**Item No. 3(a) :** **To discuss, consider and ratify the decisions taken on circulatory submission on 7<sup>th</sup> September 2012 regarding second selection list of Asso-CET-2012 for admissions to first year Health Science Courses for the Academic Year 2012-13.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti observed as under:-

- 1) As per the directives given by the Samiti in its meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> August 2012 (at Item No.3) Association was to submit the detailed information in respect of second selection list of Asso-CET-2012 before 27<sup>th</sup> August 2012. Considering this Samiti had fixed the meeting on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2012 but the said information was not received from the Association till 1<sup>st</sup> September 2012.
- 2) Association vide its letter dated 24/08/2012 has requested Samiti to permit it to submit second selection list of Asso-CET-2012 on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2012. Accordingly Samiti in its meeting held on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2012 (at Item No. 6[f]) considered the request However, Association again failed to submit the second selection list of Asso-CET-2012 on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2012.

Association vide its letter dated has on 6<sup>th</sup> September 2012 (at 4:30 p.m.) submitted the CD containing the data of second selection list of Asso-CET-2012 for the admission of Health Science courses for the Academic Year 2012-13 and same was sent to the Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai on 6<sup>th</sup> September 2012 itself for verification & observations.

Expert Committee accordingly has submitted its verification and observation report vide its letter dated 7<sup>th</sup> September 2012 (through the email). Discrepancies pointed out are as under:-

**a. Observations regarding Selected Candidates**

Six candidates were blocked in the second round having selected in Government Colleges in MHT-CET round. The details are given below:-

**b. Observations from number of Colleges for which selections are done:** Following Colleges/Institutes were not permitted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

1. Pandit Deendayala Upadhyay Dental College, Solapur
2. Aditya Dental College, Beed.

After deliberation Samiti directs the Association to ensure that the allotment of students to colleges is done, subject to removal of the discrepancies pointed out by the Expert Committee.

**Item No. 3(b) :** **To discuss, consider and ratify the decisions taken on circulatory submission on 11<sup>th</sup> September 2012 regarding institute level admission process in respect of vacant seats of after second round of Asso-CET-2012 along with email dated 10/09/2012 received from Shantanu Kale.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Applicant has furthered following points for consideration of Samiti:-

1. Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti needs to send representative to all these colleges to observe the construction of merit list and entire process of Institutional level admissions.
2. Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti needs to declare names & Cell numbers of contact persons on the website.
3. It be ensured that such person remains present in the respective colleges.
4. Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti should provide functional helpline which can be contacted by students or parents if they feel so.
5. Colleges to be asked to accept the application forms by Speed post and declare the merit list on their website two days in advance.

6. Colleges to be asked to charge token money from students and to pay remaining amount of fees within two days.
7. Pravesh Niyran Samiti to play proactive role in curbing malpractices at Institutional level admissions

After deliberation, Samiti decides as under:

**Point No. 1,2,3, & 4 :**

Samiti observes that the communication by an email is sent on 10<sup>th</sup> September 2012. Process of admission after 2<sup>nd</sup> round was scheduled to be started from 14/09/2012. The details of said schedule were already declared on 14/08/2012. It is therefore felt at this point of time that the suggestions though deserves to be appreciated can not be implemented practically. It is not fit, proper, practicable and just for Samiti to send its representatives to all the Colleges spread over the State of Maharashtra to oversee the procedures. The points are thus answered accordingly.

- 5) Samiti has already asked the Colleges to follow the schedule.
- 6) It is felt at this juncture that the suggestion though deserves to be appreciated can't be implemented practically, in view of the fact that the detailed instructions already were passed on to Colleges with the schedule.
- 7) It is pointed out that the Samiti happens to be quasi judicial body and has its own inherent limitations while discharging its functions. Samiti decides to note the points raised by complainant.

**Item No. 4:** **Letter dated 7<sup>th</sup> September 2012 received from Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra regarding second provisional list of Asso-CET-2012 along with office note dated 10<sup>th</sup> September 2012.**

Samiti perused and noted the revised schedule for admission of vacant seats after 2<sup>nd</sup> round of Asso-CAP.

**Item No. 5:** **To consider and decide on the letters/representations received:-**

**Item No. 5(a) :** **Letter dated 17<sup>th</sup> September 2012 received from Association of Management of Unaided Nursing Colleges, Pune requesting to permit the admissions of B.Sc. Nursing course on the basis of MHT-CET and 12<sup>th</sup> Science pass students for the Academic Year 2012-13.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti already perused the various submissions of the Colleges/Institutes in its meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> July 2012 (at Item No. 4[c]). The extract of which are as under:-

***"Samiti decides and directs the aforesaid Colleges/Institutes that, if the seat remains vacant after the last round of 'Central Admission Process' of Asso-CET-2012, then aforesaid Colleges/Institutes to approach to the Competent Authority of MHT-CET-2012 i.e. Director, Medical Education and Research, Mumbai along with complete details of vacancy position. Samiti further directs the Competent Authority of MHT-CET-2012 to fill up the vacant seats of such colleges through the MHT-CET-2012 for the Academic Year 2012-13, considering the reservation rules.***

***In view of the above, after deliberation Samiti decides not to accede to the request made by the aforesaid Colleges/Institutes."***

In view of the above, after deliberation, Samiti comes to the conclusion that decision taken by Samiti in its meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> July 2012 (at Item No. 4[c]) warrants no change. All decisions of the Committee those were taken herein before in respect of admissions of B.Sc. Nursing course on the basis of Non-CET stand as they are without any alterations, modifications, etc. The aforesaid College/Institute can seek the remedy against the decision of Samiti if at all the applicant feels aggrieved before the appropriate authority empowered by law.

**Item No. 5(b) : Letter dated 17<sup>th</sup> September 2012 received from Association of Management of Unaided Nursing Colleges, Pune requesting to permit admissions of P.B.B.Sc. nursing on the basis of Non CET and asking to permit to admit non APGN-CET candidates in NRI quota for M.Sc. Nursing course for the Academic Year 2012-13.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti already perused the submission of the College/Institute viz. College of Nursing, Wanless Hospital, Miraj in its meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> March 2012 (at Item No. 3 [c]). The extract of which are as under:-

***"Samiti also perused the letter dated 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2012 received from India Nurisng Council, New Delhi clause No. 8. The extract of which are as below.***

***"The Institution should admit candidate only by entrance examination for M.Sc. (N) & P.B.B.Sc. (N). Marks of the qualifying examination should not be considered."***

***In view of the above, after deliberation, Samiti decides not to accede to request made by the aforesaid College/Institute regarding M.Sc. Nursing admission on the basis of Non-CET for the Academic Year 2012-13."***

In view of the above, after deliberation, Samiti comes to the conclusion that decision taken by Samiti in its meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> March 2012 (at Item No. 3[c]) warrants no change. All decisions of the Committee those were taken herein before in respect of admissions of M.Sc. Nursing and P.B.Sc. Nursing on the basis of Non-CET stand as they are without any alterations, modifications, etc. The aforesaid College/Institute can seek the remedy against the decision of Samiti if at all the applicant feels aggrieved before the appropriate authority empowered by law.

**Item No. 5(c) : Letter dated 17<sup>th</sup> September 2012 received from Dr. Ulhas Patil Medical College & Hospital, Jalgaon regarding schedule of admission process for first year MBBS course for the Academic Year 2012-13.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Aforesaid College/Institute has assured that no meritorious student will be denied admission and they will follow rules strictly as directed by Samiti.

Samiti noted the contents..

**Item No. 5(d) : Letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> September 2012 received from Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru Memorial Institute of Homoeopathic Medical Sciences, Amravati requesting to permit admissions of 1) Dr. Farhan Monis Ahmed Anis Ahmed and 2) Dr. Chandan Pradip Dhole admitted in Academic Year 2010-11 and 2011-12 respectively on the basis of Council norms.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberation, Samiti permit the admissions of 1) Dr. Farhan Monis Ahmed Anis Ahmed and 2) Dr. Chandan Pradip Dhole admitted in Academic Year and 2011-12 respectively on the basis of norms laid down by the Central Council of Homoeopathy, New Delhi.

Samiti decides that above admissions are approved, subject to the aforesaid candidates full filling the norms laid down by the Central Council of Homoeopathy, New Delhi and Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

Samiti directs that the said permission is granted only for the Academic Year 2010-11 and 2011-12 and the Colleges/Institutes should not treat it as a precedent for the years to come.

**Item No. 5(e) : Letter dated 31<sup>st</sup> August 2012 received from Swargiya Dadasaheb Kalmegh Smruti Dental College & Hospital, Nagpur in respect of the decision taken by the Samiti in its meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> June 2012 (at Item No. 2[c]) regarding over and above admission done in 15% NRI Quota for Post Graduate Medical course for the Academic Year 2012-13.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti decides to hear the aforesaid College/Institute in its next meeting.

Samiti therefore directs the aforesaid College/Institute to remain present before Samiti in the next meeting scheduled to be held on 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2012

**Item No. 5(f) : Letter dated 6<sup>th</sup> September 2012 received from Kasturba Health Society, Wardha requesting to enlist with State CET for its P.B.B.Sc. Nursing and M.Sc. Nursing course for the Academic Year 2012-13.**

Samiti perused the letters under reference.

After deliberations, Samiti grants its permission to the aforesaid Colleges/Institutes to join State CET conducted by Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai -Government of Maharashtra and to follow CET rules as per Government policy, subject to final approval/affiliation/permissions from respective Authorities.

**Item No. 5(g) : Hon'ble High Court order dated 9<sup>th</sup> August 2012 in respect of Writ Petition No. 2500 of 2012 regarding admission of Rangoli R. Jaiswal admitted for B.P.Th. course for the Academic Year 2011-12 at V.S.P.M. College of Physiotherapy, Nagpur.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik to follow the same.

**Item No. 6: To consider and decide on the complaints/representations received from students/parents during admission process done at Institute level for the Academic Year 2012-13 (Enclosed as Annexure – A)**

Samiti perused the letters under reference.

After deliberation, Samiti directs/resolved as under:-

- 1) All admissions after 2<sup>nd</sup> round of Asso-CET-2012 at the institute level shall be provisional.
- 2) Colleges should inform all students admitted after 2<sup>nd</sup> round of Asso-CET-2012 as in (1) above.
- 3) Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik also should inform all Colleges/Institutes accordingly.
- 4) All admissions shall thus be provisional and subject to the final approval of Samiti.

Samiti further decides that after receipt of clarifications from concerned Colleges/Institutes, students concerned to be informed by email only. Students in turn to offer their say over these explanations. Thereafter office to place them before Samiti for its consideration.

**Item No. 7: To discuss and conduct the verification process in respect of vacant seats of after last CAP round of Asso-CET-2012 done at institute level for Medical and Dental courses for the Academic Year 2012-13.**

The selection list in respect of admissions done by the College/Institute at institute level after the second round of Asso-CET-2012 and submitted by the various Medical and Dental Colleges/Institutes is sent to the Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai for their scrutiny and remarks/suggestions **(Enclosed as Annexure –B).**

It is observed that report of Expert Committee is not yet received. Samiti directs the Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai to verify and scrutinize the list of provisionally admitted candidates admitted by the Colleges at Institute level submitted by the various Medical and Dental Colleges/Institutes and submit their report to Samiti within one week, positively. Final decision shall be subject to the scrutiny by Samiti.

**Item No. 8: Any other matter with the permission to the Chair.**

**Item No. 8(a): Letter dated nil received from under graduate students of S.V.N. Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Rahuri, Ahmednagar regarding permission of the said colleges from concerned authorities.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti concludes that the request of the applicant students since not related to the Samiti and the prayer being beyond the purview of Samiti. Samiti directs the applicants to approach the appropriate authority empowered by law for the appropriate remedy.

**Item No. 8(b): Letter dated 25<sup>th</sup> September 2012 received from Dr. Ulhas Patil Medical College & Hospital, Jalgaon in respect of vacant seats of first year M.B.B.S. course for the Academic Year 2012-13**

Samiti perused and noted the letter under reference.

The institute has pointed out that as on 25<sup>th</sup> September 2012 six seats were lying vacant because of cancellation of admissions by students on 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> September 2012.

The College has assured that the vacant seats shall be filled in on inter-se merit by giving wide publicity. Samiti noted the contents.


**Item No. 8(c): Letter dated 18<sup>th</sup> September 2012 received from Institute of Medical Sciences and Research, Satara regarding cancellation of admission of Ms. Jaivy Joshi admitted in first year MBBS course for the Academic Year 2012-13**

Samiti perused the letter under reference. The institute has pointed out that the candidate under reference has secured 148 marks out of 300 in PCB group (12<sup>th</sup> HSC examination). It is also pointed out that the said candidate does not full fill the eligibility criteria laid down by Medical Council of India, New Delhi regulations.

However, it is then observed that allotment of this candidate is done by Association through Common Admission Process of Asso-CET-2012. His name also appears in the second selection list of Asso-CET-2012. The list is verified and scrutinized by the Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Maharashtra State.

Considering the above, after deliberation Samiti directs the Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra and Expert Committee i.e. Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Maharashtra State to submit the explanation as to how the candidate who does not fulfill the eligibility criteria laid down by MCI regulations is allotted to the aforesaid College/Institute and why the Expert Committee did not point out the same. The explanations to be placed before the Samiti.
