Samiti perused the action taken report on the decisions arrived at in its previous meeting held on 24th June, 2013 details of which are as below:-

Samiti noted and approved it.

Item No. 3(a) : To discuss, consider and ratify the decisions taken on circulatory submission on 5th July 2013 regarding Government resolution dated 4th July 2013 in respect of MBBS and BDS admission process for the Academic Year 2013-14.

Samiti perused the GR No. डब्ल्यूपीएम १०१२/प्र.क्र.१६५/१२/शिक्षण-२ dated 4/7/2013. Noted the contents.

Attention is drawn to the Mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court's in (2003) 6 Supreme Court cases 697 Islamic Academy of Education v. State of Karnataka Para No. 16 as re- produced hereunder:

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" We thus hold that the management could select students, of their quota, either on the basis of the common entrance test conducted by the State or on the basis of a common entrance test to be conducted by an association of all colleges of a particular type in that State e.g. medical, engineering or technical etc. The common entrance test, held by the association, must be for admission to all colleges of that type in the State. The option of choosing, between either of these tests, must be exercised before issuing of prospectus and after intimation to the concerned authority and the Committee set up hereinafter. If any professional college chooses not to admit from the common entrance test conducted by the association then that college must necessarily admit from the common entrance test conducted by the State. After holding the common entrance test and declaration of results the merit list will immediately be placed on the notice-board of all colleges which have chosen to admit as per this test. A copy of the merit list will also be forthwith sent to the concerned authority and the Committee. Selection of students must then be strictly on the basis of merit as per that merit List".

Government to initiate actions suitably and in accordance with the above.

Item No. 4: To discuss, decide and plan for the verification of admission process in Health Science courses for Academic Year 2013-14.

After deliberation, Samiti directs the institutions to follow as under:

- 1) Colleges to follow the schedule of admissions as directed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi & Hon'ble High Court of India, of Mumbai.
- 2) The Colleges to submit their admission details within 15 days after the cut off dates as prescribed by the appropriate authority, online.

3. Expert Committees & their role:

A) For Medical & Dental (UG & PG)

Expert committee (PNS) shall be headed by the Director, Medical Education and Research, M.S., The Director, Medical Education and Research will appoint two other members who shall be drawn from the officers of Medical Education & Research Department and who shall be not below the ranks of Dy. Director.

- a) Committee will verify the merit lists of the admitted students, where the admissions have been granted through CAP process for First year Medical and Dental, Where the admissions are done in violation of triple test, same are to be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- b) Committee will verify the merit lists of the admitted students, where the admissions done through institute level, vacancy against CAP minority quota and Admissions against NRI Quota Medical & Dental (UG & PG). Where the

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admissions are done in violation of triple test , same are to be brought to the notice of Samiti.

- c) Committee will submit the reports for Academic Year 2013-14 to Samiti before 15th November 2013.

B) For BAMS, BHMS, BUMS, BASLP, B.P.TH, B.O.TH, B.Sc, Nursing and P.B.Sc. Nursing (UG & PG)

Expert Committee (PNS) shall be headed by the Registrar Maharashtra University of Health Science (MUHS), Nashik. The Registrar Maharashtra University of Health Science (MUHS) will appoint two other members who shall be drawn from the officers of Maharashtra University of Health Science (MUHS) and who shall be not below the ranks of Dy. Registrar.

- i) Committee will check & verify the admissions done in private BAMS, BHMS, BUMS, BASLP, B.P.TH, B.O.TH, B.Sc, Nursing and P.B.Sc. Nursing (UG & PG) Colleges/Institutes. Where the admissions are done in violation of triple tests , same be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- ii) Committee will verify the merit lists of the admitted students, where the admissions done through institute level, vacancy against CAP minority quota and Admissions against NRI Quota BAMS, BHMS, BUMS, BASLP, B.P.TH, B.O.TH, B.Sc, Nursing and P.B.Sc. Nursing (UG & PG), where the admissions are done in violation of triple tests , same be brought to the notice of Samiti.
- iii) Committee will submit the reports for Academic Year 2013-14 to Samiti before 15th November 2013.

C) Schedule for Submission for online Admission details

- i) All Colleges/ Institutes shall submit the lists of admissions online only within 15 days to PNS immediately after the admissions are over for the academic year.
- ii) Where Colleges/ Institutes submit their admissions online after the due dates mentioned as above, penalty will be charged as under:-
- a) Upto 31st October every year Rs. 10,000/- per course
- b) Upto 30th November every year Rs. 50,000/- per course
- iii) After 30th November in case of failure/ non observance of due dates same be brought to the notice of PNS for further actions.

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Item No. 5: To discuss and decide in respect of the complaints/representations received during the admission process - Academic Year 2013-14.

Samiti noted that no complaints have been received so far till 15th July 2013.

Item No. 6: To consider and decide in respect of the decision taken by the Hon'ble Shikshan Shulka Samiti, Mumbai in its meeting held on 13th June 2013 regarding refund of fees of Shri Sharad Jaysing Patil.

Samiti perused the letter dated 25th June 2013 received from Shri Sharad Jaysing Patil regarding refund of fees, Samiti also perused the reference received from Shikshan Shulka Samiti. Samiti went through the relevant portion of the minutes of said Samiti.

After deliberation, Samiti directs the Institute to submit its report to PNS within seven days positively.

Item No. 7: To consider and decide on the letters/representations received:

Item No. 7(a): Letter dated 24th June received from K.K. Wagh College of Nursing, Nashik asking permission for admissions to B.Sc. Nursing Course on the basis of i) Asso-CET-2013, ii) NEET-UG-CET-2013 (including disqualified students in NEET-UG-CET-2013), iii) MT-CET-2013 and iv) Non CET for the Academic Year 2013-14.

Samiti perused the letter dated 2/7/2013 received from K.K. Wagh College of Nursing Nashik asking the permission for admissions to B.Sc. Nursing Course on the basis of i) Asso-CET-2013, ii) NEET-UG-CET-2013 (including disqualified students in NEET-UG-CET-2013), iii) MT-CET-2013 and iv) Non CET for the Academic Year 2013-14.

After deliberation, Samiti feels it appropriate, proper just and reasonable that the Colleges need to admit students from amongst the merit lists drawn on the basis of results of only one CET . Office to inform.

Item No. 7(b) : Letter dated 22nd June 2013 received from Jaslok College of Nursing, Mumbai asking permission to admit the students those appeared NEET-UG-CET-2013 and disqualified candidates in NEET-UG-CET-2013 for B.Sc. Nursing Course for the Academic Year 2013-14.

Samiti perused the letter dated 22/6/2013 received from Jaslok Hospital , Jaslok College of Nursing asking for guidance as to whether the students who have appeared NEET-UG- CET-2013 and not qualified in NEET-UG-CET-2013 can be considered for B.Sc. Nursing Course for the Academic Year 2013-14. After deliberation Samiti feels it appropriate, proper , just & reasonable , that the Colleges need to admit

students from amongst the merit lists drawn on the basis of results of only one CET .
Office to inform.

Item No. 7(c) : Letter dated 25th May 2013 received from College of Nursing Dr. Balabhai Nanavati Hospital, Mumbai informing that they are unable to admit new batch of nursing students for the Academic Year 2013-14.

Samiti noted the contents.

Item No.7(d): Letter dated 6th July 2013 received from Association of Managements of Homoeopathic Medical Colleges of Maharashtra, Mumbai asking for permission to admit 12th HSC pass candidates to for first year B.H.M.S. course for the Academic Year 2013-14.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

The Institute has requested to allow it to admit the candidates who have appeared for Asso CET 2013 & NEET-UG-2013 (irrespective of the results,). The Institute has also requested to allow it to admit the candidates who have appeared for MT CET 2013. The Institute further requests to allow it to admit Non-CET candidates to Basic BSC Nursing Course.

After deliberation Samiti concludes that the aspect of considering admissions to students drawn otherwise than the source of only one CET does not satisfy the mandate contemplated by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in (2003) 6 Supreme Court cases 697 Islamic Academy of Education v. State of Karnataka Para No. 16 as re- produced hereunder:

" We thus hold that the management could select students, of their quota, either on the basis of the common entrance test conducted by the State or on the basis of a common entrance test to be conducted by an association of all colleges of a particular type in that State e.g. medical, engineering or technical etc. The common entrance test, held by the association, must be for admission to all colleges of that type in the State. The option of choosing, between either of these tests, must be exercised before issuing of prospectus and after intimation to the concerned authority and the Committee set up hereinafter. If any professional college chooses not to admit from the common entrance test conducted by the association then that college must necessarily admit from the common entrance test conducted by the State. After holding the common entrance test and declaration of results the merit list will immediately be placed on the notice-board of all colleges which have chosen to admit as per this test. A copy of the merit list will also be forthwith sent to the concerned authority and the Committee. Selection of students must then be strictly on the basis of merit as per that merit List".

After deliberation, Samiti concludes that the aspect of considering the admissions to 12th HSC pass candidates without having any reference to any of the CET's for first year B.A.M.S course does not come within the purview of Samiti in view of provisions contemplated in the orders passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in (2003) 6 Supreme Court cases 697 Islamic Academy of Education v. State of Karnataka Para No. 16 as re- produced hereunder:

" We thus hold that the management could select students, of their quota, either on the basis of the common entrance test conducted by the State or on the basis of a common entrance test to be conducted by an association of all colleges of a particular type in that State e.g. medical, engineering or technical etc. The common entrance test, held by the association, must be for admission to all colleges of that type in the State. The option of choosing, between either of these tests, must be exercised before issuing of prospectus and after intimation to the concerned authority and the Committee set up hereinafter. If any professional college chooses not to admit from the common entrance test conducted by the association then that college must necessarily admit from the common entrance test conducted by the State.
