Minutes of the Meeting of Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti - Medical Education held on Monday, the 16th July 2012 at 12.30 p.m. in the Conference Hall, Office of the Director, Technical Education, 3, Mahapalika Marg, Mumbai - 400 001 are approved and confirmed with the following corrections:-

"After deliberation Samiti ratifies the decision and decides that, if the seats remain vacant even after Govt.-CET, Asso-CET and Nationalised CET procedures, then only with Samiti's permission candidate can be admitted for Pre and Para clinical subjects in MD/MS course on the basis of criteria laid down in clause 9(1), 9(2) and 9(3) of Medical Council of India – Post Graduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000 for the Academic Year 2012-13. Samiti further decides that University could investigate/verify admissions of such Non-CET admissions. Above admissions are approved subject to permissions/affiliations of all the authorities Central Government, Respective Council, Government of Maharashtra and Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik for the Academic Year 2012-13."

Samiti decides that the decisions shall be communicated to the concerned Departments / Associations and the Colleges / Institutes for further necessary action through official website of Samiti.

Samiti noted and approved it.

Item No. 3 : To conduct the verification process for first round of Asso-CET-2012 conducted by Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra as per the scheduled of Hon'ble High Court order in Review Petition No. 120 of 2006 and Writ Petition No. 7799 of 2010.

As per the schedule of Hon'ble High Court order in Review Petition No. 120 of 2006 in Writ Petition No. 6332 of 2005 and Writ Petition No. 7799 of 2010 it is binding on the Association to submit the data/information of first round of selection process of Asso-CET-2012 on 3rd July 2012, but till date Association failed to submit any information in respect of first selection round of Asso-CET-2012.

Samiti heard Mrs. Jayamala Godbole, Legal Advisor and Mrs. Ranga, representative of the Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra.

Mrs. Godbole stated that two new medical Colleges were being sanctioned by the respective authorities and students/parents were not aware of these developments, therefore the fresh preferences from the students were required to be obtained and the Association had to include these colleges in first selection list of Asso-CET-2012. She also stated that Association was in the process to file a petition in Hon'ble High Court for modification of the scheme approved by Hon'ble court in Review Petition No. 120 of 2006 in Writ Petition No. 6332 of 2005 and Writ Petition No. 7799 of 2010.

After deliberation, Samiti directs the Association to submit proper explanation as to why it did not follow the Scheme which was already approved by the Hon'ble High Court in Review Petition No. 120 of 2006 in Writ Petition No. 6332 of 2005 and Writ Petition No. 7799 of 2010 within one week. Samiti further decides that after receipt of the said explanation from the Association it be placed before Samiti for its consideration.

Item No. 4 : To consider the request of the following Colleges/Institutes asking to permit the admissions of B.P.Th and B.Sc. Nursing course on the basis of Non-CET for the Academic Year 2012-13.

Item No. 4(a) : Letter dated 14th June 2012 received from Dr. Ulhas Patil College of Physiotherapy, Jalgaon for its B.P.Th. course.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

As per the decision taken by the Samiti in its meeting held on 5th March 2012 (at Item No. 5[b]) the aforesaid College/Institutes was permitted to enlist with the MHT-CET-2012 conducted by Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai for its B.P.Th. course.

In view of the above, after deliberation Samiti directs the College/Institute to follow CET rules and regulations as per Government Policy. Samiti decides not to accede the request made by the aforesaid college/institute.

Item No. 4(b) : Letter dated 7th June 2012 received from DPO's NETT College of Physiotherapy, Thane for its B.P.Th. course

Item No. 4(c) : Letter dated 12th June 2012 received from Dr. Vikhe Patil Memorial Hospital and Medical College, Ahmednagar for its B.P.Th. and B.Sc. Nursing courses.

Samiti perused the letters under reference.

Samiti decides and directs the aforesaid Colleges/Institutes that, if the seat remains vacant after the last round of 'Central Admission Process' of Asso-CET-2012, then aforesaid Colleges/Institutes to approach to the Competent Authority of MHT-CET-2012 i.e. Director, Medical Education and Research, Mumbai along with complete details of vacancy position. Samiti further directs the Competent Authority of MHT-CET-2012 to fill up the vacant seats of such colleges through the MHT-CET-2012 for the Academic Year 2012-13, considering the reservation rules.

In view of the above, after deliberation Samiti decides not to accede to the request made by the aforesaid Colleges/Institutes.

Item No. 5 : **To consider and decide on the letters/representations received:-**

Item No. 5(a) : **Letter dated 21st June 2012 received from D.E.S. College of Physiotherapy, Pune asking for guidance in respect of admissions under NRI Quota.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti observes that, a person registered as Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) is to be treated at par with Non resident Indian (NRIs) in respect of economic, financial and educational fields except in relation to acquisition of agricultural or plantation properties. No parity shall be allowed in the sphere of political rights.

Any other benefits to OCIs are notified by the Ministry of Overseas Indian Affairs (MOIA) under Section 7B(1) of the Citizenship Act, 1955.

In view of the aforesaid provisions, the College/Institute needs to follow as above.

Item No. 5(b) : **Letter dated 29th June 2012 received from Sinhgad College of Nursing, Pune regarding CET-2012 for P.B.B.Sc. Nursing and M.Sc. Nursing course conducted by Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai for Academic Year 2012-13.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Dr. A.S. Vyas, Member Expert Committee and Officer on Special Duty, Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai pointed out that the aforesaid College/Institute is disassociated from the Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra and wish to join and join the Government CET for their admission process but Government is not conducting CET for P.B.B.Sc. and M.Sc. Nursing course.

In view of the above, after deliberation, Samiti directs the aforesaid College/Institute to join the Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and

Dental Colleges of Maharashtra and admit the students on the basis of CET being conducted by the aforesaid Association for the Academic Year 2012-13.

Item No. 5(c) : **Letter dated 9th June 2012 received from Chaitanya Medical Foundation's College of Physiotherapy, Pune asking for enlist with Asso-CET and APGP-CET conducted by Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra for its B.P.Th and M.P.Th. course for Academic Year 2012-13.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberations, Samiti grants its permission to the aforesaid Colleges/Institutes to join CET-2012 conducted by Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra and to follow CET rules as per directives of the concerned authorities, subject to final approval/affiliation /permissions from respective Authorities.

Item No. 5(d) : **Letter dated 4th June 2012 received from Vamanrao Ithape Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Sangamner asking to permit admission of Kum. Rani Cornelus Ruptakke from reserved category to open category for Academic Year 2008-09.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti already perused the various submissions of the Colleges/Institutes in its meeting held on 18th April 2012 (at Item No. 5). The extract of which are as under:-

"As per the Annexure – B sub clause (2) of MHT-CET-2011 brochure and Rule No. 7 of ASSO-CET-2011 brochure candidates belonging to backward class categories are required to submit the Caste Certificate and the Caste/Tribe Validity Certificate as per the Government Notification No. MED/-2006/1196/CR206/06 Edu-1(2), dated 24/06/2006.

In view of the above, Samiti decides not to accede to the request made by the aforesaid College/Institutes for change of category/quota on the ground that the students were unable to submit the aforesaid documents."

In view of the above, after deliberation, Samiti comes to the conclusion that decision taken by Samiti in its meeting held on 18th April 2012 (at Item No. 5) warrants no change. All decisions of the Committee those were taken herein before in respect of change in category and/or quota stand as they are without any alterations, modifications, etc. The aforesaid College/Institute can seek the remedy against the decision of Samiti if at all the applicant feels aggrieved before the appropriate authority empowered by law.

Item No. 5(e) : Letter dated 26th June 2012 received from Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra regarding draft brochure of APGN-CET-2012, APGP-CET-2012 and APBN-CET-2012 for admissions to Post Graduate Nursing, Physiotherapy and Post Basic Nursing course respectively for the Academic Year 2012-13.

Samiti perused the letter under reference and letter dated 14th July 2012 submitted by the Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Ayurved, Maharashtra State, Mumbai

Considering the suggestions of Expert Committee on the draft brochure and after deliberations, Samiti allows the Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra to conduct APGP-CET-2012 for admission to Post Graduate Physiotherapy course for Academic Year 2012-13, subject to the following:-

- a) CET and CAP should be conducted in fair and transparent manner and as per the directives, orders, norms, rules and regulations laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi, 2) Hon'ble High Courts, 3) Respective Council, 4) Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik, 5) Govt. of Maharashtra and 6) Pravesh Niyamtran Samiti, Maharashtra State.
- b) List of notified centers with details of seating arrangement made in each such centers and list of eligible candidates appearing for examination to be provided to Samiti. No. of seats available college wise to be provided to Samiti.
- c) Schedule of CET and CAP should be as per directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi and Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik, if any.
- d) Samiti directs the Association to declare the result of the said CET within 10 days
- e) Result of CET should be displayed on website and the notice boards of the Association. Result of APGP-CET-2012 to be submitted to the Samiti office, within two days from the date of declaration of result.
- f) Association should ensure that allotment of students to colleges is made strictly as per merit and as per the options of choices exercised. Association should also ensure that colleges submit Fee Approval proposals to Shikshan Shulka Samiti, Maharashtra State for finalization of fee structure for the Academic Year 2012-13. It should also to be ensured that allotment of students is done only to the colleges who are permitted/affiliated to Council/University for the academic year 2012-13. Association should ensure that colleges submit the list of admissions within two days from the cut off date to Samiti's office.

- g) Association conducting CET/ CAP should communicate to Samiti's office vacancy details immediately after the each round is over.
- h) The Competent Authority of the Association and / or Representatives of Director, Directorate of Ayurved, Maharashtra State will be Grievance Redressal Authority who will take care of all complaints of students/parents during CET examinations and admission process. Association should further ensure appointment of appellate authority to hear and decide and dispose of grievances against the decisions of said competent authority.
- i) All admissions to be done on the basis of CET conducted by the Association with the requisite mark.
- j) Association/Colleges are directed to display details of their infrastructure available on their website.
- k) Association should submit detailed information in respect of appointments of moderators/examiners their names qualifications, etc to Samiti immediately.
- l) Where seats are likely to be increased, Association to publish the details before hand in Local as well State Level News papers, notice boards and websites of association and respective Colleges also and invite/call the fresh preferences / choices from the candidates for such seats.
- m) Samiti further directs the Association to submit the following information to office from time to time without fail:-
- i) No. of students appeared
 - ii) No. of students qualified in the Exam.
 - iii) No. of participating Colleges with subjects and their sanctioned intake capacity.
 - iv) Course/Subject/category wise seat matrix of each round, before and after rounds.
 - v) List of selected candidates after each round.
 - vi) Details of complaints received during the process and details of action taken by Competent Authority and the Appellate Authority.

Samiti further directs, to incorporate following changes in final Rules and Information Brochure of APGP-CET-2012 as suggested by Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Ayurved, Maharashtra State, as follows:-

- 1) The rule of eligibility, conduct of examination Tie-break, etc are at par with the Post Graduate Physiotherapy entrance test conducted by Directorate of Medical Education and Research Mumbai for the Academic Year 2012-13

- 2) **Rule Refund of Fees** : The Association/Colleges/Institutes are directed to follow following in the matter of refund of fees and incorporate the same clause as follows:
- I) "If a candidate cancels his/her admission before the cut-off-date, then College/Institute has deduct only Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges and balance amount of fees paid by a student be refunded within two days, otherwise the same amount to profiteering and charging of capitation fees. The samiti further directs that the College/Institute should also return the original documents / certificates collected from the students within two days.
 - II) If a candidate expires within three months from the date of admission full refund shall be made after deducting Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges.
 - III) After cut-off-date except as in (b) above no refund shall be made.

In view of submission of Dr. Vyas that Government has not conducted entrance test for Post Graduate and Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing course. Hence was unable to submit views/suggestions in this regard. after deliberation, Samiti, subject to the aforesaid changes/conditions, grants its approval to the draft brochure of APGP-CET-2012 of Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra for admissions to Post Graduate Physiotherapy course for Academic Year 2012-13. Samiti further directs the Association to conduct the CET for M.Sc. and P.B.Sc. Nursing course and follow the rules, regulations, conditions and eligibility criteria, etc laid down by their respective councils, Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik and Government of Maharashtra for admissions process of M.Sc. Nursing and P.B. B.Sc. Nursing courses for the academic Year 2012-13.

Item No. 5(f) : Letter dated 6th June 2012 received from Dakshin Kesari Muni Mishrilalji Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Aurangabad regarding provisional admissions in Homoeopathic pharmacy and Psychiatry Post Graduate Homoeopathic courses for the Academic Year 2012-13.

Samiti perused the letter under reference. Samiti defers the said matter till the further orders.

It is observed that the admissions of this subject's viz. – Homoeopathic Pharmacy and Psychiatry are done by the aforesaid College/Institute on the basis of order passed by the Hon'ble High Court, Bench at Aurangabad in Writ Petition No. 7401 of 2011.

In view of the above, after deliberations, Samiti decides that matter being subjudice, will be disposed of after the decision by Hon'ble High Court.
