The copy of draft brochure in respect of ASSO-PGH-CET-2014 for admissions to Post Graduate Homoeopathy courses for the Academic Year 2014-15 submitted by aforesaid Association is sent to the Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of AYUSH, Maharashtra State and Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik for their scrutiny and expert comments/remarks. Somaiya Medical College and Research Center, Mumbai requesting to allow it to admit students in Management Quota from amongst the students who have appeared All India CET, PGM-CET or any CET for Post Graduate Medical course for the Academic Year 2014-15.

Samiti perused the aforesaid letter dated 20th February 2014 received from K.J. Somaiya Medical College and Research Center, Mumbai requesting to allow it to admit students in Management Quota from amongst students who are appeared in All India CET, PGM-CET or any an CET for Post Graduate Medical courses for the Academic Year 2014-15.

Samiti observes that the aforesaid College has opted for admission process being conducted by Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Maharashtra State on the basis of results of PGM-CET-2014 for admissions to Post Graduate Medical courses for the Academic Year 2014-15.

In view of the above, after deliberations, Samiti directs the College to admit students from the merit list drawn on the basis of results of only one CET as contemplated and mandated by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India is (2003) 6 Supreme Court cases 697 Islamic Academy of Education v. State of Karnataka Para No. 16 as reproduced hereunder:

" We thus hold that the management could select students, of their quota, either on the basis of the common entrance test conducted by the State or on the basis of a common entrance test to be conducted by an association of all colleges of a particular type in that State e.g. medical, engineering or technical etc. The common entrance test, held by the association, must be for admission to all colleges of that type in the State. The option of choosing, between either of these tests, must be exercised before issuing of prospectus and after intimation to the concerned authority and the Committee set up hereinafter. If any professional college chooses not to admit from the common entrance test conducted by the association then that college must necessarily admit from the common entrance test conducted by the State. After holding the common entrance test and declaration of results the merit list will immediately be placed on the notice-board of all colleges which have chosen to admit as per this test. A copy of the merit list will also be forthwith sent to the concerned authority and the Committee. Selection of students must then be strictly on the basis of merit as per that merit List".

Office to inform accordingly.

If any professional college chooses not to admit from the common entrance test conducted by the association then that college must necessarily admit from the common entrance test conducted by the State. After holding the common entrance test and declaration of results the merit list will immediately be placed on the notice-board of all colleges which have chosen to admit as per this test. A copy of the merit list will also be forthwith sent to the concerned authority and the Committee. Selection of students must then be strictly on the basis of merit as per that merit List".


