On the basis of the remarks submitted by the Directorate of Ayurved, Maharashtra State, Samiti decides to approve the admission of Vd. Sachin Ashok Mandge in first year Post Graduate Ayurved Course for the Academic Year 2011-12, subject to payment of penalty @ Rs. 10,000/- to be paid in the form of Demand Draft / Pay order in favour of "PRAVESH NIYANTRAN SAMITI".

Shri Nakhave, Asst. Registrar, Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik pointed out University having declared the result of 07 students admitted in first year BDS course for the Academic Year 2011-12 at M.A. Rangoonwala College of Dental Sciences & Research Center, Pune, on the basis of order dated 15.11.2012 passed by National Commission for Minority Educational Institution, New Delhi. Samiti noted the same.

Item No. 4(C) : Email dated 30th October 2012 received from Prasad Ravindra Hervade requesting not to cancel the admissions already done on Non – CET basis.

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti has in its meeting held on 2nd November 2012 (at Item No. 3[d]), observed as under:-

"Samiti perused the letter under reference. Samiti also perused Govt. letter no. एमईडी/प्र.क्र. २७९/शिक्षण - २, dated 30/10/2012 received from Medical Education Department, Mantralaya, However, the aspect of granting the permission to admit Non-CET students in BHMS, BAMS, BPMT does not come within the purview of Samiti"

Considering above, after deliberation, Samiti comes to the conclusion that decision taken by Samiti in its meeting held on 2nd November 2012 (at Item No. 3[d]) warrants no change. All decisions of the Committee those were taken herein before in respect of admissions of B.H.M.S. course on the basis of Non-CET stand as they are without any alterations, modifications, etc. The aforesaid candidate can seek the remedy against the decision of Samiti if at all the applicant feels aggrieved before the appropriate authority empowered by law.

Item No. 5 : To consider and decide on the complaints/representations received after 30th September 2012 from students/parents in respects of the admission process followed at Institute level for the Academic Year 2012-13. (As per list)

Samiti perused the list.

Samiti has received various complaints/representations after 30th September 2012 up to 30th November 2012. Government of Maharashtra vide its resolution bearing No. एमईडी १०१२/प्र.क्र.३०९/शिक्षण-२, dated 29th November 2012 formed a committee to enquire/investigate into various complaints received.

Samiti perused the letters under references.

After deliberations, Samiti decides that the aspect of granting permission to new post graduate courses does not come within the purview of Samiti.
