After deliberation, Samiti directs the aforesaid Association and concerned Colleges to follow the above schedule strictly. The seats remaining unfilled shall be filled in by these Colleges at their own level strictly in accordance with inter-se merit of the applicants and in a fair and transparent manner. Samiti further decides that those who fail to submit their admissions details to Samiti, admission process of the said Colleges/Institutes will not be regularized by Samiti for the Academic Year 2012-13, kindly note.

Item No. 4 : To discuss and decide on the reply submitted by the Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra in respect of the decision taken by the Samiti in its meeting held on 16th July 2012 (at Item No. 3).

Samiti perused and noted the same. Samiti observes as under:-

- 1) Whether the permissions/Approvals/Affiliation of new medical Colleges was given by appropriate authorities before starting the admission process. This needs to be clarified.
- 2) Whether the two new medical Colleges have exercised their option to admit the students through the 'Central Admission Process' of Asso-CET-2012. This also needs to be clarified.

After deliberation, Samiti decides to call for the explanation in this regard from the Association within one week, after receipt of the same it be placed before Samiti for its consideration.

- a) CET and CAP should be conducted in fair and transparent manner and as per the directives, orders, norms, rules and regulations laid down by the 1) Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi, 2) Hon'ble High Courts, 3) Respective Council, 4) Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik, 5) Govt. of Maharashtra and 6) Pravesh Niyamtran Samiti, Maharashtra State.

- 2 Admission to this course for Academic Year 2012-13 is subject to approval of intake capacity and admission quota by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik and Government of Maharashtra.
- 3 **Rule Refund of Fees** : The Association/Colleges/Institutes are directed to follow following in the matter of refund of fees and incorporate the same clause as follows:
 - a) "If a candidate cancels his/her admission before the cut-off-date, then College/Institute has deduct only Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges and balance amount of fees paid by a student be refunded within two days, otherwise the same amount to profiteering and charging of capitation fees. The Samiti further directs that the College/Institute should also return the original documents / certificates collected from the students within two days.
 - b) If a candidate expires within three months from the date of admission full refund shall be made after deducting Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges.

 - iv) Course/Subject/category wise seat matrix of each round, before and after rounds.
 - v) List of selected candidates after each round.
 - vi) Details of complaints received during the process and details of action taken by Competent Authority and the Appellate Authority.

Samiti further directs, to incorporate following changes in final Rules and Information Brochure of PGU-CET-2012 as suggested by Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Ayurved Education, Maharashtra State, as follows:-

1. **Rule No. 1.2** : Due to unforeseen ----- PGU-CET-2012 entire paragraph should be deleted.
2. **Annexure – G – (No. of Seats)** : To be read as – For the year 2012-13 seats are likely to vary depending on fresh inspection of colleges by Central Council of Indian Medicine, New Delhi and recommendation of Department of AYUSH, Government of India for the current year seat allocation for more clarity
3. **Rule Refund of Fees** : The Association/Colleges/Institutes are directed to follow following in the matter of refund of fees and incorporate the same clause as follows:
 - a) "If a candidate cancels his/her admission before the cut-off-date, then College/Institute has deduct only Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges and balance amount of fees paid by a student be refunded within two days, otherwise the same amount to profiteering and charging of capitation fees. The Samiti further directs that the College/Institute should also return the original documents / certificates collected from the students within two days.
 - b) If a candidate expires within three months from the date of admission full refund shall be made after deducting Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges.
 - c) After cut-off-date except as in (b) above no refund shall be made.

Samiti, subject to the aforesaid changes/conditions, grants its approval to the draft brochure of PGU-CET-2012 of Association of Muslim Minority's Medical Educational Institutes of Maharashtra, Pune for admissions to Post Graduate Unani course for Academic Year 2012-13, subject to approval/recognition of the said degree from the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

Item No. 5(d) : Letter dated 24th July 2012 received from Association of Managements of Unaided Nursing Colleges, Pune requesting to permit to conduct Common Admission Process (CAP) round after first round of Asso-CET-2012 for B.Sc. Nursing Course for the Academic Year 2012-13.

Samiti perused the letter under references.

In view of the decision of Samiti at Agenda Item No. 10(b) in the meeting of Samiti held on 28th June 2012 in respect of the similar request of Association, after deliberation, Samiti decides not to accede to the request made by the Association. Samiti further directs all concerned colleges/institutes to publish a detailed notification quoting therein the category wise vacancy position and specimen format of Application Form in widely circulated Local as well as State level newspaper(s), Notice boards and

Website specifying the date for submitting the applications to the respective Colleges/Institutes for seeking admissions, the dates of declaring the merit lists and the dates for reporting to Colleges. The seats remaining unfilled shall be filled in by these Colleges/Institutes at their own level strictly in accordance with inter-se merit of the applicants and in a fair and transparent manner.

Item No. 5(e) : Letter dated 13th July 2012 received from Seva Mandal Education Society, Mumbai requesting to enlist with MHT-CET-2012 for its B.Sc. Nursing course being conducted by Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberations, Samiti grants its permission to the aforesaid College/Institute to join MHT-CET-2012 conducted by Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai - Government of Maharashtra, subject to final approval/affiliation/permissions from all respective Authorities.

Item No. 5(f) : Letter dated 14th July 2012 received from Suretech College of Nursing, Nagpur requesting to permit to admit students through MHT-CET-2012 and Asso-CET-2012 for its B.Sc. Nursing course for the Academic Year 2012-13.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberations, Samiti clarifies that, CET is mandatory for all admissions. Samiti also directs the aforesaid college to prepare the merit list on the basis of marks obtained in CET's i.e. MHT-CET-2012 and Asso-CET-2012. First preference should be given to MHT-CET-2012 candidates and thereafter second preference should be given to the Asso-CET-2012 candidates. The admissions to be done strictly in accordance with inter-se merit of the applicants and in a fair and transparent manner.
