2. Government vide its letter No. WPM 1315/Pra.Kra.227/15/Edu-2, dated 2nd September 2015 has requested the Samiti to consider on following\_
- a) Samiti to consider about regularizing the admissions disapproved in the Academic Year 2012-13.
- b) Samiti to consider about the actions to be initiated against private unaided Colleges/Institutes those admitted the students illegally/irregularly and by violating the rules during the Academic Year 2012-13.
3. Samiti considered the Hon'ble Supreme Court's order in Writ Petition No. 350 of 1993 dated 14/08/2003 in the matter of Islamic Academy of Education and Another versus State of Karnataka. Last sentence of para no. 230 reads as under \_\_

*"..... If it is found that any students has been admitted de-hors merit penalty can be imposed on that institute and appropriate cases recognition/affiliation may also be withdrawn. "*

Samiti also considered the Judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Special leave petition (C) No.(s) 31900 of 2013 dated 2 September 2014 in the matter of Krina Ajay Shan and Ors versus the Secretary, Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges, Maharashtra and Ors. Last para read as under :-

220

*"In the circumstances, though the relief such as the one sought by the petitioners cannot be granted at this stage in view of the long lapse of time but we are of the opinion that the petitioners are certainly entitled to public law damages. State of Maharashtra is directed to pay an amount of Rs. 20 lakhs to each one of these petitioners towards public law damages and such payment should be made within a period of four weeks from today. We also deem it appropriate to direct the State of Maharashtra to identify the officers who are responsible for the inaction on the report of the monitoring Committee dated 11th January, 2013 and take appropriate action against those officers including the recovery of the amount (to be paid pursuant to this order, by the State) from those officers."*

Samiti also considered the Hon'ble High Court order dated 26th August 2015 in Civil Application in Writ Petition No. 469 of 2015 in Writ Petition No. 5670 of 2013 the details extract as under :

*"The learned AGP appearing for the State of Maharashtra, on written instruction dated 26.08.2015 by the Deputy Secretary to Government, to the following effect, seeks time.*

*"...Considering the time lapsed since the unapproved admissions were made, it has been proposed to take the decision on humanitarian basis regarding the unapproved admissions of the petitioner students, made at college level and after the second round of common entrance examination - 2012, subject to the opinion of the Pravesh Niyamtran Samiti. The said proposal has been approved the law and Judiciary Department and the same has been forwarded for approval to the Hon'ble Minister for Education and Drugs Dept. Thereafter, the approval of the said Samiti (PNS) to the said proposal will be sought. After the decision from the PNS, the order according to decision of PNS will be issued.*

*The written instruction are taken on record and marked "X" for identification purposes. All point kept open."*

4. This Samiti by its resolution dated 11<sup>th</sup> January 2013 had refused to approve admissions while refusing to approve the Samiti recorded thus:-

*".....Samiti therefore confirm the finding of Enquiry Committee that the reservation rules were not followed by this Colleges. The admission process was thus not fair, transparent and merit based and reservation rules having not followed in the right perspective. Samiti therefore disapproves all the admissions done by the College/Institute after the last "Common Admission Process" (CAP) round of MH-CET/Asso-CET-2012 for the Academic Year 2012-13. Samiti recommends to Government of Maharashtra to direct the said College/Institute to cancel the admission after last CAP round of MH-CET/Asso-CET-2012....."*

The University was not permitting the students whose admission were not approved to appear for the examinations. Therefore they approached the Hon'ble High Court by filing various Writ Petitions. The High Court by interim order permitted the students to appear for the examinations and the students continued their further studies. With the result the students have prosecuted their studies for the degree of M.B.B.S. from the Academic Year 2012-13. If the Samiti does not pass appropriate resolution to enable the students to continue their studies for the degree examination those students would be ousted but the seats which will become vacant as a consequence of the ouster can not be now filled in and will go waste. In short those students will suffer adverse consequences but no other student will benefit. The Samiti while refuse to approve the admissions of these students did not impose penalty on the Colleges which had admitted the students wrongly because the admission of the students was disapproved. But now if the admission are to be treated as approved. It would be appropriate consider imposing penalty on the erring colleges.

5. Considering the above, Samiti after deliberations, resolves as under:-

- A) As a one time measure; Samiti decides to request the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik to treat these admissions as having been approved by Samiti and accordingly process the examination form of the students.
- B) If at all penalties are to be imposed on the institutions for their illegal, irregular, unjust, biased admissions done in Academic Year 2012-13, Samiti thinks it proper to issue show cause notices to the erring institutions asking them to submit their written representations **AS TO WHY PENALTY SHOULD NOT BE LEVIED HEAVILY FOR THEIR WRONGFUL ADMISSIONS DURING THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2012-13.** The Institutions to submit their written representations before 29th September 2015 failing which the appropriate decision will be taken in absence of their say. This has to be considered as a one time measure in view of the public law damages, deficiencies and wrongs done by these Colleges. The University may also be requested not to give affiliation to these Colleges/Institutes from the Academic Year 2016-17 until the Colleges/Institutes comply with this.


