Item No. 6: **To consider the letter dated nil received from Registrar, High Court of Bombay in the matter of Writ Petition No. 3235 of 2015 viz. – Sinhgad Dental College, Pune along with Hon'ble High Court order dated 21st April 2015.**

After deliberations Samiti feels no action was necessary at this stage from Samiti. Court orders to be obeyed. Office to take necessary steps.

Item No. 7: **To discuss and decide the letter dated 25th July 2015 received from Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra submitting data of Second Round of Asso-CET-2015.**

The CD containing the data of Second Round of Asso-CET-2015 submitted by Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra is sent to the Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai for their scrutiny and remarks/suggestions vide office letter dated 1st August 2015.

Report of Expert Committee is not yet received. Samiti directs the Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai to verify and scrutinize the result submitted by the Association and submit his report to Samiti within one week, positively. Office to inform accordingly.

Item No. 8: **To discuss and decide the letter dated 21st July 2015 received from Directorate of AYUSH, M.S. regarding draft brochure of APGA-CET-2015 for the admissions of Post Graduate Ayurved Courses for the Academic Year 2015-16.**

Office of the Directorate of AYUSH, Maharashtra State has stated in the aforesaid letter that process of selling application forms and information brochure was started from 1/7/2015 and the said draft brochure was received in the directorates office on 7/7/2015. Admission process being already started, Director feels his remarks/suggestion on the draft brochure of APGA-CET-2015 for the admissions of Post Graduate Ayurved Courses for the Academic Year 2015-16 were not necessary.

Samiti feels that the association should have submitted the draft brochure well in advance within a reasonable time period to enable the authorities to verify and scrutinize the details in the instant case, authorities could not pass on the remarks since the brochure happened to have submitted at the eleventh hour. This could have been avoided.

After deliberations, Samiti directs to the Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of AYUSH, Maharashtra State to verify and scrutinize the said draft brochure of APGA-CET-2015 and submit its report to Samiti within one week, positively. Office to inform accordingly.

Item No. 9(a): **To ratify the decision on circulatory submission in respect of a letter dated 12th May 2015 received from Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra requesting to visit and observe the Asso-CET-2015, along with office note dated 13/05/2015.**

Aforesaid letter received from Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra, Mumbai requesting to visit and observe the process Asso-CET-2015. Said letter was circulated amongst the members of Samiti for the decision vide its circulatory submission dated 13th May 2014. Samiti ratifies the decision.

Item No. 9(b): **To ratify the decision on circulatory submission in respect of a letter dated 23rd April 2015 received from Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik regarding approval of Post Graduate Ayurved admissions on the basis of Non-CET for the Academic Year 2014-15, along with office note dated 8/5/2015.**

Aforesaid letter received from Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik regarding approval of Post Graduate Ayurved admissions on the basis of Non-CET for the Academic Year 2014-15, letter was circulated amongst the members of Samiti for the decision vide its circulatory submission dated 8th May 2014.

In view of the fact that the Association of Management of Ayurvedic Medical Colleges of Maharashtra has filed writ petition viz. – No. 12376 and 12125 in Hon'ble High Court. Samiti decides that matter being subjudice, will be disposed off after the decision by Hon'ble High Court. Samiti ratifies the said decision.

Item No. 9(c): **To ratify the decision on circulatory submission in respect of a letters dated 15th, 18th and 30th May 2015 received from i) Seva Mandal Education society's College of Nursing, Mumbai, ii) Shri Yashvant Shikshan Prasarak Mandal, Kodoli, Kolhapur and iii) B.K.L. Walavalkar Rural Medical College, Ratnagiri, respectively asking for permission to enlist with Govt. CET for the Academic Year 2015-16, along with office note dated 2/6/2015.**

Samiti perused aforesaid letters received from i) Seva Mandal Education society's College of Nursing, Mumbai, ii) Shri Yashvant Shikshan Prasarak Mandal, Kodoli, Kolhapur and iii) B.K.L. Walavalkar Rural Medical College, Ratnagiri respectively asking for permission to enlist with Government CET for the Academic Year 2015-16, said letter was circulated amongst the members of Samiti for the decision vide its circulatory submission on 2/6/2015. Samiti subject to the observation as at Agenda Item No. 3 above, after deliberations, grants its permission to aforesaid College/Institute to join State CET and to follow CET rules as per Government policy, subject to final approval/affiliation/permissions from respective Authorities. Office to inform accordingly.

Item No. 9(d): **Letter dated 9th January 2015 received from Post Graduate Institute of Swasthiyog Pratishthan, Miraj asking for approval of admission of admitted candidate on the basis of AICET-2014 for the Post Graduate Medical course for the Academic Year 2014-15 - Ref.: Minutes of the meeting dated 12/12/2015 at Item No. 8(e) (f) & (g) along with office note.**

Samiti perused the aforesaid letter received from Swasthiyog Pratishthan, Miraj asking for approval of admission of admitted candidate on the basis of AICET-2014 for the Post Graduate Medical Course for the Academic Year 2014-15.

It is noticed that aforesaid College/Institute in its affidavit dated 30th May 2015 stated that an advertisement was published in newspaper, but the copy of the newspapers was not submitted.

In view of above, after deliberation, Samiti directs to the College/Institute to submit all relevant documents before Samiti in respect of approval of admission on the basis of AICET-2014 for the Post Graduate Medical course for the Academic Year 2014-15. Office to inform accordingly.

Item No. 9(e): Letter dated 2nd January 2015 received from C.S.M.S.S. Dental College Aurangabad asking for approval of admission of Dr. Chetan Dilip Zavar admitted on the basis of Govt. – NEET-MDS-CET-2013 for the Post Graduate MDS course for the Academic Year 2013-14 – Ref.: Minutes of the meeting dated 12/12/2015 at Item No. 8(e) (f) & (g) along with office note.

Samiti perused the aforesaid letter received from C.S.M.S.S. Dental College, Aurangabad regarding approval of admission of Dr. Chetan Dilip Zavar admitted on the basis of Govt. – NEET-MDS-CET-2013 for the Post Graduate MDS course for the Academic Year 2013-14.

Samiti went through the decisions taken by it in its earlier meetings.

Aforesaid College/Institute in its affidavit has stated that "merit has not been compromised and no injustice has been done to any of the candidates and none of the meritorious student was denied admission and no candidate has filed any complaint against the College for Post Graduate Admission process in the Academic Year 2013-14".

In view of the above, after deliberations, Samiti decides to approve the admission of Dr. Chetan Dilip Zavar admitted in Post Graduate Dental Course in Academic Year 2013-14, subject of fulfillment of rules, regulation, norms and eligibility criteria laid down by the respective authorities. Office to inform.

Item No. 10: To consider and decide the Government resolution dated 29th April 2015 regarding admission process in respect of the B.Sc. Nursing course from the Academic Year 2015-16.

Samiti perused the Government resolution bearing no. एमईडी १०१५/प्र.क्र. ७६/१५/शिक्षण-२, dated 29th April 2015. Noted, subject to the observations of the Samiti as at Agenda Item No. 3 above.

Item No. 11: Letter dated 5th June 2015 received from Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra regarding online examinations of Association CET's from the Academic Year 2016-17.

Samiti perused the aforesaid letter received from Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra regarding online examinations of Association CET's from the Academic Year 2016-17.

Samiti also went through the contents of Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and fees) ordinance published on 12th May 2015.

Samiti after deliberations comes to the conclusion that it was beyond the competence of the Samiti to grant permissions to hold CETs from the Academic Year 2016-17. Samiti feels that such a permission can not be granted by Samiti at this juncture, as the Ordinance dated 12th May 2015 has come into force with immediate effects from the date of publication in the Government official Gazette. Office to inform accordingly.

The above data submitted by Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra is sent to the Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai for their scrutiny and remarks/suggestions vide office letter dated 1st August 2015.

Reports of Expert Committee are not yet received. Samiti directs the Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai to verify and scrutinize the above data submitted by the Association and submit the reports to Samiti within one week, positively. After receipt of the same it be placed before Samiti for its consideration. Office to inform accordingly.

Item No. 13: To consider and decide on the letter dated 8th May 2015 received from Desk Officer, Medical Education and Drugs Department along with letter 20th January 2015 from Dr. Vijay Kumar Agarwal regarding UG and PG complaint admission process of Private Medical Colleges of Maharashtra.

Samiti perused the aforesaid letter received from Desk Officer, Medical Education and Drugs Department along with letter dated 20th January 2015 from Dr. Vijay Kumar Agarwal complaining against UG and PG admission process of Private Medical Colleges of Maharashtra.

After deliberation, Samiti decides to send the complaint to Director Medical Education and Research, M.S. for investigation in the matter and also inform the Government of Maharashtra through the Addi. Chief Secretary, Medical Education and Drugs Department, Mantralaya, Mumbai. Office to inform accordingly.

Item No. 14: To discuss and decide on letters/representations received from:-

Item No. 14(a): Letter dated 9th June 2015 received from Directorate of AYUSH, Maharashtra State submitting the report of Expert Committee on draft brochure of Asso-PGH-CET-2015 - Ref.: Minutes of the meeting dated 30th April 2015 (Item No. 6[a]).

Samiti perused the aforesaid letter received from Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of AYUSH, Maharashtra State regarding remarks on draft brochure of Asso-PGH-CET-2015 for the admissions of Post Graduate Homoeopathy Courses for the Academic Year 2015-16.

Considering the suggestions of Expert Committee on the draft brochure and after deliberations and in view of the guidance/interpretation received from Government of Maharashtra vide its letter quoted at Item No. 3 above, Samiti allows the Association of Management of Homoeopathic Medical Colleges of Maharashtra to conduct Asso-PGH-CET-2015 for admission to Post Graduate Homoeopathy courses for Academic Year 2015-16, Subject to the following:-

- a) CET and CAP should be conducted in fair and transparent manner and as per the directives, orders, norms, rules and regulations laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi, 2) Hon'ble High Courts, 3) Central Council of Homoeopathy, New Delhi, 4) Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik, 5) Govt. of Maharashtra and 6) Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti, Maharashtra State.
- b) List of notified centers with details of seating arrangement made in each such centers and list of eligible candidates appearing for examination to be provided to Samiti. No. of seats available college wise to be provided to Samiti.
- c) Schedule of CET and CAP should be as per directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi, Central Council of Homoeopathy, New Delhi and Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik, if any.
- d) Result of CET should be displayed on website and the notice boards of the Association. Result of CET-2014 to be submitted to the Samiti office, within two days from the date of declaration of result.
- e) Association should ensure that allotment of students to colleges is made strictly as per merit and as per the options of choices exercised. Association should also ensure that colleges submit Fee Approval proposals to Shikshan Shulka Samiti, Maharashtra State for finalization of fee structure for the Academic Year 2015-16. It should also to be ensured that allotment of students is done only to the colleges who are permitted/affiliated to Council/University for the academic year 2015-16. Association should ensure that colleges submit the list of admissions within two days from the cut off date to Samiti's office.
- f) Association conducting CET/ CAP should communicate to Samiti's office vacancy details immediately after the each round is over.
- g) The Competent Authority of the Association and / or Representatives of Director, Directorate of AYUSH, Maharashtra State will be Grievance Redressal Authority who will take care of all complaints of students/parents during CET examinations and admission process. Association should further ensure appointment of appellate authority to hear and decide and dispose of grievances against the decisions of said competent authority.
- h) All admissions to be done on the basis of CET conducted by the Association with the requisite mark.
- i) Association/Colleges are directed to display details of their infrastructure available on their website.



- j) Association should submit detailed information in respect of appointments of moderators/examiners their names qualifications, etc to Samiti immediately..
- k) Samiti further directs the Association to submit the following information to office from time to time without fail:-
- i) No. of students appeared
 - ii) No. of students qualified in the Exam.
 - iii) No. of participating Colleges with subjects and their sanctioned intake capacity.
 - iv) Course/Subject/category wise seat matrix of each round, before and after rounds.
 - v) List of selected candidates after each round.
 - vi) Details of complaints received during the process and details of action taken by Competent Authority and the Appellate Authority.

Samiti further directs, to incorporate following changes in final Rules and Information Brochure of ASSO-PGH-CET-2015 as suggested by Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of AYUSH, Maharashtra State, listed in **Annexure - A**.

- l) Samiti further directs the Association/Colleges/Institutes to follow following in the matter of refund of fees and incorporate the said clause in the brochure:-
- I) "If a candidate cancels his/her admission before the cut-off-date, then College/Institute has deduct only Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges and balance amount of fees paid by a student be refunded within two days, otherwise the same amount to profiteering and charging of capitation fees. The Samiti further directs that the College/Institute should also return the original documents / certificates collected from the students within two days.
 - II) If a candidate expires within three months from the date of admission full refund shall be made after deducting Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges.
 - III) After cut-off-date except as in (b) above no refund shall be made.

In view of the foregoing Samiti resolves as under :

"Association should ensure that the Colleges incorporated in the lists are having all permissions, affiliations of their respective Councils, Central Government, Department of AYUSH, New Delhi, Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik and Government of Maharashtra. Students to be allotted to such colleges only.

Where seats are likely to be increased, Association should publish the details before hand in Local as well State Level News papers, notice boards and websites of association and respective Colleges also. It should also call for the fresh preferences / choices from the candidates for such seats.

Office to inform accordingly.

Samiti perused the aforesaid letters received from Mr. Prakash Ramchandra Alhat and Yogita Dental College, Khed, Ratnagiri regarding refund of fees.

It is observed that aforesaid College/Institute in its letters dated 11th and 13th June 2015 stated that Miss. Devyani Prakash Alhat has cancelled her admission on 27th September 2014 and the cut-off-date for the course was 30th September 2014

While approving the draft brochure of Asso-CET-2014 by the Samiti in its meeting held on 20th June 2014 at Item No. 6[a], clause (o) sub clause (i) has resolved as under:-

- i) *"If a candidate cancels his/her admission before the cut-off-date, then College/Institute has deduct only Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges and balance amount of fees paid by a student be refunded within two days, otherwise the same amount to profiteering and charging of capitation fees. The Samiti further directs that the College/Institute should also return the original documents / certificates collected from the students within two days.*

In view of the above, after deliberations, Samiti directs the aforesaid College/Institute to follow the above decision and deduct only Rs. 1,000/- and refund the entire amount of fees along with all original documents to Miss. Devyani Prakash Alhat immediately. Office to take necessary steps and inform accordingly.

Item No. 14(e): Letter dated 6th May 2015 received from Akhil Bhartiya Vidyarthi Parishad, Mumbai complaining against admission process of Pravara Medical College, Loni, Ahmednagar.

Samiti perused all the above complaints made by Akhil Bhartiya Vidyarthi Parishad, Mumbai against admission process of Pravara Medical College, Loni, Ahmednagar.

Pravara Medical College, Loni, Ahmednagar happens to be the Deemed University.

As per the definition contained in Chapter – I, clause (2), 2 sub clause (q) (ii) of the Ordinance No. VII of 2015 dated 12th May 2015, Pravara Medical College, Loni, Ahmednagar does not come within the purview of this Samiti it can not therefore entertain this complaint for want of the jurisdiction. Office to communicate.

Item No. 14(f): Letter dated 20th April 2015 received from Jamia Islamia Ishaatul Uloom, Akkalkuwa, Nandurbar asking for approval for Minority CET for the admissions of First Year MBBS course for the Academic Year 2015-16 along with Hon'ble High Court order dated 13th April 2015 in WP No. 3161/2015.

Samiti perused aforesaid letter received from Jamia Islamia Ishaatul Uloom, Akkalkuwa, Nandurbar asking for approval for Minority CET for the Admissions of First year MBBS course for the Academic Year 2015-16 along with Hon'ble High Court order dated 13th April 2015 in Writ Petition No. 3161 of 2015.

After deliberation, Samiti feels no action was necessary at this stage from Samiti. Court Orders to be obeyed. Office to inform accordingly.

Item No. 14(g): Letter dated 20th March and 15th May 2015 received from Shaan Education Society's Guardian College of Dental Sciences and Research Center, Thane asking for Minority CET for the admissions of First Year BDS course for the Academic Year 2015-16.

Samiti after deliberations comes to the conclusion that it was beyond the competence of the Samiti to permit the said institute to conduct Minority CET for the Academic Year 2015-16 as per the provisions of Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and fees) ordinance published on 12th May 2015. Application is liable to be rejected. Therefore rejected.
