Considering above, after deliberation, Samiti concludes that the decision taken by Samiti in its meeting held on 12th December 2014 (at Item No. 8[a] and 10[b]) warrants no change. All decisions of the Committee those were taken herein before in respect of approval of admissions of First Year M.B.B.S. course for the Academic Year 2014-15 of Institute of Medical Sciences and Research, Satara stand as they are without any alterations, modifications, etc. Aggrieved party can seek the remedy against the decision of Samiti if at all it feels aggrieved before the appropriate authority empowered by law. Samiti makes it clear that as per the directions issued under the Judgment of Constitutional bench of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India (2003) 6 Supreme Court cases 697 in Islamic Academy of Education v. State of Karnataka para no. 16, directing that admissions to all professional courses need to have to be on the basis of Common Entrance Test held by the State or Association of the private, Unaided colleges per the said judgement. Admissions based on this judgment followed by the Common Entrance Test to professional (Under Graduate and Post Graduate) courses can be only monitored by this Committee.

In view of the above, after deliberation, Samiti decides not to accede to the request of the aforesaid College/Institute to approve the admissions of admitted students for Post Graduate MDS course and First Year BDS course for the Academic Year 2014-15. Office to inform accordingly.

- b) CET should be conducted at the centers located in non faculty Colleges and staff of examination i.e. Supervisor, Invigilator, Center In-charge and other staff should be drawn from non faculty.
- c) List of notified centers with details of seating arrangement made in each such centers and list of eligible candidates appearing for examination to be provided to Samiti. No. of seats available college wise to be provided to Samiti.
- d) Schedule of CET and CAP should be as per directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi, if any.
- e) Result of CET should be displayed on website and the notice boards. Result of CET-2014 to be submitted to the Samiti office, within two days from the date of declaration of result.

Association should also ensure that colleges must have submitted Fee Approval proposals to Shikshan Shulka Samiti, Maharashtra State for finalization of fees structure for the Academic Year 2015-16. It should also to be ensured that allotment of students is done only to the Colleges/Courses who are permitted/affiliated to Council/University for the academic year 2015-16. Association should ensure that colleges submit the list of admissions within two days form the cut off date to Samiti's office.
- g) Association conducting CET/ CAP should communicate to Samiti's office vacancy details immediately after the last round is over but within 7 days.
- h) The Competent Authority of the Association and / or Representatives of Director, Medical Education and Research, Maharashtra State will be Grievance Redressal Authority who will take care of all complaints of students/parents during CET examinations and admission process. Association should further ensure appointment of appellate authority to hear and decide and dispose of grievances against the decisions of said competent authority.
- i) All admissions to be done on the basis of CET conducted by the Association with the requisite mark.
- j) Association/Colleges are directed to display details of their infrastructure available on their website.
- k) Association should submit detailed information in respect of appointments of moderators/examiners their names qualifications, etc to Samiti immediately.
- l) Samiti further directs the Association to submit the following information to office from time to time without fail:-
- i) No. of students appeared
 - ii) No. of students qualified in the Exam.
 - iii) No. of participating Colleges with subjects and their sanctioned intake capacity.
 - iv) Course/Subject/category wise seat matrix of each round, before and after rounds.
 - v) List of selected candidates after each round.
 - vi) Details of complaints received during the process and details of action taken by Competent Authority and the Appliate Authority.
- m) **Annexure A & B** : It should be ensured that the Colleges/Subjects incorporated in the lists are having all permissions, affiliations of their respective Councils, Central Government, Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik and Government of Maharashtra Students to be allotted to these colleges only.



Where seats are likely to be increased, Association/College/Institute to publish the details before hand in Local as well as State Level News papers, notice boards and websites of association and/or respective College also and invite/call the fresh preferences / choices from the candidates for such seats.

- o) **Rule 18 : Refund of Fees :** The Association/Colleges/Institutes are directed to follow following in the matter of refund of fees and incorporate the same clause as follows:
- i) "If a candidate cancels his/her admission before the cut-off-date, then College/Institute has deduct only Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges and balance amount of fees paid by a student be refunded within two days, otherwise the same amount to profiteering and charging of capitation fees. The Samiti further directs that the College/Institute should also return the original documents / certificates collected from the students within two days.
 - ii) If a candidate expires within three months from the date of admission full refund shall be made after deducting Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges.
 - iii) After cut-off-date except as in (ii) above no refund shall be made.

Samiti further directs, to incorporate following changes in final Rules and Information Brochure of CET-2015 as suggested by Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai Maharashtra State, as follows:-

- 1) The rule of eligibility criteria, conduct of examination, preparation of Result and Merit list using tie break are at par with the rules prescribed by Director, Medical Education and Research in their brochures of PGM/PGD-CET-2015.
- 2) The admission to Post Graduate Medical/Dental courses will be subject to permission of MCI / DCI, Government of India, Maharashtra Government and Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

Samiti, subject to the incorporation of the aforesaid changes/conditions, grants its approval to the draft brochure of APGM/APGDC-CET-2015 of Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra for admissions to Post Graduate Medical and Dental courses for Academic Year 2014-15. Office to inform accordingly.

Item No. 7(b): Letter dated 20th January 2015 received from Jamia Islamia Ishaatul Uloom, Akkalkuwa, Nandurbar asking permission to conduct CET-2015 for Minority Quota admissions in First Year MBBS course for the Academic Year 2015-16.

Samiti perused aforesaid letter received from Jamia Islamia Ishaatul Uloom, Akkalkuwa, Nandurbar asking permission to conduct CET-2015 for Minority Quota admissions in First Year MBBS course for the Academic Year 2015-16.

Samiti observes that per the law laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its judgment in the case of Islamic Academy versus State of Karnataka (2003) 6 supreme Court cases 697 (para 16) there is no provision for separate CET for minority institutes.

In view of the above, after deliberations, Samiti decides not to accede to the request made by the aforesaid Institute. Office to inform accordingly.

Item No.7(c): To consider and decide the Observation/Verification report dated 9th February 2015 submitted by the Expert Committee i.e. Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of admissions process of Under Graduate and Post Graduate Courses for the Academic Year 2014-15.

Samiti perused the Observation/Verification report dated 9th February 2014 submitted by the Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Maharashtra State in respect of the admission process of Under Graduate and Post Graduate Courses for the Academic Year 2014-15.

After deliberation Samiti decides that, where there are no discrepancies such admissions stand approved, where there are discrepancies such admission are approved, subject to the Expert Committee sorting out and disposing off with said discrepancies after appropriate compliances within four weeks from respective Institutions, the details which are enclosed as **Annexure - A.**

Samiti further decides that admissions of the Colleges/Institutes - as listed in **Annexure - B** will be approved for Academic Year 2014-15 only after receipt of appropriate payment of penalty as decided and directed by Samiti in its meeting held on 12th December 2014 at Item No. 10(b) sub clause (4). Office to take necessary steps.

Item No.7(d): To consider and decide the Observation/Verification report dated 10th February 2015 submitted by the Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Maharashtra State in respect of admissions process of First Year Health Science Courses for the Academic Year 2012-13 and 2014-15.

Samiti perused the Observation/Verification report dated 9th February 2014 submitted by the Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Maharashtra State in respect of the admission process of First Year Health Science Courses for the Academic Year 2012-13 and 2014-15.

After deliberation Samiti decides that, where there are no discrepancies such admissions stand approved, where there are discrepancies such admission are approved, subject to the Expert Committee sorting out and disposing off with said discrepancies after appropriate compliances within four weeks from respective Institutions, the details which are enclosed as **Annexure - C.**

- 1) It is observed that Expert Committee in its report at Sr. No. 2 has pointed out that 100 candidates of Indian Institute of Medical Sciences and Research Center, Jalna are selected for Academic Year 2014-15 by Central Admission process of DMER, Mumbai. Out of these one candidate Shabnam Bano (MH-CET-2014 - SML No. 2061) is cancelled their admission and one candidate Reema Riyaaheen (MH-CET-2014 : SML No. 3971) is selected against vacancy at Institute level and she secured requisite marks in CET.

In view of the above, after deliberations Samiti decides to approved the 100 admissions of selected candidates in First Year M.B.B.S. course for the Academic Year 2014-15 of Indian Institute of Medical Sciences and Research Center, Jalna. Office to inform accordingly.

- 2) It is observed that Expert Committee in its report at Sr. No. 3 has pointed out that SMBT Medical College, Nashik has not submitted the list of applicants, hence its cannot be verified whether college has selected meritorious candidates in each category or not.

In view of the above, after deliberations Samiti directs the Colleges to submit the list of applicants along with other relevant information within 15 days. Samiti further decides not to approve the admissions of selected students in First Year M.B.B.S. course for the Academic Year 2014-15 of S.M.B.T. Medical College, Nashik on the basis of Expert Committee's report. Office to inform accordingly.

Attention is drawn on the circular bearing no. MCI-34(MC)/2014/149869, dated 16th January 2015 issued by the Medical Council of India, New Delhi regarding conduct of Entrance Examination for NRI students for admission in MBBS course.

Samiti after carefully going through the above circular, after deliberations directs to the Competent Authority, Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Maharashtra State and Competent Authority, Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra to make provisions in CET for NRI's for the admissions of First Year M.B.B.S. course from the Academic Year 2015-16, Office to take necessary steps and inform accordingly.
