Samiti perused the letters under references.

After deliberation, Samiti decides not to accede to the request made by the aforesaid Colleges/Institutes to permit admissions of B.P.Th. course on the basis of Non-CET for for the Academic Year 2011-12, being violative of the principles already laid down and being followed herein before.

Item No. 4(i) : Appeal / Revision dated 27th February 2012 received from Kum. Pratibha Prakash Dhanbhar against the decision taken by the Samiti in its Meeting held on 26th September 2011 (at Item No. 7[d]), 19th October 2011 (at Item No. 5[a]) and 17th January 2012 (at Item No. 3[f]) in respect of admission process of Dr. Ulhas Patil Medical College, Jalgaon for Academic Year 2011-12, rejecting the complaint of applicant.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti in its meeting held on 26th September 2011 (at Item No. 7[d]) has already heard the aforesaid candidate with his parents as well as said College/Institute. Samiti also perused the various submissions of the applicant in its meetings held on 19th October 2011 (at Item No. 5[a]) and 17th January 2012 (at Item No. 3[f]).

In view of the above, after deliberation, Samiti comes to the conclusion that decision taken by Samiti in the earlier meetings held on 26th September 2011 (at Item No. 7[d]), 19th October 2011 (at Item No. 5[a]) and 17th January 2012 (at Item No. 3[f]) warrants no change. All decisions of the Committee those were taken herein before in respect of admission of Kum. Pratima Prakash Dhanbhar stand as they are without any alterations, modifications, etc. The applicant can seek the remedy against the decision of Samiti if at all the applicant feels aggrieved before the appropriate authority empowered by law.

As per the Annexure – B sub clause (2) of MHT-CET-2011 brochure and Rule No. 7 of ASSO-CET-2011 brochure candidates belonging to backward class categories are required to submit the Caste Certificate and the Caste/Tribe Validity Certificate as per the Government Notification No. MED/-2006/1196/CR206/06 Edu-1(2), dated 24/06/2006.

In view of the above, Samiti decides not to accede to the request made by the aforesaid College/Institutes for change of category/quota on the ground that the students were unable to submit the aforesaid documents.

Item No. 6 : **To consider and decide on the Verification Report on the status of NRI candidates admitted during A.Y. 2010-11 and 2011-12 on the basis of documents/relevant papers submitted by the Colleges/Institutes.**
