the State or on the basis of a common entrance test to be conducted by an association of all colleges of a particular type in that State e.g. medical, engineering or technical etc. The common entrance test, held by the

association must be for admission to all colleges of that type in the state. The option of choosing, between either of these tests, must be exercised before issuing of prospectus and after intimation to the concerned authority and the committee set up hereinafter. If any professional college choose not to admit from the common entrance test conducted by the association then that college must necessarily admit from the common entrance test conducted by the State. After holding the common entrance test and declaration of results the merit list will immediately be placed on the notice board of the colleges which have chosen to admit as per this test. A copy of the merit list will also be forthwith sent to the concerned authority and the committee. Selection of students must then be strictly on the basis of merit as per that merit list.” (emphasis supplied)

In view of the above, quoted direction of Hon'ble Supreme court, Samiti can not to accede to the request made by the aforesaid institutes.

Item No. 6: To consider, discuss and decide on Proposals for Approval of the admissions yet to be submitted for Academic Year 2012-13 and 2013-14. (List Attached)

Samiti perused the list of college under reference

Samiti observes that the decision taken about Schedule for Submission of Online Admissions in its meeting held on 16th July 2013 at [Item no. 3 (D)] was not followed by colleges/Institutes and Expert Committee.

Samiti observes the decision it took in it's meeting held on 18th April 2013 and 20th June 2014 [at Item no. 3 (c)] for the Academic Year 2012-13 and 2013-14 respectively, the extract of the decision which read as under:-

For the Academic Year 2012-13

"Those who submitted their admission details online before 30th March 2013 but did not submit their proposals for approval of admissions they will submit them alongwith the Penalty of Rs. 25000/- for late submission."


For the Academic Year 2013-14

1. *After deliberation Samiti decides that Those who have not submitted their admission details online upto 30th March 2014 and did not submit their proposal for approval of admissions the penalty will be charged **Rs. 1,00,000/- per course.***
2. *Samiti also decides that the colleges who yet not submitted their proposals should submit before 30th July 2014 with Rs. 1,00,000/- Penalty.*
3. *Samiti further decides that, after 30th July 2014 the proposals for approval of admissions, same to be notice of Pravesh Niyrantr Samiti for further action such as disaffiliation/non approval of admissions etc."*

In view of the above after deliberations Samiti directs the Expert committee to submit verification report of these colleges within four weeks. After receipt of said report from office of Director Technical Education Mumbai, matter to be placed before Samiti for its consideration.
